ROBINSON'S HOMERS NOT ENOUGH IN 18-13 LOSS: Outfielder Trayvon Robinson showed why he was elected to start the Triple-A All-Star Game, belting a pair of homers and driving in five runs, but the Albuquerque Isotopes still ended up dropping a wild one to the Omaha Storm Chasers, 18-13 Thursday night at Werner Park. Albuquerque came out of the gate swinging, scoring four runs in the first inning on an RBI single by Jerry Sands and a three-run blast by Robinson that put the visitors on top 4-0. Omaha responded in the bottom of the first with a two-run homer by Kila Ka'aihue before knotting the game with two more in the second and taking the lead in the third on a solo homer by Lorenzo Cain, making the score 5-4 Chasers. A three run blast by Johnny Giavotella in the fourth extended the Omaha lead to 8-4. The Isotopes roared back in the fifth, plating six runs before the Storm Chasers could even record an out to seize the advantage right back. With J.D. Closser on first, Robinson smashed his second homer of the night, trimming the lead to 8-4 Chasers. Jamie Hoffmann then laced an RBI double to center to bring the 'Topes within 8-7. Justin Sellers capped the frame with a three-run homer to left, giving the 'Topes a 10-8 advantage. Hoffmann helped provide some breathing room in the sixth, delivering a two-run homer, the Isotopes' fourth of the game, to put the Isotopes on top 12-8. Things would turn south in a hurry for Albuquerque, however, as Omaha answered with an eight-spot in the bottom of the sixth to put the Chasers back on top 16-12. The Isotopes would cut the lead to 16-13 with a run in the seventh, but the Storm Chasers plated two more runs in the bottom of the frame to cruise to an 18-13 victory.

ALL-STAR PITCHER: Lefty Dana Eveland makes his first start after being selected to pitch for the Pacific Coast League team in the Triple-A All-Star Game taking place in Salt Lake City on July 13. In being chosen to represent the Isotopes in the annual Triple-A mid-season classic, Eveland became just the fourth pitcher to take part in the All-Star Game in team history and the first since knuckleballer Charlie Haeger appeared in the game in 2009 in Portland (Chris Seddon appeared in the 2008 contest and reliever Jim Crowell took part in the 2005 game). Eveland also looks to bounce back after having his streak of eight quality starts broken in his last outing, a no-decision at Iowa on June 25 when he allowed three runs on four hits and five walks in five innings while fanning four in a 4-3 'Topes loss. The southpaw also looks to carry into July what was an excellent June in which he went 2-1 with a 3.48 ERA (12 ER / 31.0 IP) in five starts.

THE FUNK CONTINUES: The Isotopes losing streak has now reached eight straight games, tied for the second longest losing streak in team history and the third longest in the history of Triple-A baseball in Albuquerque. The 'Topes have lost eight straight games on two

previous occasions in team history, (August 24-31, 2004 / June 28-July 5, 2008) and are one loss from equaling the franchise record of nine straight losses set from July 28-August 6, 2004. The longest losing streak in Triple-A Albuquerque history is 12 games, set by the Dukes from August 3-August 14, 1985. Since the streak began on June 22, the 'Topes have been outscored 70-45.

ROCKIN' ROBINSON: As if on cue, Trayvon Robinson celebrated his selection to the PCL All-Star team by smashing a pair of homers in a game for the first time this season, bringing his total on the season to 20 dingers, fourth most in the PCL. Almost half of Robinson's homers have come in the month of June, as the slugger belted nine homers in 27 June games, second most in the PCL over the month. In fact, June was just a stellar month in general for Robinson, who batted .359 (37x103) with 20 runs scored and 23 RBI.

TURN THE PAGE: While June was a great month for Trayvon Robinson, the same cannot be said for the Isotopes as a whole, who finished the month with a 14-15 record, their first losing month of the 2011 season. July promises to be better, however, as historically, the 'Topes turn it on as the summer heats up. Since 2009, Albuquerque is 35-21 in the month of July and 116-106 in the month all-time.

TODAY'S START: Dana Eveland makes the start coming off a no-decision at Iowa when he allowed three runs on four hits and a season-high five walks in five innings while striking out four in a 4-3 'Topes defeat.

Selected to pitch in the Triple-A All-Star game at Salt Lake on July 13, becoming just the fourth pitcher in team history to receive the honor, the last being starter Charlie Haeger in 2009

Posted quality starts in eight straight outings from May 13 to June 20, going 4-1 with a 2.94 ERA (17 ER / 54.0 IP) in that span.

Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 inningspitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances...with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation...compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0)

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
