NASHVILLE SOUNDS (40-49) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (47-42)

SOUNDS SLIP ISOTOPES, 3-1: The Albuquerque Isotopes once again received a great pitching performance but the Nashville Sounds hurlers were up to the challenge, holding the 'Topes offense to just one run in a 3-1 Sounds victory Saturday night at Isotopes Park. Through the first four innings, the contest was a pitcher's duel between 'Topes starter Tim Sexton and Nashville right-hander Mike Fiers, who was making his first start at Triple-A. After four scoreless frames, it was Fiers who blinked first, as the Isotopes plated the first run of the game in the bottom of the fifth. Dee Gordon, as he seemingly always does, started the rally with a bunt base hit before streaking into third on a single by Ivan DeJesus Jr. Jay Gibbons then roped a groundball up the middle for a force out at second that allowed Gordon to scamper home and give the Isotopes a 1-0 lead. Nashville immediately answered in the sixth, when former Isotope Brett Carroll smashed a two-run shot to left center that immediately gave the Sounds a 2-1 edge They didn't need it, but the Sounds scratched out one more run of insurance in the ninth when Taylor Green reached on a two-base fielding error by Corey Smith at first base, advanced to third on a sacrifice, and scored on a single by Brandon Boggs to send Nashville to a 3-1 win.

THE SNELL OF SUCCESS: Ian Snell makes the start coming off his best outing of the season on July 5 vs. Round Rock, when he allowed four runs on six hits in six strong innings while walking two and striking out six in a 13-4 'Topes win, Snell's first of the season. In fact, other than one rough start against Oklahoma City on June 24, Snell has been excellent at Isotopes Park. In his first start at The Lab on June 19 vs. Iowa, Snell allowed just two runs on four hits in five innings while walking three and striking out four. The right-hander has still been susceptible to the long ball, however, surrendering nine in 20 innings-pitched this season, second most on the 'Topes' pitching staff to John Ely's 14 dingers, given up over 97.1 innings.

BREAK TIME: For the fifth time in the nine-year history of the team, the Isotopes will head to the Triple-A All-Star Break with a winning record. With a win tonight, the 'Topes would head to the break with a mark of 48-42, the second-most wins at the break in club history to the 2005 squad, which went into the All-Star respite with a record of 49-21. The Isotopes also had a winning record at the break in 2004 (47-44), 2006 (46-45), and 2010 (45-44).

PITCHING PROWESS: You don't expect ERAs to plummet during homestands at Isotopes Park, but that's exactly what's happened to the Isotopes pitching staff. Since July 4, when the homestand began, 'Topes pitchers have posted an ERA of $3.67~(22~{\rm ER}/54.0~{\rm IP})$ in six games and have been even better in their last five games, racking up a $1.80~{\rm ERA}~(9~{\rm ER}/45.0~{\rm IP})$. The bullpen has been particularly stout over that span, putting up an ERA of $0.87~(1~{\rm ER}/10.1~{\rm IP})$ in the last five games. As a result, Albuquerque's team ERA of $5.43~{\rm when}$ the homestand began is $5.31~{\rm today}$.

FAMILIAR FACES: The 'Topes added a pair of very familiar faces yesterday with the return of outfielder Jay Gibbons and relief pitcher Roy Corcoran. Gibbons left the team when it was in Iowa on June 26 to have eye surgery in Kansas City and amazingly, just 15 days later, started for the Isotopes in right field last night. Corcoran, who saved 15 games as the 'Topes closer in 2007 is back after signing with the Dodgers as free agent on July 4. Last year, Corcoran spent the entire season at Round Rock.

5-MILLION FANS!!: A routine night at the ballpark turned into anything but for Myja Peterson, who became the Isotopes' 5-millionth fan last night. Myja, her husband Gundar, son Noah, and mother-in-law Elizabeth, were greeted just inside the gates by Orbit and 'Topes General Manager John Traub, who informed her she was the lucky visitor. Myja gets two round-trip tickets to Los Angeles, two nights in a hotel and two tickets to a Dodgers game.

THE FUTURE IS TODAY: The XM Satellite Radio Futures Game will be held today at Chase Field at 4:00 PM with Isotopes manager Lorenzo Bundy in the dugout as a coach for the World Team. Serving as manager today for Albuquerque will be pitching coach Glenn Dishman.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Ian Snell takes the mound coming off his first win of the season on July 5 vs. Round Rock, when he pitched a solid six innings in which he allowed four runs on six hits while walking two and striking out six in a 13-4 'Topes win. Made one relief appearance for Albuquerque in the second game of a doubleheader on June 14 at Oklahoma City when he allowed one run (on a sixth-inning solo homer by Brian Dopirak) in one inning of work.

Signed with St. Louis to a minor league contract with an invite to Major League Spring Training on January 14. Sent to Minor League camp on March 13 but opted to retire instead. Signed with Los Angeles on May 25.

2010: Split the season between Seattle Mariners and Triple-A Tacoma... went 0-5, 6.41 in 12 games, making eight starts with Seattle before being designated for assignment on June 15... was outrighted June 19 and re-signed as a minor league free agent on June 22... went 0-5, 6.11 (24 ER / 35.1 IP) in eight starts... in four relief appearances posted a 7.36 ERA (9 ER / 11.0 IP)... made first relief appearance on May 6 vs. Tampa Bay, allowing two runs in 3.1 innings, his first relief appearance since August 12, 2005 at HOU... made final appearance June 14 at STL, allowing three hits and four runs in 2.0 innings... went 3-4, 6.66 (36 ER / 48.2 IP) in nine starts for Tacoma during the regular season... placed on 7-day disabled list August 5-September 7 with a right elbow strain... part of Tacoma's PCL Championship squad and appeared in three playoff games out of the bullpen (0-0, 4.15, 4.1 IP / 2 ER).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Acquired by Seattle in 2009 from Pittsburgh in a 7-player trade on July 29 along with Jack Wilson in exchange for infielder Ronny Cedeno, catcher/ first baseman Jeff Clement, right-hander Aaron Pribanic, right-hander Nathan Adcock, and right-hander Brett Lorin... in final nine starts of season, went 5-1, 3.00 ERA (17 ER / 51 0 IP)... his 3 00 ERA from August 15 to the end of season ranked 8th-best in the AL... his five wins were tied for 6th-best... lost 9 of his first 11 decisions (w/ PIT & SEA) before winning five of his final six... in five-week span, was optioned (June 25) to Triple-A Indianapolis by Pittsburgh, traded (July 29) to Seattle, optioned (July 29) to Tacoma by Seattle and recalled (July 31) to the Majors... made first start with Mariners on August 2 at Texas, recorded a no-decision allowing three hits and two runs in 6.0 IP... charged with first career error September 26 at Toronto; had not made an error in 128 consecutive chances to begin his career...optioned to Indianapolis on June 25... struck out a career-high 17 batters, including an Indianapolis team record 13 straight batters to start the game in his first start with Indy on June 28 vs. Toledo (no-decision)... represented Puerto Rico in 2009 World BaseballClassic making two starts: March 9 vs. Netherlands (4.0 IP, 3H, 1 ER,5K) & lost to Venezuela March 16 allowing one earned run in 4.0 IP

In 2008, agreed to terms on a five-year contract with Pirates, including club options for the 2011 and 2012 seasons on March 16... made first Opening Day start on March 31 in ATL and received a no-decision (6.0 IP, 4 ER)... struck out season-high 10 batters while pickingup first win on April 6 at Florida... on the disabled list June 26 (retro to June 23)-July 8 with a strained right elbow...posted a 3.68 ERA (18 ER / 44.0 IP) in his last eight starts and a 3.67 ERA in five September starts.

Led Pirates staff in 2007 in ERA (3.76), strikeouts (177) and innings pitched (208.0)... shared lead in starts with Tom Gorzelanny... 177 K's were the most by a Pirate right-hander since Kris Benson (184 in 2000)... ranked 8th in the NL in strikeouts and ninth ininnings pitched... 3.65 road ERA ranked ninth in the league andhis 7.7 K / 9.0 IP ranked 10th... tied for league lead in wild pitches (12)... whiffed a career-high 11 batters in first start but came away with a no-decision (6.0 IP / 2 ER) April 3 at HOU... ranked fourth among NL pitchers with a 1.59 ERA through the end of April... tossed first career complete game, allowing one unearned run in 8-1 victory vs. TEX on July 13... ranked 5th among NL starters with a 2.93 ERA at the break... went 0-5 with an 8.31 ERA (24 ER / 26.0 IP) in his first five starts after the All-Star break, raising ERA to 3.91... posted a 1.64 ERA and surrendered just one home runin his final five starts (33.0 IP)... pitched at least 6.0 innings in 26 of his 32 starts and at least 7.0 frames 18 times.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Graduated from Caesar Rodney High School in Camden,Del., in 2000, where he played football, baseball and basketball... honored by the Delaware Sports Writers Associationas its Athlete of the Year for 2006... became the 48th player from Delaware to appear in the Major Leagues when he made his debut in 2004... his 14 wins in 2006 were most by a Delaware right-hander since Huck Betts in 1934... played for Puerto Rico in the 2009 World Baseball Classic (step father is of Puerto Rican descent).
