'TOPES ENTER ALL-STAR BREAK WITH 9-5 LOSS: The Albuquerque Isotopes found themselves buried in an early hole they couldn't escape, as the Nashville Sounds scored seven times in the first three innings and cruised to a 9-5 win Sunday night at Isotopes Park. It was clear early on that it wouldn't be Albuquerque's night as former Isotope Brett Carroll continued to torment his former team, smashing a solo home run with two down in the first to give Nashville a 1-0 lead. The Sounds struck again in the second, again with two outs, when Caleb Gindl hammered a triple to center and immediately dashed home on a single by Edwin Maysonet to double the visitor's lead to 2-0. The real damage came in the third however, when Nashville put up a five-spot to break the game wide open. After a grand slam by Taylor Green, the first hit by any team at Isotopes Park this season, Gindl added a solo blast that extended the Nashville lead to 7-0. Gindl added a double and a single to rack up the first cycle ever hit against the Isotopes and just the third cycle hit in Nashville Sounds history. That's the way it would stay until Ivan De Jesus Jr. finally gave the Isotopes faithful something to cheer about. With one out in the fifth, De Jesus belted a solo homer, his first of the season, over the fence in left center that put Albuquerque on the board 7-1. Nashville tacked on two more runs in the eighth before the 'Topes finally woke up from their offensive coma, scoring twice in the eighth and twice more in the ninth to draw within 9-5.

NEWBY AND SEXTON TAKE THE HILL: Tonight's doubleheader will feature a spot start in the first contest as Joe Newby makes his second start of the season with his first coming in the second game of a twin-bill at Oklahoma City on June 14. The right-hander suffered the defeat in that contest, allowing four runs on five hits in five innings of a 5-3 loss. Newby has been an extremely solid piece out of the 'Topes bullpen, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (6 ER / 16.2 IP) in 11 relief appearances. The night-cap will feature right-hander Tim Sexton, who takes the hill looking for a measure of revenge against the Sounds. In his last start, on July 9 against Nashville at Isotopes Park, Sexton suffered a tough-luck defeat to the Sounds, allowing just two runs on four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and fanning a season-high seven but still winding up on the losing end of the decision in a 3-1 'Topes defeat.

LET'S PLAY TWO: Tonight the Isotopes will play their third doubleheader of the season, with all of them coming on the road. This twin-bill is a make-up of a game postponed during the 'Topes' last visit to Music City on May 1 due to rain and unplayable field conditions. This is the fifth doubleheader the Isotopes have played in Nashville in team history, with the 'Topes emerging from their last twin-bill at Greer Stadium on August 2, 2009 with a sweep. All-time, the Isotopes are 4-4 in doubleheader games at Nashville.

YOU AGAIN?: The double-dip is the continuation of nine straight games Albuquerque will play against the Sounds. After splitting their four-game set at Isotopes Park at the end of last week, the 'Topes and Sounds will play five games in four days at Greer Stadium, where Albuquerque took two of three at the end of April. This will be the last regular-season meeting between Albuquerque and Nashville in 2011.

GO-GO GORDON: Shortstop Dee Gordon has racked up multiple hits in every contest he's played since returning to Albuquerque from the Dodgers on July 5, going an incredible 13-for-29 (.448 average) in that six-game span. Gordon has gotten a hit in each of his last nine games as an Isotope dating back to before his call-up on June 6, batting .476 (20x42).

DUKES RETRO NIGHT IS COMING!: After a quick weekend set in Nashville, the 'Topes are back home for a big homestand that features Dukes Retro Night on Saturday, July 23. The fun starts this Monday with the first of four games against the Oklahoma City RedHawks.

TODAY'S START: Joe Newby makes his second start of the season after pitching primarily out of the bullpen, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (6 ER / 16.2 IP) in 11 relief appearances.

2011 vs. NVL: 0-0, 0.00 ERA

Earned his only win of the season on June 18 vs. Iowa after 3.1 scoreless innings of relief in which he allowed just one hit while walking one and striking out four in a 13-10 win.

Made his only other start of the season in the second game of a doubleheader on June 14 at Oklahoma City, taking the loss after giving up four runs on five hits in five innings while walking three and striking out two in a 5-3 loss.

Transferred to Albuquerque from Chattanooga on May 31 and suffered the loss in his Isotopes debut that night at Memphis after allowing one run on two hits in 2.0 IP of relief in a 10-4 'Topes loss.

Signed by the Dodgers on February 23 and appeared in seven games (two starts) for Chattanooga, going 2-1 with a 3.74 ERA (9 ER / 21.2 IP). Started the season making two straight starts, going 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA (2 ER / 10.0 IP). Suffered a hard-luck loss in his first start of the season on May 1 vs. Jackson when he allowed one run on four hits in five innings while walking none and striking out four in a 3-0 Lookouts loss. Bounced back with his first win of the season on May 6 at Mississippi, allowing one run on five hits in five innings while walking three and fanning four in a 3-1 Chattanooga win. Went 1-0 with a 5.40 ERA (7 ER / 11.2 IP) in five appearances out of the bullpen before joining the Isotopes. Six of his nine total runs given up with Lookouts came in one appearance at Tennessee on May 15.

2010: Pitched in 2010 for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League, going 6-5 with a 2.48 ERA (31 ER / 112.2 IP) in 37 games (14 starts)... set careerhigh in innings-pitched (112.2), games (37), and strikeouts (80)... yielded just seven home runs... combined to throw the first no-hitter in team history on August 5 at Newark, pitching eight-plus innings in which he walked in the Bears only run in the bottom of the ninth before giving way to closer Jim Ed Warden, who finished the no-no... Newby ended up with 8.0-plus innings-pitched, giving up just one run on no hits while walking five and striking out four in a 3-1 Blue Crabs win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played for three teams in the Seattle Mariners organization in 2009, going a combined 1-1 with a 2.38 ERA (14 ER / 53.0 IP) in 34 games, all of them in relief... spent the majority of the season at Double-A West Tennesee, appearing in 28 games in which he went 1-1 with a 2.72 ERA (13 ER / 43.0 IP)... earned a promotion to Tacoma, for his first taste of Triple-A, on June 28 and allowed just one earned run in 6.1 innings of work over three games (1.42 ERA)... also appeared in three games for Single-A High Desert, where he did not allow a run in 3.2 innings.

Did not pitch at all in 2008 while recovering from three different surgeries to his right elbow, including Tommy John surgery.

Started the 2007 season at Single-A Kane County in the Oakland chain, going 0-3 with a 8.59 ERA (14 ER / 14.2 IP) in nine games before being sidelined with a right elbow injury.

Pitched for Single-A Kane County in 2006, going 5-0 with a 3.22 ERA (18 ER / 50.1 IP) in 32 games... allowed just one home run in his 50.1 innings of work... fanned 53 while walking 22.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP). Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May

2010: Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).
