ISOTOPES WIN A PAIR AT NASHVILLE: The Albuquerque Isotopes picked up a pair of wins in about a four hour span, dashing the team's four-game losing streak against the Nashville Sounds Saturday evening at Greer Stadium. The 'Topes defeated Nashville 8-4 in 13-innings in the completion of Friday night's suspended contest and followed it up with a thrilling 3-2 triumph in Saturday's regularly scheduled contest. The day's action began with the Isotopes and Sounds deadlocked at 3-3 in the top of the 12th inning of a game suspended late Friday night due to the PCL's curfew rules. After each team traded zeroes to send the contest into the 13th, Russ Mitchell led off the frame with a towering solo homer, putting Albuquerque on top 4-3. That proved to open the flood gates for the 'Topes, who added a run on an RBI single by Ivan De Jesus Jr. before Jay Gibbons put the exclamation point on the game with a three-run homer to put the Isotopes ahead 8-3. Nashville plated a run in the bottom of the 13th, but it wasn't enough as Albuquerque cruised to an 8-4 13-inning win. The Isotopes carried that momentum right into the regularly scheduled contest, scoring a run in the first inning when Mitchell roped an RBI single to give the visiting team a quick 1-0 advantage. Nashville scratched back in the bottom of the fourth, knotting the contest at 1-1, but Albuquerque got the lead back thanks to a pair of long balls. With two out in the sixth, Trayvon Robinson put the Isotopes ahead with a towering solo homer that bounced of Nashville's iconic guitar-shaped scoreboard in left-center, giving Albuquerque a 2-1 edge. One inning later, Corey Smith hammered a laser over the wall in left to increase the 'Topes lead to 3-1. The Sounds made one last desperate push to avoid the loss in the bottom of the ninth, scoring a run to come within 3-2, but Justin Miller struck out Taylor Green to end the game and preserve the 3-2 win.

ONE HAPPY MONTH OF J-ELY: John Ely makes the start riding a two-game winning streak in which he's recorded victories in each of his last two starts. So far in the month of July, Ely is 2-0 with a 0.64 ERA, allowing just one run in his last 14.0 innings of work. His last triumph was a dominating outing against the Nashville Sounds at Isotopes Park on July 8, when he allowed just one run on six hits through seven innings while walking none and striking out five in a 7-1 Isotopes win. This month opposing hitters have an average of just .196 (10x51) against Ely.

SOUNDIN' GOOD: If the 'Topes can beat Nashville this evening, they'll have 10 wins against the Sounds this season, the most the

Isotopes have ever gotten in a year against a Nashville club that always plays Albuquerque tough. With a record of 9-6, the 'Topes are guaranteed a winning record against the Sounds in 2011, just the third time in team history they've been able to achieve that feat (they went 8-7 vs. Nashville in 2008 and 9-7 in 2004), and with a win would post back-to-back winning records at Greer Stadium ('Topes went 5-3 at Greer last year) for the first time ever.

JUST LIKE OLD TIMES!: Justin Miller's strikeout of Taylor Green last night earned the reliever his first save in an Albuquerque uniform since 2007. Miller saved six games for Albuquerque in 2007 before getting called up the Marlins, meaning his last save for the 'Topes came vs. Tacoma on May 14, 2007. After that save, Miller was used exclusively in a set-up role for the Marlins, San Francisco Giants, and Dodgers. He did save a pair of games for Round Rock on May 11 and May 15 of this year, going almost exactly four years between professional

THE STREAK CONTINUES: A.J. Ellis is back with the Isotopes, which means his streak of 25 consecutive games reaching base rolls on as well, thanks to a 1-for-3 performance with a walk last night. Since the streak began on May 12, Ellis is batting .333 (24x72) and has an incredible on-base percentage of .538. Of the 34 total games Ellis has played with Albuquerque this season, the catcher has not reached base in a game just twice.

DUKES RETRO NIGHT IS COMING!: After a quick weekend set in Nashville, the 'Topes are back home tomorrow for a big homestand that features Dukes Retro Night on Saturday, July 23. The fun starts tomorrow with the first of four games against the Oklahoma City RedHawks.

Had a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA.

ning streak after a win over Nashville at Isotopes Park on July 8 when he pitched seven innings, allowing just one run on six hits while walking none and striking out five in a

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior. was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game...selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
