ROBINSON SLAM SENDS 'TOPES PAST SOUNDS 9-5: Trayvon Robinson unknotted a 3-3 tie with a grand slam in the fifth that propelled the Albuquerque Isotopes to a 9-5 series-ending win over the Nashville Sounds Sunday evening at Greer Stadium. Nashville surged to an early lead in the first inning when Eric Farris led off the frame with a solo homer that gave the Sounds an immediate 1-0 edge. After a double by Erick Almonte, Taylor Green added an RBI single, doubling the first-inning advantage to 2-0. The Sounds added another run in the second to take a 3-0 lead before the Isotopes roared back in the top of the fourth. After Albuquerque got on the board when Jay Gibbons scored on a throwing error by the shortstop Farris, A.J. Ellis blasted a two-run double to center that knotted the game at 3-3. It would not stay deadlocked long. Ivan De Jesus Jr. started the next Isotopes rally in the fifth with a single in front of back-to-back walks to Gibbons and Russ Mitchell that loaded the bases for Robinson, who smashed an opposite-field grand slam home run to left that instantly gave Albuquerque a 7-3 lead. Nashville was down but not out, chipping away with a run in the bottom of the fifth and another in the eighth to bring the Sounds back into striking distance at 7-5. Any thoughts of a late comeback by the home team would be dashed in the top of the ninth, however, when the Isotopes tacked a pair of insurance runs, sending Albuquerque to a comfortable 9-5 win

ANOTHER START FOR NEWBY: Right-hander Joe Newby makes a second straight start, coming off an outing in the first game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 14. In that appearance, Newby pitched a solid 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on six hits while walking three and striking out two, but ended up with the loss in a 5-0 'Topes shutout loss. While this will be Newby's third start of the season, it'll be his first at Isotopes Park, with his two previous starting assignments taking place on the road as part of doubleheaders. Newby's first start of the season for Albuquerque was in the second game of doubleheader at Oklahoma City on June 14, when he allowed four runs on five hits in five innings in a 5-3 Isotopes defeat. Whether starting or coming out of the bullpen, Newby has been doing a great job of keeping the ball in the yard. In 26 innings of work this year, Newby has allowed just two homers, with his last dinger given up against RedHawks first baseman Koby Clemens on June 22, six appearances and 10.0 innings ago.

OUT FOR REDHAWKS REVENGE: The Isotopes welcome back to Albuquerque the Oklahoma City RedHawks, the only team this

season that has taken a series from the 'Topes at home. On June 21-24, the Red-Hawks rolled into the Duke City and took three of four from the Isotopes, which started Albuquerque on a franchise record 10-game losing streak and snapped the 'Topes' streak of five straight home series wins.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!: Over the past month, the Isotopes have been streaking more than Frank The Tank. After dropping 10 straight, Albuquerque went on a roll, winning four straight games only to turn around lose four right after that. Now, the 'Topes come home riding a three-game winning streak, tied for their longest road winning streak of the season.

NIFTY FIFTY: Last night's win gave Albuquerque its 50th victory of the season, the second fastest the 'Topes have reached the 50-win plateau in team history. In 2005, the Isotopes won their 50th game on July 15. This is the quickest Albuquerque has hit 50 since the 'Topes have been affiliated with the Dodgers with win number 50 coming on July 20 last year and on July 21 in 2009.

GEARING UP WITH GIBBY: Since returning from the DL on July 9 after undergoing a procedure on his eyes, Jay Gibbons has been dialed in, batting .421 (8x19) with five runs, two doubles, a homer, and five RBI in his last seven games. In the just-completed series at Nashville, Gibbons lit up the Sounds to the tune of six hits in 12 at-bats with four runs, a double, a homer, and four RBI in five games.

DUKES RETRO NIGHT IS COMING THIS HOMESTAND!: The 'Topes are back in town tonight for a big homestand that features Dukes Retro Night on Saturday. The fun starts with the first of four games against the Oklahoma City RedHawks tonight!

TODAY'S START: Joe Newby makes his third start of the season, and his first at home, after taking the loss in his last start in the first game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 14. In that contest, Newby allowed two runs on six hits in 4.1 innings while walking three and striking out two in a 5-0 'Topes loss.

Had been pitching primarily out of the bullpen, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (6 ER / 16.2 IP) in 11 relief appearances.

Earned his only win of the season on June 18 vs. Iowa after 3.1 scoreless innings of relief in which he allowed just one hit while walking one and striking out four in a 13-10 win.

Made his only other start of the season in the second game of a doubleheader on June 14 at Oklahoma City, taking the loss after giving up four runs on five hits in five innings while walking three and striking out two in a 5-3 loss.

Transferred to Albuquerque from Chattanooga on May 31 and suffered the loss in his Isotopes debut that night at Memphis after allowing one run on two hits in 2.0 IP of relief in a 10-4 'Topes loss.

Signed by the Dodgers on February 23 and appeared in seven games (two starts) for Chattanooga, going 2-1 with a 3.74 ERA (9 ER / 21.2 IP). Started the season making two straight starts, going 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA (2 ER / 10.0 IP). Suffered a hard-luck loss in his first start of the season on May 1 vs. Jackson when he allowed one run on four hits in five innings while walking none and striking out four in a 3-0 Lookouts loss. Bounced back with his first win of the season on May 6 at Mississippi, allowing one run on five hits in five innings while walking three and fanning four in a 3-1 Chattanooga win. Went 1-0 with a 5.40 ERA (7 ER / 11.2 IP) in five appearances out of the bullpen before joining the Isotopes. Six of his nine total runs given up with Lookouts came in one appearance at Tennessee on May 15.

2010: Pitched in 2010 for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League, going 6-5 with a 2.48 ERA (31 ER / 112.2 IP) in 37 games (14 starts)... set career-high in innings-pitched (112.2), games (37), and strikeouts (80)... yielded just seven home runs... combined to throw the first no-hitter in team history on August 5 at Newark, pitching eight-plus innings in which he walked in the Bears only run in the bottom of the ninth before giving way to closer Jim Ed Warden, who finished the no-no... Newby ended up with 8.0-plus innings-pitched, giving up just one run on no hits while walking five and striking out four in a 3-1 Blue Crabs win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played for three teams in the Seattle Mariners organization in 2009, going a combined 1-1 with a 2.38 ERA ($14 \, \text{ER} / 53.0 \, \text{IP}$) in 34 games, all of them in relief... spent the majority of the season at Double-A West Tennesee, appearing in 28 games in which he went 1-1 with a 2.72 ERA ($13 \, \text{ER} / 43.0 \, \text{IP}$)... earned a promotion to Tacoma, for his first taste of Triple-A, on June 28 and allowed just one earned run in 6.1 innings of work over three games ($1.42 \, \text{ERA}$)... also appeared in three games for Single-A High Desert, where he did not allow a run in 3.2 innings.

Did not pitch at all in 2008 while recovering from three different surgeries to his right elbow, including Tommy John surgery.

Started the 2007 season at Single-A Kane County in the Oakland chain, going 0-3 with a $8.59\ ERA\ (14\ ER\ /\ 14.2\ IP)$ in nine games before being sidelined with a right elbow injury.

Pitched for Single-A Kane County in 2006, going 5-0 with a 3.22 ERA (18 ER / 50.1 IP) in 32 games... allowed just one home run in his 50.1 innings of work... fanned 53 while walking 22.

Signed by Oakland as a non-drafted free agent on June 19, 2004.
