# OKLAHOMA CITY REDHAWKS (41-55) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (50-46)

ISOTOPES OVERCOME BY REDHAWKS, 8-7: The Albuquerque Isotopes saw a four-run lead evaporate in the seventh inning as the Oklahoma City RedHawks surged to an 8-7 series-opening win Monday night at Isotopes Park. After the RedHawks scored in the top of the second, Albuquerque grabbed a quick lead in the bottom of the frame when Trayvon Robinson drew a one-out walk and was immediately cashed in on a two-run homer to left by Russ Mitchell that gave the Isotopes a sudden 2-1 edge. The home team extended its advantage in the very next frame thanks to the fleet feet of Dee Gordon. After reaching on a fielder's choice, Gordon swiped second, nabbed third, and scored on a wild pitch to put the Isotopes ahead 3-1. With A.J. Ellis aboard with a walk, Jerry Sands then hammered a two-run blast to give Albuquerque a 5-1 cushion. The 'Hawks climbed to within 5-2 on a solo homer in the fourth by J.R. Towles before Albuquerque tacked on what seemed to be a crucial run of insurance in the sixth on an RBI single by Jay Gibbons that made the score 6-2 'Topes. Oklahoma City got up off the mat in the seventh, however, scoring four runs to erase the deficit in one fell swoop. With runners on second and third and nobody out, J.B. Shuck laced a two-run double to cut the Isotopes lead to 6-4. Drew Locke then roped a triple, scored on a sacrifice fly by Anderson Hernandez, and just like that, the game was knotted at 6-6. The RedHawks then broke the stalemate in the eighth, when Koby Clemens led off the inning with a single and was picked up by a two-run shot by Tommy Manzella, giving Oklahoma City the 8-6 lead. Albuquerque would mount one last rally in the ninth, as Robinson crushed his 24th home run of the season, a solo blast with two out to cut the lead to 8-7, but the 'Hawks quashed the rally there for an 8-7 win.

**THREE UP, THREE DOWN:** After winning his first three Triple-A decisions, right-hander Tim Sexton takes the mound looking to snap a three-game skid that dates back to June 28, a span of four starts in which he's posted an ERA of 6.32 (15 ER / 21.1 IP). Although he's still looking for his first win at home, the right-hander has enjoyed some of his best outings of the season at Isotopes Park. Three of his four quality starts on the season have come at The Lab (although technically his outing on June 23 was in relief of rehabbing closer Jonathan Broxton who pitched one inning and departed the game), where he's walked just five while striking out 18 and where he's posted a 1.37 ground-ball to air-out ratio.

HAMPERED BY THE 'HAWKS: The Isotopes now dropped their last four games against Oklahoma City and have fallen in seven of their last nine contests against the RedHawks. In two of their last four defeats, the 'Topes held a lead in the seventh inning or later. Albuquerque's longest skid against Oklahoma City is six games, set twice, the last coming from April 26 to July 10, 2008. The RedHawks (5-8) and the Iowa Cubs (7-9) are the only two teams in the PCL below .500 against whom the Isotopes have losing record.

MITCH MASH: With homers in two of his last four games and hits in each of his five, infielder Russ Mitchell is officially swinging a hot bat. In his last five games, Mitchell is batting .474 (9x19) with four runs scored, two doubles, two homers, and four RBI. Last night he became just the ninth Isotope in team history to rack up five hits, joining Trayvon Robinson as the only 'Topes to get five knocks this year.

**HOMER HAPPY:** In just 16 games played so far this month, the Isotopes have belted 20 home runs, tied for third most in the PCL behind Round Rock's 23 and Tacoma's 26. Eleven of those dingers this month have come in eight games at home.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP). Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May
