# ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (42-39) AT OMAHA STORM CHASERS (45-37)

ISOTOPES SILENCED BY STORM CHASERS, 6-0: The Albuquerque Isotopes were held to a mere three hits as the Omaha Storm Chasers rolled to a 6-0 win Friday night at Werner Park. With the game knotted in a scoreless tie, Omaha mounted the first scoring threat for either team in the bottom of the third. After Joaquin Arias and Irving Falu led off the frame with back-to-back singles, 'Topes All-Star starter Dana Eveland walked Johnny Giavotella to load the bases for Mike Aviles, who smashed a grand slam to left, giving the Chasers an immediate 4-0 lead. Meanwhile, Omaha starter Mike Montgomery tied the 'Topes in knots for 6.2 shutout innings, allowing just two hits, both singles, and three walks while striking out seven to earn the victory. The Storm Chasers bullpen was just as effective as its starter, as Mario Santiago took over for McDonald and allowed one hit in 1.1 innings before handing the ball to Jesse Chavez, who retired the 'Topes in order in the ninth to secure the shutout. Throughout the entire game, the 'Topes offensive attack was limited to singles from Russ Mitchell, Jamie Hoffmann, and Justin Sellers. Omaha would tack on two more runs in the eighth when Cody Clark reached on a fielding error by Mitchell that allowed Lorenzo Cain to score and a sac fly by Arias that sent the Chasers to a 6-0 shutout win.

THE KEIS TO SUCCESS: Randy Keisler takes the mound looking to continue the momentum he built up in a sensational month of June. In seven outings, four starts, in the month, Keisler posted a 4-1 record with a 2.27 ERA (8 ER / 31.2 IP) while walking 13 and striking out 29. His only defeat in the entire month came in his last outing on June 26 at Iowa when he allowed six runs, five of them earned, on nine hits in five innings, his shortest start since April 21 when he injured his groin and hamstring in his first appearance of the season at Principal Park and had to leave after just 2.2 innings. Keisler's four wins in June tied for the second-most in the PCL and his 2.27 ERA ranked fifth for the month among all qualifying pitchers.

RECORD-SETTING SKID: Last night's 6-0 loss was the Isotopes' ninth in a row, tying a franchise record set from July 28 to August 6, 2004 and tied for the second longest losing streak in the history of Triple-A baseball in Albuquerque. In 1985, the Dukes lost a record 12 straight but lost nine in a row four times (once each in 1973, 1988, 1993, and 1998). Of the six teams that have lost nine in a row or more before this squad, one has rebounded to make the playoffs. In 1988, the Dukes started the month of June with nine straight losses before righting the ship and ending up with the PCL's best record of 86-56. Last night's defeat drops the 'Topes five games behind Round Rock in the PCL's American Southern Division, their largest deficit of the season.

HOFFMANN WEATHERS THE STORM: With one of the three hits the Isotopes were able to muster last night, Jamie Hoffmann continues his mastery of Omaha Storm Chasers pitching. In nine games against Omaha this year, Hoffmann is batting a team-high .414 (12x29) with eight runs, two doubles, a triple, two homers and eight RBI. While he's been a bit overshadowed by his fellow outfielders Trayvon Robinson and Jerry Sands, Hoffmann is once again enjoying an excellent year for the Isotopes, batting .290 (70x241) with 55 runs, nine doubles, a triple, 14 homers, and 42 RBI in 71 games. His 14 dingers on the year ranks second on the team is a career-high, with his previous high being 11, set between stops in Chattanooga (2), Albuquerque (8), and Los Angeles (1)

**OVERDUE IN OMAHA:** Albuquerque is 2-6 in its last eight games against the Storm Chasers, but over that stretch, the 'Topes have twice followed up two straight losses against Omaha with a win, meaning if that trend holds for a third time, the Isotopes are due for a victory tonight.

On June 21 vs. Oklahoma City, Keisler came on in the second in relief of the rehabbing Jonathan Broxton and delivered six shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10, the most punch-outs by a 'Topes pitcher this year and the most by an Isotope in a relief appearance in franchise history.

Earned his second win of the season on June 11 vs. Nashville when he allowed just one run on just four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 5-2 'Topes win. Also pitched a gem on June 6 at Round Rock when he tossed six shutout innings, allowing just six hits and a walk while striking out four in an 11-0 win, his first victory of the season.

Earned PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for his back-to-back starts on June 6 and June 11 in which he went a combined 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER / 13.0 IP) while walking two

Strained his right groin and hamstring in a start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).
