# OKLAHOMA CITY REDHAWKS (42-55) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (50-47)

ALBUQUERQUE COLLAPSES IN 9-5 LOSS: For the second straight night, the Albuquerque Isotopes surrendered a late lead, as the Oklahoma City RedHawks scored nine unanswered runs from the fifth to the ninth to grab a 9-5 come-from-behind win Tuesday night at Isotopes Park. Things got off to an extremely promising start for the Isotopes, who came out the clubhouse hot, scoring three runs in the very first frame. With two on and one out, Russ Mitchell smashed a double to right-center scoring two and putting the 'Topes on top 2-0. After a throwing error by centerfielder Jason Bourgeois on the play allowed Mitchell to trot into third, Trayvon Robinson roped a single to right, plating Mitchell and extending the lead to 3-0 Albuquerque. Robinson helped the 'Topes increase the advantage in the fourth when, after Mitchell drew a lead-off walk, the outfielder smashed a monstrous home run that hit off the scoreboard in left-center, giving the Isotopes a 5-0 lead. That proved to be the extent of Albuquerque's scoring, while Oklahoma City started chipping away, scoring a run in the fifth before adding two in the sixth to cut the lead to 5-3, Isotopes. For the second game in a row, the seventh proved to be Albuquerque's undoing, as the 'Hawks scored three to grab a 6-5 lead before pouring it on with a run in the eighth and two more in the ninth to sail to the 9-5 victory.

KEIS TO THE RESCUE: Looking to break out of their two-game funk, the Isotopes turn to left-hander Randy Keisler, who is definitely the right guy for the job. In two appearances against Oklahoma City this year, Keisler is 2-0 and has not given up an earned run in 11.1 innings of work. The last time Keiser faced the RedHawks at Isotopes Park on June 21, he came on in relief of rehabbing closer Jonathan Broxton in the second inning and proceeded to dominate the 'Hawks through six innings, allowing just four hits while walking two and striking out 10 in a win which also happens to be the last time the 'Topes beat the RedHawks. In fact, the left-hander has seemed to solve the riddle that is Isotopes Park. In his last three starts at The Lab, Keiser is 3-0 with a 0.45 ERA, giving up just one earned run in 19.2 innings-pitched.

IN RUSS WE TRUST: Over his last seven at-bats, Russ Mitchell is a perfect 7-for-7, meaning that if he gets a hit in next official at-bat, the infielder will tie a franchise record of consecutive at-bats with a hit of eight, set by Robert Andino on June 7-9, 2007 and tied by John Gall from June 14-15, 2008. With two walks sprinkled in from last night's game, Mitchell has reached base safely in nine straight plate appearances, also one short of the record set during Andino's streak in 2007 when he had eight hits and two walks.

A TRAY OF HOMERS: Speaking of streaks, Trayvon Robinson has belted a home run in each of his last four games, tying a team season-high set by Jerry Sands from April 9 to April 12. Over his current streak, the red-hot Robinson has gone 7-for-16 (a .438 average) with six runs, and an incredible nine RBI. Since June 1 Robinson has belted 14 homers, second-most in the PCL over that span to Iowa slugger Bryan LaHair's 16.

HOME HANGOVERS: Normally virtually unbeatable at Isotopes Park, the 'Topes have lost their last four games at The Lab, tying a season-high. With last night's loss, Albuquerque is 4-5 in the month of July at home, equaling the number of home defeats the Isotopes have suffered in any previous month this season. The 'Topes also continue to struggle with the RedHawks, who have take five in a row from Albuquerque, one shy of their longest winning streak against the 'Topes in franchise history.

**BOBBLE BOBBLE:** On Friday, the Isotopes kick off the weekend in style with the team's annual Orbit bobble giveaway courtesy of Sandia Resort, which this year will be a bobble-body! Be sure to get here early, because they'll be gone fast. Gates open at 6:05 PM.

**DUKES RETRO NIGHT!:** The Isotopes will turn back the clock for Dukes Retro Night, when the team will sport the mustard-yellow duds the Dukes made famous in 1971. Also on tap for the night is the team's annual induction ceremony to the Albuquerque Professional Baseball Hall of Fame, where Brian Traxler, Ted Power, and Jason Wood will be honored.
