'TOPES SWEEP TWIN-BILL FROM REDHAWKS: The Albuquerque Isotopes combined timely offense and stifling pitching to grab a doubleheader sweep over the Oklahoma City RedHawks by the scores of 8-4 and 6-1 on a splendid Thursday night at Isotopes Park. Albuquerque jumped out to a quick lead in the first contest of the evening, plating four quick runs, all with two out. With Russ Mitchell on second, Jamie Hoffmann started the uprising with an RBI single and promptly stole second, from where he scored on a base hit by A.J. Ellis to put the Isotopes on top 2-0. Pitcher Randy Keisler then hammered a ball off the wall in right center, scoring Ellis and increasing the advantage to 3-0 'Topes. Dee Gordon then capped the scoring with a bases-clearing triple, putting the home team ahead 4-0. The 'Hawks would roar back with four in the fourth to briefly tie the contest, but Albuquerque scored twice in the bottom of the frame on a two-run single by Ivan DeJesus Jr. to put the Isotopes back on top 6-4. DeJesus would tack on another RBI with a run-scoring double, his second two-bagger of the night, in the sixth making the score 7-4 before Mitchell added an RBI double of his own to send Albuquerque cruising to an 8-4 game-one win. Albuquerque would need much less offense in the second game thanks to another masterful performance by starting pitcher Dana Eveland. The left-hander tossed six strong innings, allowing one run on four hits while walking one and striking out seven to earn his 10th win of the year. After each teams traded runs, Albuquerque scored the go-ahead tally in the bottom of the second on an RBI single by Corey Smith to grab a 2-1 edge. The Isotopes would keep the 'Hawks around until the sixth, at which point the 'Topes finally put the visitors away with a four-run frame en route to a 6-1 win and a doubleheader sweep.

PITCHING HEATS UP IN THE MONTH OF J-ELY: Right-hander John Ely continues to dominate the month of July, winning all three of his starts in the month while posting a 1.89 ERA (4 ER / 19.0 IP), the fourth lowest by any PCL pitcher in the month. In his last start at home, on July 8 vs. Nashville, Ely allowed just one run on six hits in seven innings while walking none and striking out five in a 7-1 Isotopes win, the right-hander's third quality start at Isotopes Park.

A RECORD FOR RUSS: With a base hit in his first at-bat in the first game of last night's doubleheader, Russ Mitchell equaled a team record by collecting a hit in eight straight at-bats, tying a franchise mark set by Robert Andino on June 7-9, 2007 and equaled by John Gall on June 14-15, 2008. Mitchell also equaled Andino's streak of reaching base in 10 straight plate appearances, which the

long-time 'Topes shortstop set concurrent with his at-bat hit streak. Mitchell has now hit in a season-high eight straight games, a span in which he's batted .500 (14x28) with six runs, three doubles, a triple, two homers, and eight RBI.

CATCHING SOME Z'S: Albuquerque begins its final home series of the season against division rival New Orleans looking to continue its winning way sagainst the Z's in the Duke City. The 'Topes have won their last six home series against the Zephyrs, going an astonishing 21-4 against New Orleans over that span. The last time the Z's won a series in Albuquerque was July 4-6, 2008, when they won two of three games from the 'Topes. In their first meeting at The Lab this year, the Isotopes took three of four.

IVAN-NNA ROCK: Ivan DeJesus Jr. has collected hits in nine of his last 10 games, posting a .341 (14x41) average since July 9. His latest streak, the infielder has hit in seven straight, just continues a torrid month of July in which he's batted .347 (17x49) over 14 games.

BOBBLE BOBBLE: Tonight the Isotopes kick off the weekend in style with the team's annual Orbit bobble giveaway courtesy of Sandia Resort, which this year will be a bobble-body!

DUKES RETRO NIGHT!: The Isotopes will turn back the clock for Dukes Retro Night, when the team will sport the mustard-yellow jerseys the Dukes made famous in 1971. Also on tap for the night is the team's annual induction ceremony to the Albuquerque Professional Baseball Hall of Fame, where Brian Traxler, Ted Power, and Jason Wood will be honored.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander John Ely makes the start riding a three-game winning streak, his longest of the year, after a victory in Nashville on July 17 when he pitched five innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking three and striking out four in a 9-5 Isotopes win.

Had a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game...selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
