ISOTOPES OVERCOME ZEPHYRS IN WILD, 12-10 WIN: The Albuquerque Isotopes saw a six-run lead disappear only to get two clutch home runs in the eighth inning by Justin Sellers and Jay Gibbons to complete a wild, 12-10 win over the New Orleans Zephyrs Friday night at Isotopes Park. With the Isotopes holding a seemingly comfortable 9-3 advantage, the Zephyrs plated five runs in the sixth to get right back into the contest. With one out in the frame, the Z's had eight straight batters reach base, four via the two-bagger, to climb within 9-8. The inning could've been much worse if not for the heroics of reliever Ramon Troncoso, who inherited the bases loaded with one out and immediately coaxed a double-play by Ozzie Martinez to end the threat and the frame. The twin-killing merely delayed the inevitable, however, as New Orleans scored twice in the eighth on RBI singles by Mike Cervenak and Martinez gave the visitors an improbable 10-9 lead. Undaunted, the 'Topes rallied in the bottom of the eighth. Sellers led off the inning by smashing a solo homer to knot the game at 10-10. After A.J. Ellis hit a single that hugged the third base line until bouncing off the third base bag, Gibbons delivered a monstrous two-run homer to right that gave the Isotopes the lead right back at 12-10. Closer Jon Link would make it stand, retiring the Z's in order, two by strikeout, in the top of the ninth to seal the 12-10 'Topes triumph.

WE'LL ALWAYS HAVE PARISI: Right-hander Mike Parisi makes his first appearance for the Isotopes after the Dodgers signed him to a minor league contract on July 20. Prior to that, Parisi had been a standout in the independent Atlantic League, going 6-4 with a 3.50 ERA (31 ER / 79.2 IP) in 13 starts for the Long Island Ducks. The right-hander pitched a four-hit shutout on June 15 at Lancaster and earned a selection to the Atlantic League All-Star game on July 13, when he pitched a scoreless second inning. The key to Parisi's career of late hasn't been effectiveness but rather health. Last season, after being selected by the Cubs from the Cardinals in the 2009 Rule 5 Draft, Parisi appeared in six games before undergoing season-ending surgery in May to remove bone chips from his right elbow. In 2008, after making his Major League debut with the Cardinals, what should have been a break-out season for the right-hander was cut short in August when he had to have Tommy John surgery, which essentially kept him out nearly all of 2009.

A.J. THE HAMMER: As part of 4-for-4 performance last night, A.J. Ellis connected on his first home run since August 26, 2008, a span of 636 at-bats (both Major and Minor League combined) between dingers. In the five games he's played with Albuquerque since returning from his latest stint with the Dodgers, Ellis has gone 8-for-17 (.471) with six runs, two doubles, the homer, and eight RBI.

TORRID TRAY: Speaking of homers, Trayvon Robinson has belted seven home runs in his last nine games, bringing his total on the year to 26, tied for second-most in the PCL with Reno's Cody Ransom (who just joined the Diamondbacks), behind Iowa's Bryan LaHair, who paces the PCL with 28.

BACK ON TRACK: By virtue of last night's win and Thursday's doubleheader sweep, the 'Topes have won three straight games and have prevailed in six of their last eight contests. Most importantly, the Isotopes are creeping back into the race for the PCL's American Southern Division. After falling a season-high eight games behind division-leading Round Rock on July 19, Albuquerque has made up three games in three days to draw within five games, the closest the 'Topes have been to the top spot since they were five games back on July 10.

DUKES RETRO NIGHT!: To pay tribute to the great baseball history in the city of Albuquerque, the Isotopes will wear yellow Dukes jerseys, made legendary by the 1972 Dukes, who were managed by Tommy Lasorda and won the PCL Championship. There must be some old Dukes magic left in the air. Since the Isotopes started Dukes Retro night in 2005, they are 5-1 when sporting Dukes duds.

HALL OF FAME TRIO!: Tonight the Isotopes are privileged to honor three legends of Albuquerque baseball history; Brian Traxler, Ted Power, and Jason Wood. All three will be honored before tonight's game in a special on-field ceremony. Wood will be on hand to accept the honor, while Power will not be able to attend due to emergency hip replacement surgery. Accepting the honor for Traxler, who passed away in 2004 is his widow Gabby.

BIG HOMESTAND ROLLS ON: After Dukes Night, the 'Topes' big homestand continues tomorrow with the first and only appearance by the Zooperstars, presented by Arby's. On Monday, the Isotopes will play their final Business Person's Special of the 2011 season with first pitch slated for 12:05 PM.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Mike Parisi makes his Isotopes debut after being signed from the Long Island Ducks of the independent Atlantic League on July 20.

Went 6-4 with a 3.50 ERA (31 ER / 79.2 IP) in 13 games (all starts) with the Ducks, including a shutout, authored on June 15 at Lancaster when allowed just four hits over nine scoreless innings while walking two and striking out nine in a 6-0 Long Island win

Selected to the Atlantic League All-Star team and pitched a perfect second inning in the Atlantic League All-Star Game on July 13 at York, PA.

Struck out a season-high 10 in seven innings in a 3-1 win vs. Southern Maryland on May 11, while allowing one run on four hits and two walks.

2010: Selected by the Cubs from St. Louis in the Major League portion of the Rule 5 Draft on December 10, 2009 and spent an injury-plagued season in the Cubs organization. Started the season at Triple-A Iowa, going 0-3 with a 8.50 ERA (17 ER / 18.0 IP) before being transferred to Double-A Tennessee, where he appeared in one game, allowing one run on three hits in 2.2 innings. Diagnosed with bone chips in his right shoulder and had season-ending surgery in May.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Limited to just five outings in 2009 while recovering from Tommy John surgery... went 0-2 with 4.70 ERA (8 ER / 15.1 IP) in stops between the Gulf Coast League Cardinals and the Single-A Palm Beach Cardinals... posted a 1.17 ERA (1 ER / 7.2 IP) with a 0-1 record, nine strikeouts and a 0.83 average against (2x24) in three starts with the GCL Cardinals... joined Palm Beach on August 28, going 0-1 with an 8.22 ERA (7 ER / 7.2 IP) in two starts... played for the Surprise Rafters of the Arizona Fall League, going 3-2 with a 4.44 ERA (13 ER / 26.1 IP) with 15 strikeouts and a .257 average against.

Made his Major League debut in two stints with the St. Louis Cardinals in 2008... posted an 8.22 ERA (21 ER / 23.0 IP) in 12 appearances (two starts) in two stints with the Cardinals... made his Major League debut on May 5 at Colorado, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings... went 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA (36 ER / 84.0 IP) in 15 starts with Triple-A Memphis... had season-ending Tommy John surgery on August 20.0

Spent the majority of the 2007 in Triple-A Memphis, setting career-highs in starts (28) and innings-pitched (165.0) in his first action at the Triple-A level... was 8-13 with a 4.91 ERA (90 ER / 165.0 IP) for the Redbirds... opened the season with a three-game winning streak, April 10-30, going 3-0 with a .10 ERA (9 ER / 19.1 IP) during that span (four games)... held the opposition to a .247 batting average (19x77) with runners in scoring position and two outs... had a 3.62 ERA (32 ER / 79.2 IP) in 13 starts at AutoZone Park... tossed 6.0 or more innings in 18 of his 28 starts, including eight straight from May 21 to June 27.

Was 9-8 with a 4.60 ERA (77 ER / 150.2 IP) in 27 starts for Double-A Springfield in 2006

Established career marks in wins (10) and strikeouts (129) between Single-A Quad Cities and Palm Beach in 2005... went 10-11 with a 3.68~ERA~(67~ER/~164.0~IP) in a combined 27~starts between both stops.

After being selected by the Cardinals in the ninth round of the 2004 draft, made his professional debut by going a combned 5-3 with a 3.88 ERA (31 ER / 72.0 IP) in 13 starts with Single-A New Jersey and Single-A Peoria.
