ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (55-50) AT OMAHA STORM CHASERS (56-48)

'TOPES CHASED DOWN BY OMAHA IN 6-4 LOSS: The Albuquerque Isotopes took a lead into the eighth inning, only to watch the Omaha Storm Chasers score three times and surge to a 6-4 come-from-behind win Wednesday night at Werner Park. Clinging to a 4-3 lead in the bottom of the eighth, the 'Topes turned to reliever Roy Corcoran, who surrendered back-to-back one-out singles to David Lough and Lorenzo Cain that put the tying tally in scoring position. Clint Robinson then smashed a double off the wall in left, scoring both runners and giving Omaha the 5-4 lead. After Robinson scampered to third on the throw home, he was immediately cashed in by a sacrifice fly off the bat of Kila Ka'aihue to extend the home team's advantage to 6-4. The Isotopes tried to mount a rally in the top of the ninth, with Dee Gordon hitting a one-out single and Ivan De Jesus Jr. reaching on a walk to put the tying run in scoring position for Albuquerque. Chasers closer Jesse Chavez doused the rally in short order, however, striking out two of the 'Topes' hottest hitters, Jay Gibbons and Russ Mitchell, in succession to seal the 6-4 Storm Chasers win. Albuquerque spotted Omaha a run in the bottom of the first on a solo homer by Cain, but quickly erased the deficit with three runs in the top half of the second. After base hits by Jerry Sands and Damaso Espino, Joe Becker gave the 'Topes a lead with one swing of the bat, crushing a three-run blast to left that handed the visitors a 3-1 advantage. The Isotopes augmented the lead in the fifth, when Gibbons hit a solo homer right that increased the cushion to 4-1, but the Chasers closed the deficit in the bottom of the fifth on an RBI triple by Johnny Giavotella, who immediately came home on a wild pitch by 'Topes starter John Ely to make the score 4-3.

THE WIN KING: Lefty Dana Eveland makes the start riding a three-game winning streak that has propelled him to the top in the PCL with 10 victories on season, one of just three pitchers in Triple-A Baseball to reach double-digits in wins (Julio Teheran of Gwinnett has 11; Jeanmar Gomez of Columbus also has 10). Not only has Eveland won his last three starts, he's been dominating, not allowing more than one earned run in any of the three outings to post an ERA of 1.29 (3 ER / 21.0 IP). Not only does the left-hander have a chance to win his fourth straight game, he has a chance to exact a little revenge on the Storm Chasers. With a record against Omaha of 1-2, the Chasers are the only team Eveland has faced this year against whom he has a losing record.

A DOZEN FOR GIBBY: Any concerns that Jay Gibbons' eyes are still bothering him have been emphatically put to rest, as the slugging outfielder has hit in 12 straight games, the second-longest hitting streak by an Isotope this year. Since the streak began in the second game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 14, Gibbons has batted .373 (19x51) with eight runs, a double, three homers, and nine RBI. Of the 12 games in which he's gotten a hit, six have been multi-hit performances.

A WALK IN THE PARK: Last night, Russ Mitchell drew four walks, tying a franchise record set five previous times but a feat that hadn't been accomplished since A.J. Ellis drew four free-passes on June 6, 2009 vs. Oklahoma City. As a team, the Isotopes have drawn 401 walks and with 39 games to play, they are on pace to break the team mark for walks in a season of 541 set in 2004

HOMER HAPPENINGS: Albuquerque has belted a homer in each of its last seven games, racking up 13 dingers in that span. The Isotopes have now hit 34 home runs this month, tied for third-most in the PCL behind Reno (38) and Sacramento (37).

NEXT HOMESTAND BECKONS: After eight days on the road, the 'Topes are back in town next Wednesday for an eight-game homestand that kicks off the final month of the regular season in style. The fun starts a Lunch Bag giveaway on August 4 courtesy of Webster University, and continues with an Orbit Bank giveaway on Friday, August 5 courtesy of U.S. Bank and a postgame fireworks show on Saturday, August 6.

TODAY'S START: Lefty Dana Eveland makes the start riding a three-game winning streak after earning a victory in the second game of a doubleheader on July 21 vs. Oklahoma City when he allowed one run on just four hits in six innings while walking one and striking out seven in a 6-1 Isotopes win, Eveland's league-leading 10th of the season.

Appeared in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 in Salt Lake City, UT where he pitched a one-two-three fourth inning in the PCL's 3-0 loss to the International League.

Selected to pitch in the Triple-A All-Star game at Salt Lake, becoming just the fourth pitcher in team history to receive the honor, the last being starter Charlie Haeger in 2009.

Posted quality starts in eight straight outings from May 13 to June 20, going 4-1 with a $2.94~{\rm ERA}$ (17 ER / $54.0~{\rm IP}$) in that span.

Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 inningspitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances...with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
