ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (42-40) AT OMAHA STORM CHASERS (46-37)

'TOPES DROP 10TH STRAIGHT WITH 4-1 LOSS: For the second straight night, the Albuquerque Isotopes offense could not solve the riddle of Omaha Storm Chasers pitching, falling 4-1 Saturday night at Werner Park. The 'Topes jumped out to the game's first lead in the second inning when Trayvon Robinson drew a lead-off walk and advanced to second on a groundout, setting up Jamie Hoffmann, who roped a single to right, easily plating the base runner and giving Albuquerque a quick 1-0 advantage. The Chasers almost immediately retaliated to Albuquerque's run, grabbing a lead in the bottom of the third. Joaquin Arias led off the frame with a triple and was picked up two batters later when Johnny Giavotella smashed a two-run homer to left, putting the home team on top 2-1. Omaha augmented its advantage in the fifth when Giavotella lifted a sacrifice fly, scoring Irving Falu and making the score 3-1, Chasers. They didn't need it, but the Storm Chasers would tack on one more tally of insurance in the sixth, as Clint Robinson led off the inning with a single before scampering into third on a double to right by Lorenzo Cain. Kila Ka'aihue then laced a single to right, plating Robinson and giving Omaha a 4-1 victory.

ELY'S TURN: Tasked tonight with putting an end to Albuquerque's record losing streak is right-hander John Ely, who takes the mound looking to turn around what was a tough June. In five starts last month, Ely posted a 1-2 record with a 9.00 ERA (28 ER / 28.0 IP) as opposed to the 2-2 record and 4.39 ERA (27 ER / 55.1 IP) he put up in nine starts over the months of April and May combined. Most befuddling is the right-hander's sudden vulnerability to the long ball. After yielding just five home runs in his nine starts in April and May, Ely allowed nine homers in five starts in June, giving him a team-high 14 on the season. Last year, in 13 total starts for the 'Topes, the righty conceded just 10 homers in 68 total innings.

THE STREAK TURNS TEN: With last night's defeat, the Isotopes have dropped 10 straight games, a franchise record and the second longest losing streak in Albuquerque Triple-A history to a 12-game skid suffered by the Dukes in 1985. The streak is also tied for the longest in the PCL this year with Las Vegas, who lost 10 in a row from April 20 to April 30. Albuquerque's last victory came on June 21, when the team was a season-high 12 games over .500 and 1.5 games up in the PCL's American Southern Division. Now, Albuquerque is two games over .500 for the first time since April 25, when the team was 10-8. The Isotopes are also now a season-high six games behind Round Rock in the division, having dropped five games in five days.

I'M A PFEIFFER, HE'S A PFEIFFER: Thanks to another scoreless inning last night, left-hander David Pfeiffer continues to acquit himself well in his first taste of Triple-A. Pfeiffer has allowed just one run in seven innings over four appearances (a 1.29 ERA) while striking out nine and walking just two. Left-handed hitters are batting just .200 (2x10) against him.

AVOIDING THE BROOM: In addition to breaking their 10-game losing streak, the Isotopes are looking to avoid their second straight series sweep. The 'Topes have only been swept by Omaha once in team history and that was exactly eight years ago, when the then O-Royals took four straight games from Albuquerque at Isotopes Park on June 30-July 3, 2003.

A FINE FOURTH IS COMING UP TOMORROW!: The 'Topes are gearing up for a sensational Fourth of July celebration, featuring the biggest and best fireworks show in town, courtesy of U.S. Bank. Before the game, local bluegrass band "Family Coal" will get fans geared up for baseball with a pre-game concert on the field from 5:40 pm to 6:40 pm. Gates open at 5:30 pm so fans can stake out a great spot early!

TODAY'S START: John Ely makes his 15th start of the season coming off a nodecision on June 27 at Iowa when he allowed four runs on six hits in six innings in a game eventually lost by the 'Topes 6-5 in 15 innings.

Had a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game...selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
