ISOTOPES ROUTED BY STORM CHASERS: A night removed from throwing a shutout, the Albuquerque Isotopes yielded 10 runs as the Omaha Storm Chasers cruised to a 10-1 victory Friday night at Werner Park. Ultimately, it was the long-ball that ended up spelling doom for the 'Topes and the tone was set early with a solo homer by David Lough in the bottom of the first that put the Chasers up 1-0 after one inning. The 'Topes matched Lough's blast in the third on a solo homer by Justin Sellers that briefly knotted the game at 1-1, but Omaha got the run right back in the bottom of the frame to take a 2-1 edge. After Isotopes starter Mike Parisi loaded the bases on two walks and a single, the right-hander departed for Ramon Troncoso, who promptly gave up a grand-slam home run to Salvador Perez, making the score 7-1 Storm Chasers. Omaha was far from finished, scoring three more times in the seventh, increasing the cushion to 10-1 Storm Chasers. Meanwhile, a quartet of Omaha pitchers shut the Isotopes offense down to just one run on six hits. Starter Sean O'Sullivan (3-2) cruised to victory after allowing one run on three hits in six innings while walking two and striking out five before handing off to relievers Kelvin Herrera, Everett Teaford, and Robinson Tejada, who each authored a scoreless inning apiece to seal the 10-1 victory.

HEROIC HURLER: Right-hander Tim Sexton takes the mound coming off perhaps one of the most heroic outings by an Isotopes starter all season. With the Isotopes' bullpen totally depleted, Sexton battled through five innings in a game vs. New Orleans at Isotopes Park on July 24. Although he gave up a franchise-record 16 earned runs in an eventual 17-9 loss to the Z's that was shortened to seven innings due to a lightning storm, Sexton's work enabled the 'Topes to have a fresh bullpen the next day when Joe Newby was forced to make spot-start as well as for the first game in Omaha. By weathering the Zephyrs storm, the right-hander enabled the pitching-short 'Topes to get through the next two or three games. Now Sexton gets a chance to return the favor in New Orleans while also snapping a season-high five-game losing streak. This season the right-hander has been solid on the road, going 3-2 with a 5.04 ERA (17 ER / 30.1 IP) in six starts.

IT'S BIG, BUT NOT SO EASY: The Isotopes are back in New Orleans to renew acquaintances with the Zephyrs, who the 'Topes just played at Isotopes Park four days ago. Albuquerque looks to snap a two-game losing streak to the Z's as well as turn around its

fortunes in the Crescent City. Dating back to last year, the Isotopes have dropped six of their last seven games at the Shrine on Airline including a series in the Big Easy at the end of May in which the Zephyrs took three of four.

THE BEAT GOES ON: With two of the Isotopes six hits last night, Jay Gibbons extended his current hitting streak to 14 straight games, second longest on the team behind a pair of 16-game streaks by Trayvon Robinson. Over the course of his current tear, which began with a pinch-hit single in the second game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 14, Gibbons is batting a scintillating .440 (22x50) with eight runs, two doubles, three homers, and nine RBI. The outfielder has also gotten his hottest lately, going 7-for-17 (.412) in the Isotopes' just-completed series at Omaha.

SPEAKING OF STREAKS: After striking out in his first three at-bats, A.J. Ellis poked a single to right-center field in the top of the ninth, which not only spared him a hitless night, but also extended his current on-base streak to 34 games, third longest in the PCL this season behind two former Isotopes. Fresno's Edgar Gonzalez reached base in 42 straight games from May 25 to July 7 and Reno's Tony Abreu reached in 35 games from May 26 to July 10. Ellis is batting .343 (36x105) over his streak while posting an on-base percentage of 514.

NEXT HOMESTAND BECKONS: After four more days on the road, the 'Topes are back in town next Wednesday for an eight-game homestand that kicks off the final month of the regular season in style. The fun starts with a Lunch Bag giveaway on August 4 courtesy of Webster University, and continues with an Orbit Bank giveaway on Friday, August 5 courtesy of U.S. Bank and a post-game fireworks show on Saturday, August 6.

TODAY'S START: Tim Sexton looks to snap a five-game losing streak, coming off a defeat vs. New Orleans when he yielded a franchise-record 16 earned runs on 17 hits in five innings while walking two and striking out one in a 17-9 loss that shortened to seven innings due to a lightning storm.

Had a tough no-decision on June 23 vs. Oklahoma City at Isotopes Park. After coming into the game in the second inning in relief of Dodgers rehabbing closer Jonathan Broxton, Sexton tossed six strong innings, allowing just two runs, one earned, on six hits while walking one and striking out four. The right-hander was in line to the get win, departing with a 3-2 lead, but the RedHawks plated five in the eighth en route to an 8-6 win

Won his third straight start on June 13 at Oklahoma City when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs no eight hits while walking one and striking out two in a 4-3 'Topes win. Earned his first career Triple-A win, a 5-4 triumph at Memphis on June 2 when he allowed two runs on six hits in five innings while walking two and striking out three.

Enjoyed an excellent outing in his debut with the Isotopes on May 23 vs. Colorado Springs when he pitched six strong innings, allowing one run (an Ian Stewart solo homer) on just three hits while walking none and striking out three in a 5-4 Albuquerque win.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a $3.64~\rm ERA~(19~\rm ER~47.0~\rm IP)$. Went 1-0 with a $1.64~\rm ERA~(2~\rm ER~/11.0~\rm IP)$ in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 20

2010: Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played a second full season at Single-A Inland Empire in 2009, going 8-14 with a 3.96 ERA (69 ER / 157.0 IP) in 27 games (22 starts)... tied for the club lead with eight wins and 22 starts... ranked third on the team with a career-high 100 strikeouts... tossed a career-high 157 innings, tops in the Dodger organization and second in the California League... selected to the California League midseason All-Star Team, posting a 3.21 ERA (27 ER / 75.2 IP) in 13 games (10 starts) before the All-Star break... won the July Dodger Pride Award for Inland Empire, going 4-1 with a 3.47 ERA (14 ER / 36.1 IP) in six July starts... threw 7.0 innings or more in seven of his outings.

Spent the full 2008 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 5-12 with a 6.04 ERA (95 ER / 141.2 IP) in 28 games (26 starts)... struck out 92 while walking 36 in his 141.2 innings... named California League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 14-20 when he went 2-0 with an 0.75 ERA (1 ER / 12.0 IP).

Began his professional career in 2007 with Single-A Great Lakes, going 3-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER / 22.2 IP) in five games (no starts)... rated as the 24th best prospect in the Dodger organization and as having the fifth-best pro debut among all Junior College players from the 2007 draft by *Baseball America*.
