Z'S WALK-OFF WITH 2-1, 10-INNING WIN: The Albuquerque Isotopes were unable to hold on to a late lead as the New Orleans Zephyrs scored once in the eighth and another in the 10th on a walk-off bunt to take a 2-1 series-opening 10-inning win Saturday night at Zephyr Field. With the 'Topes clinging to a 1-0 lead, the Zephyrs mounted a two-out rally when Jorge Padilla roped a double to right with a man on first, putting the tying and go-ahead runs in scoring position. An intentional walk to Joe Thurston loaded the bases for Jose Lopez, who bounced a grounder to third. Russ Mitchell made a diving stop, popped to his feet and threw to first, but Jerry Sands couldn't keep his foot on the bag and Lopez reached safely while Brad Davis scored on the RBI infield single that knotted the game at 1-1. Albuquerque escaped further damage in the eighth and held off New Orleans in the ninth before the Zephyrs broke through again in the 10th. Mike Cervenak led off the frame with a double off reliever Joe Newby, bringing up Padilla, who dropped down a perfect sacrifice bunt. Newby leaped off the mound and picked up the ball, but his throw to first sailed up the right field line, allowing Cervenak to come home and deal the Isotopes a frustrating 2-1 extra-inning loss. The 'Topes got their only run courtesy of a big fly from Sands, who broke a scoreless tie in the fifth with a solo homer to left center that gave the visitors a 1-0 lead.

RANDY'S HANDY: Lefty starter Randy Keisler makes his 13th start of the season and going for his seventh victory while coming off a start on July 26 at Omaha when he pitched well but ended up with a no-decision. Keisler tossed seven innings, allowing four runs, only two of them earned, on eight hits while walking one and striking out two in game eventually won by the Isotopes 6-4 on a two-run, ninth-inning home run by Russ Mitchell. In that contest, Keisler pitched a season-high 107 pitches, but reaching the century mark or coming close has become commonplace for the left-hander. In each of his last nine appearances, Keisler has thrown 90 pitches or more and in each of those outings he's pitched through the fifth inning. In fact, the last time he failed to get his team into the sixth was on April 21 at Iowa, his last start before going on the DL with a strained right groin and hamstring.

TRADE WINDS: The Dodgers today officially dealt shortstop Rafael Furcal to the St. Louis Cardinals, opening the door for Dee Gordon to assume the duties of every-day shortstop in Los Angeles for the rest of the season. In 22 games with the Dodgers from June 6 to July 2, Gordon batted .232 (19x82) with 11 runs scored and nine stolen bases. The fleet-footed Gordon was nothing short of spectacular this season for the 'Topes, batting .333 (96x288) with 51 runs scored, 10 doubles, six triples and 30 stolen bases in 70 games. In

the 20 games with the 'Topes since Gordon returned from the Dodgers, he batted .375 (33x88) with 17 runs, three doubles, four triples, and eight stolen bases. In return for Furcal and cash considerations, the Dodgers received outfielder Alex Castellanos, who will report to Double-A Chattanooga.

ROMAN RETURNS: Albuquerque bullpen gets a boost today with the arrival of right-handed reliever Roman Colon, who is back after missing over two months with a fractured right foot suffered when he was hit by a line-drive at Tucson on May 17. Before he was injured, Colon was one of the Isotopes' most reliable relievers, going 1-0 with a 4.61 ERA (7 ER / 13.2 IP) in 13 games. With Gordon leaving and Colon returning, there is no shortage of arms, as the Isotopes are currently carrying 13 pitchers and 11 position players.

NARROW MARGINS: Zephyr Field has a reputation for being a pitcher's paradise, which translates directly to close games. Each of the last four games the Isotopes have played at Zephyr Field have been decided by one run, with the 'Topes dropping three of them. In five games played in the Big Easy, the Isotopes and Zephyrs have combined for 37 total runs, with the 'Topes having been outscored 16-21. By comparison, in the four-game set the two teams just played in Albuquerque, they combined for 83 runs, with Isotopes being outscored 37-46.

NEXT HOMESTAND BECKONS: The 'Topes are back in town next Wednesday for an eight-game homestand that kicks off the final month of the regular season in style. The fun starts with a Lunch Bag giveaway on August 4 courtesy of Webster University, and continues with an Orbit Bank giveaway on Friday, August 5 courtesy of U.S. Bank and a post-game fireworks show on Saturday, August 6.

Earned his second win of the season on June 11 vs. Nashville when he allowed just one run on just four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 5-2 'Topes win. Also pitched a gem on June 6 at Round Rock when he tossed six shutout innings, allowing just six hits and a walk while striking out four in an 11-0 win, his first victory of the season.

Earned PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for his back-to-back starts on June 6 and June 11 in which he went a combined 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER / 13.0 IP) while walking two and

Strained his right groin and hamstring in a start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).
