ELY ELECTRIFIES IN 2-0 ISOTOPES WIN: With the Albuquerque Isotopes desperate for a win, starting pitcher John Ely delivered a gem, keeping the Omaha Storm Chasers at bay through seven strong innings to send the 'Topes to a dramatic 2-0 win Sunday night at Werner Park. Ely was magnificent, tossing seven shutout innings in which he allowed just four hits, all of them singles, and two walks while striking one to earn his fourth victory of the season. Ely coaxed 14 groundball outs on the evening, and allowed an Omaha base runner to reach second base just twice. The entire offensive output for either team came in the fifth on one swing of the bat. Jamie Hoffmann led off the inning with a single in front of Russ Mitchell, who blasted a two-run homer deep over the fence in left to give the 'Topes a 2-0 advantage. Ely handed off to Merkin Valdez, who authored a scoreless eighth before closer Jon Link took charge, pitching around a one-out single in the ninth before striking out Manuel Pina on three pitches to seal the Isotopes victory. Link, who fanned two in the ninth, nailed down his eighth save of the season.

SEXTON SUPERIORITY: In three appearances, two starts, at Isotopes Park, right-hander Tim Sexton has yet to pick up a decision, with all of his 3-1 record having been acquired on the road. Sexton almost picked up a win in his last outing at The Lab on June 23 vs. Oklahoma City when he entered the game in the second inning after a rehab appearance by Jonathan Broxton and proceeded to carve up the RedHawks for six innings, allowing just two runs, one earned, on six hits while walking one and striking out four. Although the right-hander departed with a 3-2 win, Oklahoma City erupted for five runs in the eighth en route to an 8-6 win and tough-luck no-decision for Sexton. One of his three victories, however, has come against Round Rock, as the right-hander allowed the Express just two runs on seven hits in 5.2 innings in a 6-3 win at The Dell Diamond on June 7.

IT'S GO TIME!: Albuquerque welcomes its nemesis, the Round Rock Express, to Isotopes Park for the first time in 2011 while looking to make up some ground in the PCL American Southern Division. Certainly the Express will have revenge on their minds after the 'Topes took three of four in Round Rock at the beginning of June, but Albuquerque has played its Texas rivals tough at The Lab. All-time, the Isotopes are 30-18 at home against Round Rock and have won six of their last eight against the Express in the Duke City dating back to last year, including their last three.

HOME COOKIN': Albuquerque returns to Isotopes Park tonight where the 'Topes have been excellent this season, despite three straight losses against Oklahoma City to close out last homestand. With a record of 26-14, the Isotopes boast the best home record by percentage (.650) in the Pacific Coast League and as a team are batting a whopping .327 at The Lab.

CONSISTENCY, THY NAME IS HOFFMANN: Jamie Hoffmann continues to be a steady presence in the 'Topes lineup, with hits in his last six games and in 12 of his last 15. Since June 17, Hoffmann is batting .309 (17x55) with 11 runs, four homers, and 15 RBI in 15 games.

HAPPY FOURTH!: Tonight marks just the third time in team history that the Isotopes have been at home on the Fourth of July, with their last home Fourth taking place vs. New Orleans in 2008. In 2005, the Isotopes also hosted the Oklahoma RedHawks on Independence Day, making July 4th at Isotopes Park a tradition celebrated every three years. In team history, the 'Topes are 4-3 on the Fourth of July and 1-1 at home.

THE FOURTH IS JUST THE BEGINNING!: Tonight's July 4th celebration is just the start of a big seven-game homestand at Isotopes Park! Tomorrow, the first 3,000 fans will get free Koozies courtesy of Greystar, followed by ALS night on Wednesday and an inflatable bat giveaway on Thursday.

TODAY'S START: Righty Tim Sexton takes the mound coming off his first Triple-A loss on June 28 at Iowa when he pitched 4.2 innings, allowing four runs on eight hits and a season-high four walks in a 10-4 loss to the Cubs.

Had a tough no-decision on June 23 vs. Oklahoma City at Isotopes Park. After coming into the game in the second inning in relief of Dodgers rehabbing closer Jonathan Broxton, Sexton tossed six strong innings, allowing just two runs, one earned, on six hits while walking one and striking out four. The right-hander was in line to the get win, departing with a 3-2 lead, but the RedHawks plated five in the eighth en route to an 8-6 win.

Won his third straight start on June 13 at Oklahoma City when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs no eight hits while walking one and striking out two in a 4-3 'Topes win. Earned his first career Triple-A win, a 5-4 triumph at Memphis on June 2 when he allowed two runs on six hits in five innings while walking two and striking out three.

Enjoyed an excellent outing in his debut with the Isotopes on May 23 vs. Colorado Springs when he pitched six strong innings, allowing one run (an Ian Stewart solo homer) on just three hits while walking none and striking out three in a 5-4 Albuquerque win.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP). Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 20.

2010: Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played a second full season at Single-A Inland Empire in 2009, going 8-14 with a 3.96 ERA (69 ER / 157.0 IP) in 27 games (22 starts)... tied for the club lead with eight wins and 22 starts... ranked third on the team with a career-high 100 strikeouts... tossed a career-high 157 innings, tops in the Dodger organization and second in the California League... selected to the California League mid-season All-Star Team, posting a 3.21 ERA (27 ER / 75.2 IP) in 13 games (10 starts) before the All-Star break... won the July Dodger Pride Award for Inland Empire, going 4-1 with a 3.47 ERA (14 ER / 36.1 IP) in six July starts... threw 7.0 innings or more in seven of his outings.

Spent the full 2008 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 5-12 with a 6.04 ERA (95 ER / 141.2 IP) in 28 games (26 starts)... struck out 92 while walking 36 in his 141.2 innings... named California League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 14-20 when he went 2-0 with an 0.75 ERA (1 ER / 12.0 IP).

Began his professional career in 2007 with Single-A Great Lakes, going 3-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER / 22.2 IP) in five games (no starts)... rated as the 24th best prospect in the Dodger organization and as having the fifth-best pro debut among all Junior College players from the 2007 draft by $Baseball\,America$.
