### ROUND ROCK EXPRESS (50-34) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (43-41)

**'TOPES FALL 13-10 IN FRONT OF RECORD-SETTING CROWD:** A record crowd of 16,059, the most ever to see a game at Isotopes Park, was not enough to lift the Albuquerque Isotopes, who dropped a tough, series-opening defeat to the Round Rock Express 13-10 on an otherwise spectacular July 4th Monday evening at The Lab. The Isotopes built a lead early only to watch it disappear late as Round Rock scored nine runs over the last four innings to surge ahead. With Albuquerque clinging to a 7-4 lead, the Express roared ahead with five runs in the sixth to grab their first lead of the game. With two on and two out, Omar Quintanilla laced a two-run double ahead of Chris Davis, who smashed a two-run homer, giving the visitors an 8-7 lead. Chad Tracy then immediately added a solo homer for back-to-back Round Rock homers and a 9-7 advantage. Albuquerque fought back in the bottom of the sixth when Damaso Espino led off the frame with a single and advanced to third on a double by Joe Becker. Justin Sellers then lifted a sacrifice fly to left, plating Espino and cutting the lead to 9-8. Russ Mitchell then blasted a two run shot to left, his second homer in as many games, giving the 'Topes a 10-9 edge. Again, the lead would not last, as the Express plated a pair of runs in the eighth on an RBI double by Davis and a run-scoring single by Esteban German before tacking on two more in the ninth on back-to-back RBI singles by Julio Borbon and Quintanilla to help Round Rock cruise to a 13-10 win.

**SNELL ON THE HILL:** Ian Snell takes the mound looking rediscover the form from his first start of the season at Isotopes Park, a solid no-decision vs. Iowa on June 19 when he allowed two runs on four hits in five innings of work in an eventual 8-5 'Topes defeat. In his two outings since that appearance, the right-hander has not made it into the fifth inning, allowing a total of 14 runs on 10 hits in eight innings or work (a 15.75 ERA). Snell has shown a proficiency in coaxing ground balls, which always plays well at Isotopes Park. In four total outings with the 'Topes, Snell's groundball to flyball ratio is 1.73, third-best on the Albuquerque pitching staff behind Dana Eveland (1.86) and Ramon Troncoso (1.79)

**MITCH MASH:** Since returning from a sore wrist that sidelined him for a little over a week, Russ Mitchell has displayed the power stroke that saw him rack up 23 homers on the PCL a year ago. Mitchell has belted two-run homers in each of the last two games, raising his total on the year to seven. Mitchell has also racked up hits in each of his last five contests, batting .353 (6x17) in that span.

**DEE'S BACK!:** The Isotopes just got a whole lot quicker with the return of shortstop Dee Gordon, who is back in Albuquerque after being optioned from the Dodgers yesterday to make room for former Isotope Eugenio Velez. In 22 games with LA after making his Major League debut on June 6, Gordon batted .232 (19x82) with 11 runs, two doubles, a triple, four RBI, and eight stolen bases. Gordon was called up when the Isotopes were in the middle of a series at Round Rock and now the shortstop picks up right where he left against the Express exactly a month later. In the time that Gordon was with the Dodgers, the 'Topes went 12-16.

**WHAT A CROWD!:** Last night's July 4th throng of 16,059, not only shattered the previous single-game mark of 15,358 (set on July 3, 2009), it was the highest attendance in all of Minor League Baseball last night.

**THE COUNTDOWN IS ON!:** With last night's record crowd, the Isotopes have drawn 314,061 fans in 41 openings this season and are well on their way to eclipsing the 5-million fan mark in franchise history. Currently, the 'Topes have drawn 4,961,203 since opening the doors to Isotopes Park in 2003, just 38,797 from the 5-million mark. The 5-millionth fan through the turnstiles will get a gift pack that includes round-trip airfare to Los Angeles on American Airlines, hotel, and two tickets to see a Dodgers game, among other assorted goodies!

**A FUN-FILLED HOMESTAND ROLLS ON!:** The July 4th was just the beginning to a homestand that is packed with fun promotions. Tonight, the first 3,000 fans will get free Koozies courtesy of Greystar, followed by ALS night tomorrow and an inflatable bat giveaway on Thursday.

**TODAY'S START:** Right-hander Ian Snell makes his fourth start of the season coming off a wild no-decision at Omaha on June 30 when he allowed eight runs, seven earned, on six hits in four innings of work while walking three and striking out three in an eventual 18-13 'Topes loss. Made one relief appearance for Albuquerque in the second game of a doubleheader on June 14 at Oklahoma City when he allowed one run (on a sixth-inning solo homer by Brian Dopirak) in one inning of work.

Signed with St. Louis to a minor league contract with an invite to Major League Spring Training on January 14. Sent to Minor League camp on March 13 but opted to retire instead. Signed with Los Angeles on May 25.

**2010:** Split the season between Seattle Mariners and Triple-A Tacoma... went 0-5, 6.41 in 12 games, making eight starts with Seattle before being designated for assignment on June 15... was outrighted June 19 and re-signed as a minor league free agent on June 22... went 0-5, 6.11 (24 ER / 35.1 IP) in eight starts... in four relief appearances posted a 7.36 ERA (9 ER / 11.0 IP)... made first relief appearance on May 6 vs. Tampa Bay, allowing two runs in 3.1 innings, his first relief appearance since August 12, 2005 at HOU... made final appearance June 14 at STL, allowing three hits and four runs in 2.0 innings... went 3-4, 6.66 (36 ER / 48.2 IP) in nine starts for Tacoma during the regular season... placed on 7-day disabled list August 5-September 7 with a right elbow strain... part of Tacoma's PCL Championship squad and appeared in three playoff games out of the bullpen (0-0, 4.15, 4.1 IP / 2 ER).

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Acquired by Seattle in 2009 from Pittsburgh in a 7-player trade on July 29 along with Jack Wilson in exchange for infielder Ronny Cedeno, catcher/first baseman Jeff Clement, right-hander Aaron Pribanic, right-hander Nathan Adcock, and right-hander Brett Lorin... in final nine starts of season, went 5-1, 3.00 ERA (17 ER / 51.0 IP)... his 3.00 ERA from August 15 to the end of season ranked 8th-best in the AL... his five wins were tied for 6th-best... lost 9 of his first 11 decisions (w/ PIT & SEA) before winning five of his final six... in five-week span, was optioned (June 25) to Triple-A Indianapolis by Pittsburgh, traded (July 29) to Seattle, optioned (July 29) to Tacoma by Seattle and recalled (July 31) to the Majors... made first start with Mariners on August 2 at Texas, recorded a no-decision allowing three hits and two runs in 6.0 IP... charged with first career error September 26 at Toronto; had not made an error in 128 consecutive chances to begin his career... optioned to Indianapolis on June 25... struck out a career-high 17 batters, including an Indianapolis team record 13 straight batters to start the game in his first start with Indy on June 28 vs. Toledo (no-decision)... represented Puerto Rico in 2009 World Baseball Classic making two starts: March 9 vs. Netherlands (4.0 IP, 3H, 1 ER, 5K) & lost to Venezuela March 16 allowing one earned run in 4.0 IP

In 2008, agreed to terms on a five-year contract with Pirates, including club options for the 2011 and 2012 seasons on March 16... made first Opening Day start on March 31 in ATL and received a no-decision (6.0 IP, 4 ER)... struck out season-high 10 batters while picking up first win on April 6 at Florida... on the disabled list June 26 (retro to June 23)-July 8 with a strained right elbow... posted a 3.68 ERA (18 ER / 44.0 IP) in his last eight starts and a 3.67 ERA in five September starts.

Led Pirates staff in 2007 in ERA (3.76), strikeouts (177) and innings pitched (208.0)... shared lead in starts with Tom Gorzelanny... 177 K's were the most by a Pirate right-hander since Kris Benson (184 in 2000)... ranked 8th in the NL in strikeouts and ninth in innings pitched... 3.65 road ERA ranked ninth in the league and his 7.7 K / 9.0 IP ranked 10th... tied for league lead in wild pitches (12)... whiffed a career-high 11 batters in first start but came away with a no-decision (6.0 IP / 2 ER) April 3 at HOU... ranked fourth among NL pitchers with a 1.59 ERA through the end of April... tossed first career complete game, allowing one unearned run in 8-1 victory vs. TEX on July 13... ranked 5th among NL starters with a 2.93 ERA at the break... went 0-5 with an 8.31 ERA (24 ER / 26.0 IP) in his first five starts after the All-Star break, raising ERA to 3.91... posted a 1.64 ERA and surrendered just one home run in his final five starts (33.0 IP)... pitched at least 6.0 innings in 26 of his 32 starts and at least 7.0 frames 18 times.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Graduated from Caesar Rodney High School in Camden, Del., in 2000, where he played football, baseball and basketball... honored by the Delaware Sports Writers Association as its Athlete of the Year for 2006... became the 48th player from Delaware to appear in the Major Leagues when he made his debut in 2004... his 14 wins in 2006 were most by a Delaware right-hander since Huck Betts in 1934... played for Puerto Rico in the 2009 World Baseball Classic (step father is of Puerto Rican descent).
