SHORT-HANDED 'TOPES FALL 9-3: On a day when they lost Dee Gordon to the Dodgers and Trayvon Robinson in a trade to Seattle, the depleted Albuquerque Isotopes didn't have enough to keep up with the New Orleans Zephyrs, who raced out to an eight-run lead and cruised to a 9-3 win Sunday evening at Zephyr Field. After rain delayed the start of the game a half an hour, New Orleans came out hot, scoring three runs in the very first inning before an out was recorded. Jorge Padilla led off the frame with a single and was immediately cashed in by a two-run homer by Joe Thurston to give the Z's a 2-0 edge. The very next batter, Jose Lopez, followed with a solo shot of his own, increasing the early lead to 3-0 Zephyrs. New Orleans would blow the game open in the third, scoring five runs, all with two out in the inning, to seize a commanding 8-0 lead after just three innings. Albuquerque finally got on the board in the fourth, thanks to a big blast from Jay Gibbons. Justin Sellers started the uprising with a lead-off double and Ivan De Jesus Jr. added a walk, putting a pair on for Gibbons, who crushed a three-run blast to right center that trimmed the deficit to 8-3. For good measure, the Z's added one more in the eighth on a solo homer by Thurston, his second big-fly of the game, to cruise to a 9-3 win.

FELIX ON THE SPOT: Versatile righty Francisco Felix makes the spot-start tonight, his fourth of the season and his first since returning to the Isotopes from a 10-game stint with Saltillo in the Mexican League. After joining Saltillo on loan from the 'Topes on June 28, Felix posted a very solid 2.30 ERA (4 ER / 15.2 IP) in 10 relief appearances. With his talents needed again north of the border, Felix was transferred back to Albuquerque exactly a month later on July 28 and made one appearance out the 'pen for the 'Topes the next day at Omaha, allowing three runs on four hits while walking one and striking out two in just two-thirds of an inning in a 10-1 'Topes loss. In his three previous starts, made consecutively from April 24-May 6, Felix went 0-0 with a7.71 ERA (12 ER / 14.0 IP).

TRAY-DE WINDS: Minutes before Major League Baseball's non-waiver trade deadline yesterday, the Dodgers sent All-Star Isotopes outfielder Trayvon Robinson to Boston, who then shipped him to Seattle in a deal that ultimately landed left-hander Erik Bedard in Beantown. In return for Robinson, the Dodgers received catcher Tim Federowicz, and right-handed pitchers Stephen Fife and Juan Rodriguez. Of the three, Federowicz is the only one slated to join the 'Topes, which will be the catcher's Triple-A debut. This season, Federowicz has spent the entire year at Double-A Portland (ME) in the Red Sox organization, where he batted .277 (94x339) with 46

runs, 20 doubles, eight homers, and 52 RBI in 90 games. He entered the season rated as Boston's No. 21 overall prospect by Baseball America and was rated the system's best defensive back-stop. In the ultimate of ironies, Robinson has been assigned to the Mariners' Triple-A affiliate in Tacoma and will be with that club when they arrive in Albuquerque for a four-game series against the 'Topes this Wednesday.

PITCHER O'THE WEEK!: Lefty starter Dana Eveland has been named Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week for July 25-31 by virtue of his masterful, three-hit shutout of the Omaha Storm Chasers on July 28. Eveland is the third Isotopes pitcher to claim the award, joining John Ely and Randy Keisler, most of any PCL pitching staff and the most to garner the accolade in any one season in Isotopes history.

HAPPY TO TURN THE PAGE: With three straight losses to close out the month, the Isotopes finish July with a record of 14-15, just the third losing July in team history and the first since Albuquerque went 10-18 in 2008. The Isotopes now trail division-leading Round Rock by eight games, tied for their largest deficit of the season.

NEXT HOMESTAND BECKONS: The 'Topes are back in town Wednesday for an eight-game homestand that kicks off the final month of the regular season in style. The fun starts with a Lunch Bag giveaway on August 4 courtesy of Webster University, and continues with an Orbit Bank giveaway on Friday, August 5 courtesy of U.S. Bank and a post-game fireworks show on Saturday, August 6.

TODAY'S START: Francisco Felix makes his fourth spot-start of the season and his first since re-joining the Isotopes after a 10 game stint with Saltillo in the Mexican League.

Loaned to Saltillo on June 28 and posted a 2.30~ERA (4~ER / 15.2~IP) in 10~games, all relief appearances. Returned to Albuquerque's roster on July 28.

Made three straight spot starts from April 24 to May 6, posting a 7.71 ERA (12 ER / 14.0 IP).

Earned victories in his first three decisions with the Isotopes, all relief appearances on April 13 vs. Iowa, May 17 at Tucson, and May 25 vs. Colorado Springs.

Pitched 4.0 innings in his first start of the season on April 24 vs. New Orleans, allowing three runs on five hits in a 10-9 Isotopes loss. Prior to moving to the rotation, he made three excellent appearances out of the bullpen in which he posted a 1-0 record with a 1.80 ERA (1 ER / 5.0 IP). Joined Albuquerque on April 11 from Extended Spring Training and earned a victory in his first appearance for the 'Topes in 2011, pitching 2.1 innings of relief on April 13 vs. Iowa, allowing a run on two hits while walking one and striking out two in a 10-7 Albuquerque win.

2010: Spent the majority of the season on loan to Saltillo of the Mexican League after making his first appearance at Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee... went 1-3 with a 6.28 ERA (43 ER / 61.2 IP) in 17 games (12 starts) for Saltillo... added to Albuquerque on August 28 and made two starts for the Isotopes, going 2-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP)... pitched through the sixth in both outings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Split the 2009 season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 4-2 with a 3.07 ERA (26 ER / 76.2 IP) in a total of 43 appearances... started the season at Chattanooga, going 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA and two saves in 29 games... was 2-2 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER / 18.2 IP) and a save in nine appearances in May... made a pair of starts for Lookouts, his first since 2007, and went 0-1 with a 4.05 ERA (3 ER / 6.2 IP)... went 3-1 with two saves and a 2.77 ERA (15 ER / 48.2 IP) while holding opponents to a .222 batting average in 27 relief appearances... transferred to Albuquerque on July 25... went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (8 ER / 21.1 IP) in 14 appearances... earned his only win for the Isotopes in the second game of a doubleheader after pitching a perfect seventh in a 2-1 Albuquerque win... his only save was of the two-inning variety on August 8 vs. Portland... pitched a 0.1 inning of scoreless relief in Game 3 of the Isotopes' playoff series vs. Memphis... pitched for Culiacan of the Mexican Winter League for the fourth straight season, going 2-1 with a 2.43 ERA (11 ER / 40.2 IP) in 32 appearances (one start).

Split 2008 season between Single-A Inland Empire and Triple-A Las Vegas, going a combined 5-4 with a 4.27 ERA and three saves in 40 total games... began season at Inland Empire, posting a 5-3 record with a 3.31 ERA and two saves... was 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA and two saves in 12 games at home, 1-2 with a 4.13 in 13 games on the road... ranked fifth among all California League relievers by holding batters to a .198 average... was 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA in seven games in June... yielded just two hits over 11 straight scoreless innings from June 6 to June 18... held left-handed hitters to a .145 average, while righties batted .238... transferred to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 8 and finished the season going 0-1 with a 5.81 ERA and a save in 15 appearances.
