### SALT LAKE BEES (54-64) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (60-58)

**ISOTOPES SWAT BEES, 19-6:** In an offensive onslaught, the Albuquerque Isotopes scored 19 times on 24 hits to crush the Salt Lake Bees 19-6 Tuesday night at Isotopes Park. The 'Topes wasted no time jumping out to a quick lead on the Bees, as Jamie Hoffmann hit a three-run homer in the bottom of the first to give the home team a quick 3-0 advantage. After Salt Lake scored twice in the second to make the score 3-2, the Isotopes responded with three more in the bottom of the second to increase the lead to 6-2. After the Bees scored once in the fourth, Albuquerque plated two runs in the fourth, two more in the fifth, and another in the sixth to open up a 10-3 gap. Salt Lake opened the seventh inning with two runs but the Isotopes responded emphatically in the bottom of the frame, scoring eight times. Jerry Sands started the rally by blasting a two-run homer to left giving the Isotopes a 13-5 lead. The very next batter, Hoffmann, then added a solo homer, his second big-fly of the game, to extend the lead to 14-5. A power outage in one of the light standards behind home plate caused a short, 15-minute delay, and when light was restored the Isotopes picked up right where they left off, with Justin Sellers adding a solo homer to left, giving Albuquerque back-to-back-to-back home runs. Still, the 'Topes weren't finished. After Albuquerque loaded the bases, De Jesus smashed a grand slam into the picnic pavilion in left field to give the Isotopes a commanding 19-5 lead. The Bees would plate one more in the eighth to close the scoring, trimming the deficit to 19-6.

**THE KEIS-MASTER:** Randy Keisler takes the mound looking to stop an uncharacteristic two-game losing streak. In a loss at New Orleans on July 31 followed by a defeat vs. Tacoma on August 5, Keisler has allowed 15 runs over 7.2 total innings for an ERA over that span of 17.61. What's bedeviled the left-hander the most is a sudden vulnerability to the long ball. In his last two starts, Keisler has allowed five home runs, more than he'd conceded in his 16 previous outings combined (four home runs over 77.0 innings). Until July 31, when he gave up two home runs to the Zephyrs, Keisler had not allowed more than one home run in an appearance all season. While this is the third time he's lost two starts in a row this year, Keisler has shown the resiliency you'd expect from a veteran. After dropping two starts on June 26 and July 2, Keisler turned in a gem on July 7 vs. Nashville, allowing one unearned run on two hits in 6.2 innings.

**RE-WRITE THE RECORD BOOKS!:** The Isotopes record book received some revisions in last night's offensive eruption, as the 'Topes set a franchise mark with 46 total bases and tied club records with 24 hits (set July 24, 2009 vs. Iowa), four home runs in an inning (set on April 19, 2008 vs. Nashville and equaled on July 21, 2010 at Nashville), and 11 extra-base hits (set on August 14, 2009 at Las Vegas and equaled on April 15, 2010 vs. New Orleans).

**BRING OUT YER BATS:** Over the course of Albuquerque's current homestand, the 'Topes and either the Tacoma Rainiers or the Salt Lake Bees have combined to score 133 runs in seven games (an average of 19 total runs **per game**). The Isotopes have out-scored their opponents this homestand 72-61.

**JERRY, JAMIE, AND JUSTIN:** Last night's consecutive home runs by Jerry Sands, Jamie Hoffmann, and Justin Sellers marked the first time in team history the Isotopes have delivered back-to-back-to-back home runs. Making the feat even more remarkable was the fact there was a 15-minute delay due to power outage in the light standard behind home plate between Hoffmann's home run and Sellers' blast.

**LET'S SPLIT:** Albuquerque is looking to win two in a row and finish its series with the Bees with a four-game series split. The only time the 'Topes have lost a series at Isotopes Park this year was when Oklahoma City came in and took three of four from the Isotopes on June 21-24. This season, Albuquerque has won eight series, lost one, and split six at Isotopes Park.

**YOU DON'T HASSLE THE HOFF:** Jamie Hoffmann equaled a team record and a career-high with five hits in last night's win, continuing a red-hot hitting tear for the outfielder. In his last four games, Hoffmann has collected 12 hits in 19 at-bats (.632) with nine runs, with a double, a triple, four home runs, and 10 RBI.

**WELCOME BACK!:** Isotopes broadcaster Robert Portnoy returns to the microphone today after missing five games for a death in the family. Portnoy's return snaps a streak of five straight poorly-announced games.

**A DAY OF REST:** Tomorrow, the 'Topes will enjoy their last day off of the 2011 season. After tomorrow, Albuquerque will have a stretch of 25 games in 25 days.

**TODAY'S START:** Randy Keisler takes the mound looking to break a two-game losing streak after suffering the loss on August 5 vs. Tacoma when he allowed eight runs, seven earned, on six hits in five innings of a 13-9 'Topes loss. The lefty gave up a season-high three home runs on the night.

Won four straight outings from June 6 to June 21, a span in which he posted a stellar 0.38 ERA (1 ER / 24.0 IP). On June 21 vs. Oklahoma City, Keisler came on in the second in relief of the rehabbing Jonathan Broxton and delivered six shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10, the most punch-outs by a 'Topes pitcher this year and the most by an Isotope in a relief appearance in franchise history.

Earned his second win of the season on June 11 vs. Nashville when he allowed just one run on just four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 5-2 'Topes win. Also pitched a gem on June 6 at Round Rock when he tossed six shutout innings, allowing just six hits and a walk while striking out four in an 11-0 win, his first victory of the season.

Earned PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for his back-to-back starts on June 6 and June 11 in which he went a combined 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER / 13.0 IP) while walking two and striking out 10.

Strained his right groin and hamstring in a start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).

Roped a pinch-hit RBI double on April 18 in an 8-6 win at Oklahoma City.

Signed a minor league contract with the Dodgers out of an open tryout at Spring Training on March 3 and joined the Isotopes as camp broke.

**2010:** Split the season between two independent league teams and Laguna of the Mexican League... was 3-3 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER / 43.0 IP) in seven starts for Laguna... pitched for Pensacola in the independent American Association, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER / 11.0 IP) in two starts... also spent time with Long Island in the independent Atlantic League, going 5-0 with a 3.65 ERA (20 ER 49.1 IP) in eight starts... struck out 43 while walking just 18 in 49.1 innings with the Ducks.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Pitched for Southern Maryland in the independnet Atlantic League in 2009, going 2-2 with a 6.89 ERA (24 ER / 31.1 IP) in six starts.

Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on January 11, 2008 but was released during Spring Training... signed on the Cubs and began the season with Triple-A Iowa, going 4-6 with a 3.14 ERA (23 ER / 66.0 IP) in 12 games (11 starts)... fanned 65 while walking 26 and allowed just four home runs in 66 innings... opted out of his contract on June 10 and was signed by Baltimore... went 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER / 48.0 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) for Triple-A Norfolk... went a combined 6-9 with a 4.03 ERA in 20 starts between both Triple-A teams.

Began the 2007 season at Triple-A Memphis and was recalled to the St. Louis Cardinals on April 9... made four appearances, three starts, for St. Louis before being optioned on April 27... was 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 ER / 39.1 IP) in six starts from June 10 to July 5... tossed six-plus innings on 16 consecutive starts from June 10 to September 2... recalled on July 27 but optioned again on July 31... outrighted to Memphis on September 6.

Starte the 2006 season at Triple-A Sacramento... won three consecutive starts, going 3-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER / 18.0 IP) from April 22 to May 2... contract was selected on May 12 and made 11 relief appearances with the A's before being optioned on June 9... had a four-game winning streak from July 4 to August 11... recalled on July 26 and optioned again on July 28... outrighted to Sacramento on August 8.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Randy Dean Keisler... was a 1994 graduate of Palmer (TX) High School after attending Navasota (TX) High School prior to his senior year... attended Louisiana State University and was named to the All-Southeastern Conference College World Series Team as a junior... spent his first two collegiate seasons at Navarro (TX) Junior College... drafted by New York (AL) in the second round of the 1998 draft.
