## ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (60-59) AT FRESNO GRIZZLIES (53-66)

ISOTOPES BESTED BY BEES, 10-7: The Albuquerque Isotopes got home runs from John Lindsey and Jerry Sands, but it wasn't enough as the Salt Lake Bees countered with three, two-run homers to cruise to a 10-7 series-ending triumph Wednesday night at Isotopes Park. Salt Lake jumped out to a 4-0 lead with two in the third and two more in the second, until Albuquerque finally responded in the bottom of the fourth when Lindsey demolished a pitch over the wall in center for a three-run shot bringing the 'Topes back to within 4-3. Salt Lake augmented its advantage in the sixth, with a two-run homer by Jeremy Moore and a two-run blast by Gil Velazquez, giving the visitors an 8-3 cushion. Sands trimmed the deficit to four runs in the sixth with his team-leading 22nd home run of the season, a towering solo shot to right that cut the Bees' lead to 8-4, but Moore struck again in the top of the seventh, helping to increase the visitor's lead with yet another home run. With a man on first and two down, Moore hit a deep fly ball to center that landed and stuck in the padding of the fence atop Isotopes hill after a diving attempt to catch the ball by the centerfielder Hoffmann. As Hoffmann gathered himself and collected the ball, Moore cruised around the bases, sliding home in front of the throw for a two-run, inside-the-park home run that made the score 10-4. Albuquerque responded in the bottom of the seventh with a lead-off walk by Tim Federowicz in front of a single by Damaso Espino and a walk to Joe Becker, loading the bases for Ivan De Jesus Jr., who lifted a sacrifice fly to right, scoring Federowicz and cutting the Salt Lake lead to 10-5. Jay Gibbons then roped a double down the line in right, scoring Espino and Becker to cut the lead to 10-7 Bees. Salt Lake would make sure the 'Topes' rally stopped there, as closer Michael Kohn came on a retired in the 'Topes one-two-three in the ninth to secure the 10-7 win.

BASTARDO'S BACK!: Lefty Alberto Bastardo makes his first start back with the 'Topes after spending over two months on the DL recovering from a badly sprained left ankle suffered in a start at Round Rock on June 5. In the very first inning of that outing, Bastardo began the game with a groundout before issuing back-to-back singles. While hustling over to back-up third, he twisted his ankle, ending his day after just three batters. After rehabbing, Bastardo finally got back into some game action on July 27 in a start for the Arizona League Dodgers, with whom he made a total of three starts before rejoining the 'Topes, going 0-0 with a 3.24 ERA (3 ER / 8.1 IP).

FEELING IT IN FRESNO: For the first time since 2009, the Isotopes will play a series in Chukchansi Park, home of the Fresno Grizzlies, Triple-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants. The last time the Isotopes played in Fresno, they split a fourgame set from May 16-19, 2009. All-time, the 'Topes are 14-18 against the Grizzlies and 6-10 at Chukchansi Park. The Grizz also feature a pair of former Isotopes having excellent seasons. Lefty starter Matt Yourkin (Isotope from 2006-07), who will pitch against his former team on Monday, is 8-6 with a 4.60 ERA (70 ER / 137.0) in 24 starts, while infielder Edgar Gonzalez (Isotope in 2006) is batting .316 and has the PCL's longest consecutive on-base streak at 42 games.

**HOME RUN HAPPY:** The Isotopes have gone on a home run hitting binge of late, blasting a home run in each of their last nine games, a span in which they've hit 23 balls over the fence. As a result, Albuquerque now has 157 dingers on the season and has vaulted into second-place in the PCL behind Reno's 160.

**BIG JOHN, BIG TIME:** When John Lindsey is healthy enough to be in the lineup, he has been dominant. Lindsey has collected a hit in each of his last 11 games and in 13 of his last 14 contests dating back to June 18. In his last 11 games, Lindsey has

batted .474 (18x38) with 11 runs, five doubles, five home runs, and 14 RBI. Big John has homered in three of his last four contests, bringing his total on the season, which has been shortened by two lengthy stays on the DL, to 10.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Albuquerque is back on the road, trying to turn around a streak in which they've lost four of their last five games away from Isotopes Park. With a home record of 37-26 and a road record of 23-33, the 'Topes are tied with Iowa for the biggest differential between home wins and away wins in the PCL at 14. Iowa (20), Colorado Springs (21), and Fresno (22) are the only teams in the league with fewer road victories than Albuquerque.

TODAY'S START: Left-hander Alberto Bastardo returns after over two months on the Disabled List recovering from a severely sprained left ankle he suffered in a game at Round Rock on June 5. Bastardo faced just three batters, getting a groundout and surrendering two hits before he turned his ankle while going to back up third on a single by Chris Davis.

Made three rehab starts for the Arizona League Dodgers, going 0-0 with a 3.24 ERA (3 ER / 8.1 IP).

Missed one turn in the rotation on May 20 with a sore lower back, but did not go on the DL and returned to the rotation in a start vs. Colorado Springs on May 26.

Suffered his first loss of the season on May 10 at Las Vegas, when he allowed five runs, two earned, on six hits in six innings of work in a 7-0 loss. Earned his second win of the season and second consecutive victory on April 29 in which he out-pitched 2009 Cy Young Award winner Zack Greinke, who was making a rehab assignment for the Nashville Sounds. Bastardo allowed just one run on five hits in 7.1 innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-1 'Topes win over the Sounds. Got his first win of the season on April 23 against New Orleans at Isotopes Park when he pitched six innings, allowing four runs on nine hits whie walking none and striking out seven in a 12-8 'Topes win.

2010: Split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 12-8 with a 5.68 ERA in 27 starts... tied for the Dodger organizational lead with 12 wins and 27 starts... won the May Dodger Pride Award for Chattanooga, going 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER/31.2 IP) in five starts in the month... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of May 17-23, going 2-0 and allowing only an unearned run with 14 strikeouts in 14.0 innings in his two starts... took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on May 17 at Mobile before giving up a one-out single... ended up pitching seven shutout innings, giving up the one hit while walking two and striking out seven in a 7-0 Lookouts win... transferred to Albuquerque on June 10 and won three straight decisions... transferred back to Chattanooga on August 13 and finished the year in Chattanooga... following the season, played for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Winter League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Saw action in 2009 at three levels of Dodgers system, starting in Single-A Inland Empire, stoppnig at Double-A Chattanooga and ending the season with an appearance at Triple-A Albuquerque... combined to go 12-5 with a 4.01 ERA (66 ER / 148.1 IP) in all three stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 6-2 with a 3.84 ERA (32 ER / 75.0 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... selected to the California League Mid-Season All-Star team on June 23... transferred to Chattanooga on June 25 and went 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA (34 ER / 72.1 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... tossed a complete-game on August 5 vs. West Tenn., allowing two runs on three hits in nine innings while striking out eight... transferred to Albuquerque on September 6 and made a relief appearance in the last game of the regular season at Iowa on September 7, firing a scoreless inning... was on the Isotopes' playoff roster and was slated to start game four of the first round but did not pitch as the 'Topes were swept in three games.

Spent the entire 2008 season with Single-A Inland Empire of the California League, going 5-8 with a 5.19 ERA (76 ER / 131.2 IP) in 30 appearances (21 starts)... went 5-8 with a 4.70 ERA (55 ER / 105.1 IP) in 21 starts and 0-0 with a 7.18 ERA (21 ER / 26.1 IP) in nine relief appearances.
