ISOTOPES BATS STAY HOT IN 8-4 WIN OVER GRIZZ: On the day he was named Pacific Coast League Batter of the Week, Jamie Hoffmann celebrated with four hits and three RBI to help lead the Albuquerque Isotopes to an 8-4 win over the Fresno Grizzlies Monday night at Chukchansi Park. Not surprisingly, Hoffmann ignited the Isotopes' first rally in the second inning, reaching on a fielding error by Grizzlies third baseman Bill Hall and scampering to third on a single by Tim Federowicz. That set up Damaso Espino, who roped a single to left, plating Hoffmann and giving Albuquerque a 1-0 edge. Ivan Ochoa and Joe Becker each added RBI singles of their own to boost the 'Topes' lead to 3-0. Fresno scored a run in the bottom of the second, but the Isotopes answered emphatically in the third with a pair of home runs. With one out and the bases empty, Jerry Sands smashed a home run to left, putting the 'Topes on top 4-1. No sooner had Sands found his seat in the dugout when Hoffmann immediately followed with a solo blast of his own, giving Albuquerque a 5-1 edge. The Isotopes increased their advantage in the fifth, when Russ Mitchell led off the inning by reaching second on a throwing error by Grizzlies starter Shane Loux and was brought in by a Hoffmann single to left that padded the cushion to five runs at 6-1. Like they had the night before, however, the Grizz mounted a comeback, plating three in the bottom of the sixth to bring the home team perilously close at 6-4. Albuquerque would tack on another tally in the seventh on doubles by Mitchell and Hoffmann, the latter scoring the former, before sealing the scoring in the eighth on an RBI groundout from Mitchell to cruise to an 8-4 victory.

NEWBY IS DUE-BY: Righty Joe Newby makes the spot start, his fifth of the season, looking to get into the win column while in a starting role. In his four previous spot starts, Newby is 0-3 with a 6.63 ERA (14 ER / 19.0 IP) and in his last appearance as a starter on July 25 vs. New Orleans at Isotopes Park, the right-hander yielded seven runs on eight hits in four innings in a 9-5 loss to the Z's. Newby, who is 2-2 with a 4.50 ERA (14 ER / 28.0 IP) in 17 relief appearances for the "Topes, has established himself as a valuable work-horse out of the bullpen for Albuquerque. In each of his last four appearances, he pitched two innings or more.

CAPITAL CITY: The Isotopes begin a four-game series with the Sacramento River Cats at Raley Field, which, like for a lot of teams in the PCL, has been a tough place for the 'Topes. All-time, Albuquerque is 6-10 in Sacramento, having dropped three of four to the Cats during the Isotopes' last visit to Sacramento in 2009. In fact, the 'Topes have lost three of four in each of their last two visits to the Golden State Capital dating back to 2007, with their last series split in Sacramento taking place in 2005. Overall, the Isotopes are 14-18 all-time against the River Cats.

THIS SPACE RESERVED FOR HOFFMANN: The remarkable hot streak of Jamie Hoffmann shows no signs of slowing down, as the outfielder celebrated his being named PCL Batter of the Week yesterday by going 4-for-5 with a double, a homer, and three RBI. Hoffmann absolutely feasted on Fresno pitching, collecting multiple hit performances in each of the last four games against the Grizzlies, a span in which he went an incredible 11-for-19 (.579 average). Hoffmann's current tear is hardly a recent phenomenon, however, as the outfielder leads the Pacific Coast League with a .444 average (28x63) and 22 RBI over 14 games in August. He's also doubled in each of his last four games and with a solo homer last night, has belted a career-high 20 home runs this season. As if all of that weren't enough, Hoffmann has also hit in a season-high 13 straight games, a stretch in which he's batted .475 (28x59) with 19 runs, five doubles, six homers and 22 RBI

EVERYONE'S A HITTER: Over the month of August, the Isotopes have six different players batting .350 or better and five separate players that have racked up double-digits in RBI over the month. Surprisingly, the 'Topes' team batting average this month is just barely second in the PCL to Nashville, which is hitting at a .346 clip so far in August. Albuquerque's 27 home runs this month does lead the circuit.

CALL IN THE FED: After going 0-for-8 to start his Triple-A career, catcher Tim Federowicz has collected a hit in every game he's played since, racking up a .448 average (13x29) with nine runs scored, three doubles, three homers, and nine RBI over his current eight-game hitting streak.

FINAL HOMESTAND COMING SOON!: The final homestand of the regular season cranks up this Saturday, August 20 when the 'Topes will entertain the Memphis Redbirds and Round Rock Express for nine games. As you'd expect, the home slate ends with a bang, literally, with back-to-back Fan Appreciation Weekend fireworks shows. Also on tap is the third 50-Cent Hot Dog Night of the season, an appearance by Birdzerk! and cowbell as well as golf towel giveaways.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Joe Newby makes his fifth start of the season, having gone 0-3 with a 6.63 ERA (14 ER / 19.0 IP) in his four previous spot starts. Has appeared in 17 games as a reliever, going 2-2 with a 4.50 ERA (14 ER / 28.0 IP).

Won his second game of the season on August 2 at New Orleans when he pitched 2.0 innings of relief, allowing a run on one hit while walking one and striking out four in a 6-4 Isotopes win. The victory broke a season-high three-game losing streak.

Was excellent in a start on July 18 vs. Oklahoma City at Isotopes Park, giving up just two runs, one earned, on four hits in 5.2 innings but ended up not getting a decision in an 8-7 Isotopes loss.

Earned his first win of the season on June 18 vs. Iowa after 3.1 scoreless innings of relief in which he allowed just one hit while walking one and striking out four in a 13-10 win.

Transferred to Albuquerque from Chattanooga on May 31 and suffered the loss in his Isotopes debut that night at Memphis after allowing one run on two hits in 2.0 IP of relief in a 10-4 'Topes loss.

Signed by the Dodgers on February 23 and appeared in seven games (two starts) for Chattanooga, going 2-1 with a 3.74 ERA (9 ER / 21.2 IP). Started the season making two straight starts, going 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA (2 ER / 10.0 IP). Suffered a hard-luck loss in his first start of the season on May 1 vs. Jackson when he allowed one run on four hits in five innings while walking none and striking out four in a 3-0 Lookouts loss. Bounced back with his first win of the season on May 6 at Mississippi, allowing one run on five hits in five innings while walking three and fanning four in a 3-1 Chattanooga win. Went 1-0 with a 5.40 ERA (7 ER / 11.2 IP) in five appearances out of the bullpen before joining the Isotopes. Six of his nine total runs given up with Lookouts came in one appearance at Tennessee on May 15.

2010: Pitched in 2010 for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League, going 6-5 with a 2.48 ERA (31 ER / 112.2 IP) in 37 games (14 starts)... set career-high in innings-pitched (112.2), games (37), and strikeouts (80)... yielded just seven home runs... combined to throw the first no-hitter in team history on August 5 at Newark, pitching eight-plus innings in which he walked in the Bears only run in the bottom of the ninth before giving way to closer Jim Ed Warden, who finished the no-no... Newby ended up with 8.0-plus innings-pitched, giving up just one run on no hits while walking five and striking out four in a 3-1 Blue Crabs win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played for three teams in the Seattle Mariners organization in 2009, going a combined 1-1 with a 2.38 ERA (14 ER / 53.0 IP) in 34 games, all of them in relief... spent the majority of the season at Double-A West Tennesee, appearing in 28 games in which he went 1-1 with a 2.72 ERA (13 ER / 43.0 IP)... earned a promotion to Tacoma, for his first taste of Triple-A, on June 28 and allowed just one earned run in 6.1 innings of work over three games (1.42 ERA)... also appeared in three games for Single-A High Desert, where he did not allow a run in 3.2 innings.

Did not pitch at all in 2008 while recovering from three different surgeries to his right elbow, including Tommy John surgery.

Started the 2007 season at Single-A Kane County in the Oakland chain, going 0-3 with a $8.59~{\rm ERA}~(14~{\rm ER}~/~14.2~{\rm IP})$ in nine games before being sidelined with a right elbow injury.

Pitched for Single-A Kane County in 2006, going 5-0 with a 3.22 ERA (18 ER / 50.1 IP) in 32 games... allowed just one home run in his 50.1 innings of work... fanned 53 while walking 22.

Signed by Oakland as a non-drafted free agent on June 19, 2004.
