ISOTOPES CLAWED BY CATS, 7-3: Despite being held to one hit through five innings, the Albuquerque Isotopes mounted a late comeback, but the Sacramento River Cats surged ahead with a pair of late runs to cruise to a 7-3 win Tuesday night at Raley Field. The contest started ominously for Albuquerque, as the River Cats plated four runs in the bottom of the first while literally knocking out the Isotopes starting pitcher Joe Newby with an injury while the pitcher was covering home plate on a wild pitch. With Newby's premature exit, Francisco Felix was thrust into emergency relief duty, and after a strikeout, a hit-by-pitch, and a walk, he surrendered a single to Adam Rosales that scored Carter, but as Andy LaRoche attempted to score from second base, left-fielder Jerry Sands delivered a perfect throw to catcher Tim Federowicz that cut down the runner and ended the River Cats threat with the home team holding a 4-0 lead after one. Felix allowed another run to the Cats in the second on an RBI groundout that put Sacramento up 5-0, but after that, the right-hander was excellent, allowing one run on four hits in 4.2 innings while walking three and striking out four. Meanwhile, Cats starter Graham Godfrey was superb, allowing just one hit, a single by Coon in the first, through the first five innings before the 'Topes broke through in the sixth. Joe Becker led off the inning with a single and was immediately picked up by a triple to right by Coon, cutting the Sacramento lead to 5-1. Ivan De Jesus Jr. then roped a single up the middle, plating Coon and cutting the home team's lead to 5-2. The Cats added some insurance in the eighth on an RBI single by Cardenas and a run-scoring groundout by Kevin Kouzmanoff before the Isotopes mounted one last desperate comeback in the ninth. With the bases empty and two outs, Jamie Hoffmann delivered a solo homer to left, pulling Albuquerque to within the 7-3 final margin.

BASTARDO FINDING HIS GROOVE: Lefty Alberto Bastardo makes the start still working out the kinks after spending the better part of two months on the Disabled List recovering from a severely sprained ankle he suffered in a game at Round Rock on June 5. In his first game back with the Isotopes since the injury, on August 12 at Fresno, Bastardo allowed a season-high seven runs, six earned, on eight hits in just 2.0 innings while walking two and striking out two in an eventual 15-10 'Topes loss to the Grizzlies. Proving that Bastardo was still feeling his way back into top form was the fact he surrendered three home runs in the contest, which is unlike the ground-ball throwing lefty. In the 51.0 innings he'd pitched before he got hurt, Bastardo had allowed a total of just three long balls, as many as he'd conceded in two innings at Fresno.

THE STREAK LIVES!!: In the most dramatic fashion possible, red-hot Jamie Hoffmann extended his hitting streak to a season-high 14 games with a two-out solo home run in his last at-bat in the ninth inning. Hoffmann's streak, which started on August 2, is now tied with Jay Gibbons for the second longest on the Isotopes this year behind the pair of 16-game hitting streaks that former outfielder Trayvon Robinson enjoyed. Of course, hitting streaks are nothing new for Hoffmann, who last season equaled a team record by hitting in 19 straight from May 5-25. Over the course of his current streak, he's batted .475 (29x63) with 20 runs, five doubles, seven homers, and 23 RBI

GOOD AGAINST THE GREATS: This season, the Isotopes are 32-24 against teams in the PCL that currently have a winning record. Against the current division leaders, which includes Round Rock, Omaha, Reno, and Sacramento, the 'Topes are 15-13 with their only losing record coming against Omaha (7-9) and, after just one game, Sacramento (0-1).

BECKS A BEAUTY: With the combination of call-ups as well as bumps and bruises decimating the ranks of the 'Topes infield, Joe Becker has stepped in an done an excellent job. Becker has gotten a hit in nine of his last 10 games, batting .395 (15x38) with nine runs, four doubles, a homer, and three RBI.

SOAK UP THE SUN: After today's matinee, the Isotopes will have just two day games remaining this season: August 21 vs. Memphis at home and September 5 at Round Rock. A win today would even the 'Topes' record in the sunlight to 10-10 and give Albuquerque a two-game winning streak under the sun.

FINAL HOMESTAND COMING SOON!: The final homestand of the regular season cranks up this Saturday, August 20 when the 'Topes will entertain the Memphis Redbirds and Round Rock Express for nine games. As you'd expect, the home slate ends with a bang, literally, with back-to-back Fan Appreciation Weekend fireworks shows. Also on tap is the third 50-Cent Hot Dog Night of the season, an appearance by Birdzerk! and cowbell as well as golf towel giveaways.

TODAY'S START: Left-hander Alberto Bastardo makes his second start since returning from the Disabled List recovering from a severely sprained left ankle. Pitched 2.0 innings in his first game back on August 12 at Fresno, allowing a season-high seven runs, six earned, on eight hits while walking two and striking out two in an eventual 15-10 'Topes loss.

Suffered the ankle sprain in a game at Round Rock on June 5. He faced just three batters, getting a groundout and surrendering two hits before he turned his ankle while going to back up third on a single by Chris Davis. Placed on the Disabled List on June 9 and reinstated on August 12.

Made three rehab starts for the Arizona League Dodgers, going 0-0 with a 3.24 ERA (3 ER / 8.1 IP).

Missed one turn in the rotation on May 20 with a sore lower back, but did not go on the DL and returned to the rotation in a start vs. Colorado Springs on May 26.

Suffered his first loss of the season on May 10 at Las Vegas, when he allowed five runs, two earned, on six hits in six innings of work in a 7-0 loss. Earned his second win of the season and second consecutive victory on April 29 in which he out-pitched 2009 Cy Young Award winner Zack Greinke, who was making a rehab assignment for the Nashville Sounds. Bastardo allowed just one run on five hits in 7.1 innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-1 'Topes win over the Sounds. Got his first win of the season on April 23 against New Orleans at Isotopes Park when he pitched six innings, allowing four runs on nine hits whie walking none and striking out seven in a 12-8 'Topes win.

2010: Split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 12-8 with a 5.68 ERA in 27 starts... tied for the Dodger organizational lead with 12 wins and 27 starts... won the May Dodger Pride Award for Chattanooga, going 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER/31.2 IP) in five starts in the month... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of May 17-23, going 2-0 and allowing only an unearned run with 14 strikeouts in 14.0 innings in his two starts... took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on May 17 at Mobile before giving up a one-out single... ended up pitching seven shutout innings, giving up the one hit while walking two and striking out seven in a 7-0 Lookouts win... transferred to Albuquerque on June 10 and won three straight decisions... transferred back to Chattanooga on August 13 and finished the year in Chattanooga... following the season, played for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Winter League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Saw action in 2009 at three levels of Dodgers system, starting in Single-A Inland Empire, stoppnig at Double-A Chattanooga and ending the season with an appearance at Triple-A Albuquerque... combined to go 12-5 with a 4.01 ERA (66 ER / 148.1 IP) in all three stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 6-2 with a 3.84 ERA (32 ER / 75.0 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... selected to the California League Mid-Season All-Star team on June 23... transferred to Chattanooga on June 25 and went 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA (34 ER / 72.1 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... tossed a complete-game on August 5 vs. West Tenn., allowing two runs on three hits in nine innings while striking out eight... transferred to Albuquerque on September 6 and made a relief appearance in the last game of the regular season at Iowa on September 7, firing a scoreless inning... was on the Isotopes' playoff roster and was slated to start game four of the first round but did not pitch as the 'Topes were swept in three games.

Spent the entire 2008 season with Single-A Inland Empire of the California League, going 5-8 with a 5.19 ERA (76 ER / 131.2 IP) in 30 appearances (21 starts)... went 5-8 with a 4.70 ERA (55 ER / 105.1 IP) in 21 starts and 0-0 with a 7.18 ERA (21 ER / 26.1 IP) in nine relief appearances.
