ISOTOPES CLIP RIVER CATS, 2-1: The Albuquerque Isotopes got some stellar starting pitching from John Ely and the benefit of a costly eighth-inning error to edge the Sacramento River Cats 2-1, Thursday night at Raley Field. Sacramento surged to a quick lead in the first inning on an RBI double by Kevin Kouzmanoff to put the home team on top 1-0, but that's the only run Ely would allow. The right-hander tossed 6.2 innings, allowing just the one run on six hits while walking two and striking out seven. River Cats starter Travis Banwart was up to Ely's challenge, authoring five scoreless frames of his own until the 'Topes broke through in the sixth. With one out and nobody on, Jerry Sands hammered a monstrous solo home run to center, immediately knotting the game at 1-1. Albuquerque would break the deadlock in the eighth in an inspired two-out rally. With two down and the bases empty, Tim Federowicz laced a double to left to ignite the Isotopes uprising. After a walk to A.J. Ellis, Sacramento reliever Mike Benacka unleashed a wild pitch that allowed both runners to move up 90 feet. Cats catcher Donaldson then made an ill-advised throw to third in an attempt to get Federowicz that sailed into left field, allowing the Isotopes catcher to trot home with the go-ahead run, giving the 'Topes a 2-1 edge. The Isotopes' bullpen would make sure the one run advantage stood, as Roman Colon (2-1) tossed a perfect inning and a third in relief of Ely to get the victory before turning the game over to Travis Schlichting (4), who delivered a one-two-three ninth, getting two outs via strikeout, to seal the exciting 2-1 win and his fourth save of the season.

NEXT STOP: A RECORD: All-Star lefty Dana Eveland takes the mound looking for his 13th win of the season, which would be a personal and a team milestone. A 13th win would give Eveland a career-high in triumphs in a season, eclipsing the 12 games he won in 2008 between stops in Oakland (9 wins) and Sacramento (3). A win would also tie a franchise record for wins in a season originally set by Frankie De La Cruz in 2008 and equaled a year later by Giancarlo Alvarado. Eveland is also looking to stay ahead of Sacramento's Graham Godfrey for the PCL lead, as the River Cats right-hander moved into a tie for the league's top spot with a 12th win in the first game of the current series. The last Albuquerque pitcher to lead the PCL in victories was Zak Shinnall, who led the league with 13 wins in 1992.

SWEET 16 FOR HOFF! With a base knock in last night's win, Jamie Hoffmann has now hit in 16 straight games, tying the longest streak by an Isotope this season with Trayvon Robinson, who had two, 16-game streaks before he was traded to Seattle. The outfielder is now just three games away from equaling the franchise record of 19 straight games with a hit, set by Eric Reed in 2006 and tied by Hoffmann himself last year. Since the streak began on August 2, Hoffmann is batting .431 (31x72) with 20 runs, five doubles, seven homers, and 23 RBI. In addition to the hits, Hoffmann has been racking up the stolen bases of late as well. He's swiped a bag in each of his last two games and in three of his last four, bringing his total on the year to a team-high 13.

BULLPEN SHUFFLE: Right-hander Joe Newby has been placed on the Disabled List with a lower back strain, suffered in the right-hander's spot-start to begin the current series in Sacramento on August 16. With the bullpen down an arm, the Isotopes have brought in right-hander John Housey from Class-A Great Lakes. Originally a product of the Seattle organization, Housey began the year at High Desert in the California League, going 1-0 with a 8.44 ERA (10 ER / 10.2 IP) before getting released on April 30. The right-hander was then signed by the Dodgers on May 13 and sent to Rancho Cucamonga, where he made one appearance, ironically against his former team High Desert, before he was sent to Extended Spring Training where he spent roughly a month. Housey joined Great Lakes on June 14 and pitched well for the Loons, going 1-2 with a 3.38 ERA (10 ER / 26.2 IP) and a save before joining the Isotopes yesterday in what is his Triple-A debut in just his third full professional season.

MAD ABOUT BRAD: Brad Coon continues to be a sterling addition to the 'Topes, both offensively and defensively since he joined the team on August 1. In 15 games with the Isotopes, Coon is batting .321 (18x56) and has racked up five hits in his last seven at-bats over his last two contests. Coon has also been great batting out of the leadoff position, where he's hitting .314 (16x51) with eight runs score in 13 games.

FINAL HOMESTAND STARTS TOMORROW! The final homestand of the regular season cranks up tomorrow when the 'Topes will entertain the Memphis Redbirds and Round Rock Express for nine games. As you'd expect, the home slate ends with a bang, literally, with back-to-back Fan Appreciation Weekend fireworks shows. Also on tap is the third 50-Cent Hot Dog Night of the season, an appearance by Birdzerk! and cowbell as well as golf towel giveaways.

TODAY'S START: Dana Eveland makes the start coming off his PCL-leading 12th victory of the season on August 14 when he held the Fresno Grizzlies to three runs on seven hits in seven innings in a game in which the 'Topes had to fend off a late charge to hang on to a 9-8 win.

Tossed a three-hit shutout masterpiece at Omaha on July 23, allowing the Storm Chasers just three hits, all singles, through nine shutout innings while walking one and striking out six in a 2-0 'Topes win. The shutout was Eveland's first of his nine-year career, and his first complete game since May 21, 2008 when he was a member of the Oakland Athletics and held Tampa Bay to one run on three hits in nine innings. The left-hander becomes just the seventh pitcher in Isotopes history to toss a nine-inning shutout and just the sixth PCL hurler to do it this year. Named PCL Pitcher of the Week on August 1 as a result of his efforts.

Appeared in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 in Salt Lake City, UT where he pitched a one-two-three fourth inning in the PCL's 3-0 loss to the International League.

Selected to pitch in the Triple-A All-Star game at Salt Lake, becoming just the fourth pitcher in team history to receive the honor, the last being starter Charlie Haeger in 2009.

Posted quality starts in eight straight outings from May 13 to June 20, going 4-1 with a 2.94 ERA (17 ER / 54.0 IP) in that span.

Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
