# ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (56-54) AT NEW ORLEANS ZEPHYRS (55-55)

ISOTOPES SLAMMED BY ZEPHYRS, 4-2: The Albuquerque Isotopes were burned by a former player, as Chris Aguila blasted a grand slam to power the New Orleans Zephyrs to a 4-2 win Monday night at Zephyr Field. With the Isotopes hanging on to a 2-0 lead in the sixth, reliever Ramon Troncoso started the frame by issuing back-to-back walks to Jorge Padilla and Joe Thurston. Mike Cervanek then slapped a single to shallow left, loading the bases for Aguila, who crushed a grand slam over the picnic pavilion in left field to immediately give the Z's a 4-2 lead. After the script had been flipped, the Zephyrs made sure the lead was preserved as relievers Peter Andrelczyk and Victor Garate authored a scoreless frame apiece before giving the ball to dominating closer Jose Ceda, who closed out the Isotopes in the ninth to seal the 4-2 win and nail down his 24th save of the season. Things started well enough for Albuquerque, as the Isotopes grabbed the first lead of the game with two runs in the third. A.J. Ellis led off the frame with a walk and scored all the way from first on a double by Justin Sellers to give the 'Topes a 1-0 edge. After a sacrifice moved Sellers to third, newest Isotope Brad Coon smashed a double to center for his first hit as a 'Tope, which also easily scored Sellers to give the visitors a 2-0 lead that would prove to not be enough.

EVE ROLLING: Isotopes ace Dana Eveland takes the mound riding a season-high four-game winning streak after tossing a three-hit shutout in his last outing on July 28 at Omaha. The shutout, Eveland's PCL-leading 11th victory of the season, was the left-hander's first in his nine-year career and ties him with Jeff Fulchino (2005) and Charlie Haeger (2009) for the second-most wins in a season by an Isotopes pitcher behind Giancarlo Alvarado (2009) and Frankie De La Cruz's (2008) 13. Over the course of his last four starts, Evelanad has been simply masterful, going 4-0 with a 0.90 ERA (3 ER / 30.0 IP). In his last 30.0 innings of work, Eveland has allowed just 15 hits and six walks while striking out 23. For his exploits in Omaha, Eveland yesterday was named PCL Pitcher of the Week, becoming the third Isotope this season to receive the honor.

AVOIDING THE BROOM: The Isotopes look to avoid their second series sweep of the season and their second sweep in team history to the New Orleans Zephyrs. The last time the 'Topes were swept in a four-game set was June 25-28 when Albuquerque lost four in a row to the Iowa Cubs in Des Moines, part of the Isotopes' franchise-record 10-game losing streak. The last time (and only time) the 'Topes were swept by the Z's was on May 23-26, 2008, when Albuquerque dropped four straight in the Big Easy, part of a six-game losing streak to New Orleans that season, which was also the last time the 'Topes had a losing record to the Z's over a single campaign (they went 6-10 that

SUMMER SELLERS: With two hits, including an RBI double yesterday, the first day of August, it appears that Justin Seller's hot summer is going to continue. In the months of June, July, and now August combined, Sellers is batting .353 (55x156) with 33 runs, 11 doubles, seven homers, and 28 RBI in 47 games. The infielder's .353 batting average is the 10th highest in the PCL over that summer-

NOT SO GRAND FEELING: Yesterday's grand slam was the fifth surrendered by Isotopes pitching this season, second-most in the Pacific Coast League to Nashville's six salamis allowed. Reliever Ramon Troncoso, who gave up the slam last night to Chris Aguila, has now allowed two slams in four days and, along with Sounds starter Amaury Rivas, is one of two PCL pitchers to give up two grand slams this season.

WALKING ON SUNSHINE: The Isotopes take the field for some morning baseball looking to turn around their luck when playing in the sunshine. Albuquerque has lost its last three day games and has a record on the year of 8-10 in the sunshine. After today, the 'Topes have three more day games left on the schedule, one in Sacramento (August 17), one at home (August 21), and one at Round Rock (Sept. 5). If Albuquerque wants to have a winning record in day games, today is a

TODAY'S START: Dana Eveland makes the start riding a season-high four-game winning streak after tossing a three-hit shutout masterpiece at Omaha on July 23. Eveland allowed the Storm Chasers just three hits, all singles, through nine shutout innings while walking one and striking out six in a 2-0 'Topes win. The shutout was Eveland's first of his nine-year career, and his first complete game since May 21, 2008 when he was a member of the Oakland Athletics and held Tampa Bay to one run on three hits in nine innings. The left-hander becomes just the seventh pitcher in Isotopes history to toss a nine-inning shutout and just the sixth PCL hurler to do it this year. Named PCL Pitcher of the Week on August 1 as a result of his efforts.

Appeared in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 in Salt Lake City, UT where he pitched a one-two-three fourth inning in the PCL's 3-0 loss to the International League.

Selected to pitch in the Triple-A All-Star game at Salt Lake, becoming just the fourth pitcher in team history to receive the honor, the last being starter Charlie Haeger in 2009.

Posted quality starts in eight straight outings from May 13 to June 20, going 4-1 with a 2.94~ERA~(17~ER~/54.0~IP) in that span.

Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances...with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
