MEMPHIS REDBIRDS (66-61) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (65-63)

DE JESUS DELIVERS ISOTOPES 6-5, WALK-OFF WIN: Ivan De Jesus Jr. hammered a two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth to give the Albuquerque Isotopes a dramatic, 6-5 walk-off win over the Memphis Redbirds on a sensational Saturday night at Isotopes Park. Albuquerque looked like it had the game well in hand, holding a 4-1 lead in the top of the ninth, but Memphis stormed ahead on 'Topes closer Jon Link. Adron Chambers got the rally started with a one-out double and immediately scored on a single by pinch-hitter Andrew Brown to trim the home team's lead to 4-2. After a single by Shane Robinson moved Brown to second, he cruised into third on a wild pitch by Link, where he scored on a groundout by Tyler Green to make it a one-run game at 4-3. Nick Stavinoha then blasted a Link offering onto the berm in right field for a two-run blast, giving Memphis an improbable 5-4 lead. It wouldn't last long, as Brad Coon led off the bottom of the ninth with a single in front of De Jesus, who crushed the game-winner over the wall in left-center, sending Albuquerque to a 6-5 win, its first walk-off victory since June 10.

KEISLER RETURNS: Lefty Randy Keisler makes his triumphant return after spending 10 days on the Disabled List recovering from a slightly strained right hamstring suffered in his last start at Isotopes Park on August 10. In that outing, Keisler was going to field a slow roller off the bat of Salt Lake Bees outfielder Jeremy Moore in the fourth inning and strained his hamstring, which forced him from the game after just three-plus innings in which he allowed four runs on four hits while walking two and striking out three. Now that he's back healthy, Keisler is also looking to put an end to a season-high three game losing streak, as he's taken the loss in each of the last three games he's started before being injured.

DE JESUS DECIDEDLY DOMINANT: Last night's two home run performances was a career-first for Ivan De Jesus Jr., and marked the first time he'd ever belted a walk-off home run in his seven-year professional career. In his last six home games, De Jesus is batting .320 (8x25) with six runs scored, three homers, and nine RBI. The infielder's next home run, he's already hit four this month, will tie his career high of seven set in 2008 in Jacksonville and equaled with the Isotopes last year.

ONE IS THE LONLIEST NUMBER: Of Albuquerque's six wins against the Memphis Redbirds this season, all of them have

come by one run. Strangely enough, the lopsided outcomes have come in a pair of losses, with both of them coming at pitcher-friendly AutoZone Park in Memphis when the 'Topes lost 10-4 and 11-1 in back-to-back games on May 31 and June 1.

FED FEELS RIGHT AT HOME: Tim Federowicz has certainly adjusted well to hitting in Isotopes Park. In seven games played at The Lab, Federowicz is batting .370 (10x27), with six of his 10 hits going for extra-bases (four homers and two doubles). The catcher has also homered in four of his six games in the Duke City.

FINAL FUN IN THE SUN: Today marks the final day game of the 2011 season at Isotopes Park. The 'Topes will play one more day game the last day of the regular season at Round Rock on September 5. This season, the 'Topes are 9-11 under the sun and 4-5 in day games played at home.

HOMETOWN HERO: Throwing out the first pitch as well as being recognized in an on-field ceremony today is Antonio Diaz Chacon, who bravely chased down and rescued a six year-old girl from an abductor on Monday, August 15.

FINAL HOMESTAND ROLLS ON!!: The final homestand of the regular season continues tonight with a visit from Birdzerk!, who will be making his one and only appearance at The Lab this year. Tomorrow, the Isotopes will have their third 50-Cent Hot Dog Night. And as you'd expect, the home slate ends with a bang, literally, with back-to-back Fan Appreciation Weekend fireworks shows next weekend.

TODAY'S START: Randy Keisler makes his first start after coming off the DL while
recovering from a slightly strained right hamstring suffered in a start on August 10 vs. Salt
Lake at Isotopes Park. In the fourth inning of that contest, Keisler went to field a slow roller
off the bat of Bees outfielder Jeremy Moore and strained his hamstring, forcing him from
the game after pitching three-plus innings in which he allowed four runs on four hits while
walking two and striking out three in a 10-7 'Topes loss, Keisler's third in as many starts.

Won four straight outings from June 6 to June 21, a span in which he posted a stellar 0.38 ERA (1 ER / 24.0 IP). On June 21 vs. Oklahoma City, Keisler came on in the second in relief of the rehabbing Jonathan Broxton and delivered six shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10, the most punch-outs by a 'Topes pitcher this year and the most by an Isotope in a relief appearance in franchise history.

Earned his second win of the season on June 11 vs. Nashville when he allowed just one run on just four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 5-2 'Topes win. Also pitched a gem on June 6 at Round Rock when he tossed six shutout innings, allowing just six hits and a walk while striking out four in an 11-0 win, his first victory of the season.

Earned PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for his back-to-back starts on June 6 and June 11 in which he went a combined 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER / 13.0 IP) while walking two and striking out 10.

Strained his right groin and hamstring in a start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).

Roped a pinch-hit RBI double on April 18 in an 8-6 win at Oklahoma City.

Signed a minor league contract with the Dodgers out of an open tryout at Spring Training on March 3 and joined the Isotopes as camp broke.

2010: Split the season between two independent league teams and Laguna of the Mexican League... was 3-3 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER / 43.0 IP) in seven starts for Laguna... pitched for Pensacola in the independent American Association, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER / 11.0 IP) in two starts... also spent time with Long Island in the independent Atlanic League, going 5-0 with a 3.65 ERA (20 ER 49.1 IP) in eight starts... struck out 43 while walking just 18 in 49.1 innings with the Ducks.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League in 2009, going 2-2 with a 6.89 ERA (24 ER / 31.1 IP) in six starts.

Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on January 11, 2008 but was released during Spring Training... signed on the Cubs and began the season with Triple-A Iowa, going 4-6 with a 3.14 ERA (23 ER / 66.0 IP) in 12 games (11 starts)... fanned 65 while walking 26 and allowed just four home runs in 66 innings... opted out of his contract on June 10 and was signed by Baltimore.. went 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER / 48.0 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) for Triple-A Norfolk... went a combined 6-9 with a 4.03 ERA in 20 starts between both Triple-A teams.

Began the 2007 season at Triple-A Memphis and was recalled to the St. Louis Cardinals on April 9... made four appearances, three starts, for St. Louis before being optioned on April 27... was 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 ER / 39.1 IP) in six starts from June 10 to July 5... tossed six-plus innings on 16 consecutive starts from June 10 to September 2... recalled on July 27 but optioned again on July 31... outrighted to Memphis on September 6.

Starte the 2006 season at Triple-A Sacramento... won three consecutive starts, going 3-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER / 18.0 IP) from April 22 to May 2... contract was selected on May 12 and made 11 relief appearances with the A's before being optioned on June 9... had a four-game winning streak from July 4 to August 11... recalled on July 26 and optioned again on July 28... outrighted to Sacramento on August 8.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Randy Dean Keisler... was a 1994 graduate of Palmer (TX) High School after attending Navasota (TX) High School prior to his senior year... attended Louisiana State University and was named to the All-Southeastern Conference College World Series Team as a junior.. spent his first two collegiate seasons at Navarro (TX) Junior College... drafted by New York (AL) in the second round of the 1998 draft.
