REDBIRDS OUTRACE ISOTOPES, 10-5: After building an early lead, the Albuquerque Isotopes surrendered seven runs over the sixth through the ninth innings before succumbing to the Memphis Redbirds 10-5 on a beautiful Sunday afternoon at Isotopes Park. Memphis plated a run in the top of the first, but the 'Topes answered in the bottom of the frame, scoring three times thanks to a series of Redbirds miscues. With a man on first, Ivan De Jesus Jr. hit into a tailor-made double-play, but shortstop Tyler Greene couldn't handle the feed from second baseman Pete Kozma and both 'Topes ended up safe. After catcher Bryan Anderson dropped an easy foul pop for the second error of the inning, Jay Gibbons roped an RBI single, tying the game at 1-1. Russ Mitchell then knocked in De Jesus with a sacrifice fly before Jerry Sands hit a grounder to third that should've also been a Redbirds twin-killing, but Kozma couldn't catch the throw from third baseman Mark Hamilton, allowing Gibbons to streak into third while Sands trotted into second. Jamie Hoffmann then plated Gibbons with an RBI groundout, giving the home team an early 3-1 lead on three Memphis errors. Albuquerque added another tally in the second when Gibbons laced another RBI base hit to extend the home team's lead to 4-1. The 'Birds chipped into the cushion in the third with a solo homer by Nick Stavinoha and again in the fourth on an RBI single by Andrew Brown to draw within 4-3 before surging ahead with four runs in the sixth, making the score 7-4. Memphis would add another run in the seventh before the Isotopes responded in the form of a solo blast to right by Gibbons that trimmed the deficit to 8-5. The three-run deficit was as close as the Isotopes would get, however, as the 'Birds plated a tally in the eighth and another in the ninth to cruise to a 10-5 win.

HOWDY STRANGER: Lefty Alberto Bastardo makes his first start at Isotopes Park since May 26 after a string of four straight road starts surrounding three months on the Disabled List with a severely sprained ankle. If his last outing is any indication, Bastardo has shaken off any rust accumulated over the extended DL stay. On August 17, the lefty held the Sacramento River Cats, one of the best teams in the PCL, scoreless on just three hits through 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four. Despite leaving the game with a 2-0 lead, Bastardo did not figure in the decision after the Cats rallied for two runs in the seventh, sending the game into extra innings, where Sacramento eventually prevailed in 13 innings, 4-3. The southpaw has made four starts at The Lab this season, going 1-0 with a 4.84 ERA (12 ER / 22.1 IP).

GOOD STARTS: Through the last turn in the rotation, Isotopes starters have been superb, posting a 2.86 ERA (9 ER / 28.1 IP) with a total of 30 strikeouts over the last five games. Unfortunately, due to late rallies by both Albuquerque and its opponent, the group is 0-1 with four no-decisions over that span. The last time a 'Topes starter earned a victory was on August 15 in Fresno when right-hander Mike Parisi beat the Grizzlies 8-4.

KNOCK FOUR TIMES: With his excellent 4-for-5 performance yesterday, Jay Gibbons added his name to the list of Isotopes who have collected four knocks or more in a game this season. A total of 12 different players have reached four hits or more a total of 20 times this year for Albuquerque, including three five-hit performances. Gibbons' four-hit day was his first for the 'Topes since July 31 of last year.

CASE OF THE MONDAYS: Last week's win at Fresno broke a streak in which the 'Topes had lost six Monday games in a row, with their last Monday win prior to August 15 coming on June 20. This season, the Isotopes are a total of 10-9, one of three days of the week in which Albuquerque has a winning record (Monday, Thursday, and Saturday).

FINAL HOMESTAND ROLLS ON !!: The final homestand of the regular season continues tonight with the third and final 50-Cent Hot Dog Night of the season. And as you'd expect, the home slate ends with a bang, literally, with back-to-back Fan Appreciation Weekend fireworks shows next weekend

TODAY'S START: Alberto Bastardo makes the start coming off a brilliant outing on
August 17 at Sacramento when he pitched 5.1 shutout innings, allowing just three hits
while walking two and striking out four. Did not end up with a decision, however,
Sacramento rallied late, sending the game into extra innings where the River Cats
eventually prevailed, 4-3 in 13 innings.

Suffered the ankle sprain in a game at Round Rock on June 5. He faced just three batters, getting a groundout and surrendering two hits before he turned his ankle while going to back up third on a single by Chris Davis. Placed on the Disabled List on June 9 and reinstated on August 12.

Made three rehab starts for the Arizona League Dodgers, going 0-0 with a 3.24 ERA (3 ER / 8.1 IP).

Missed one turn in the rotation on May 20 with a sore lower back, but did not go on the DL and returned to the rotation in a start vs. Colorado Springs on May 26.

Suffered his first loss of the season on May 10 at Las Vegas, when he allowed five runs, two earned, on six hits in six innings of work in a 7-0 loss. Earned his second win of the season and second consecutive victory on April 29 in which he out-pitched 2009 Cy Young Award winner Zack Greinke, who was making a rehab assignment for the Nashville Sounds. Bastardo allowed just one run on five hits in 7.1 innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-1 'Topes win over the Sounds. Got his first win of the season on April 23 against New Orleans at Isotopes Park when he pitched six innings, allowing four runs on nine hits whie walking none and striking out seven in a 12-8 'Topes win.

2010: Split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 12-8 with a 5.68 ERA in 27 starts... tied for the Dodger organizational lead with 12 wins and 27 starts... won the May Dodger Pride Award for Chattanooga, going 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER/31.2 IP) in five starts in the month... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of May 17-23, going 2-0 and allowing only an unearned run with 14 strikeouts in 14.0 innings in his two starts... took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on May 17 at Mobile before giving up a one-out single... ended up pitching seven shutout innings, giving up the one hit while walking two and striking out seven in a 7-0 Lookouts win... transferred to Albuquerque on June 10 and won three straight decisions... transferred back to Chattanooga on August 13 and finished the year in Chattanooga... following the season, played for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Winter League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Saw action in 2009 at three levels of Dodgers system, starting in Single-A Inland Empire, stoppnig at Double-A Chattanooga and ending the season with an appearance at Triple-A Albuquerque... combined to go 12-5 with a 4.01 ERA (66 ER / 148.1 IP) in all three stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 6-2 with a 3.84 ERA (32 ER / 75.0 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... selected to the California League Mid-Season All-Star team on June 23... transferred to Chattanooga on June 25 and went 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA (34 ER / 72.1 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... tossed a complete-game on August 5 vs. West Tenn., allowing two runs on three hits in nine innings while striking out eight... transferred to Albuquerque on September 6 and made a relief appearance in the last game of the regular season at Iowa on September 7, firing a scoreless inning... was on the Isotopes' playoff roster and was slated to start game four of the first round but did not pitch as the 'Topes were swept in three games.

Spent the entire 2008 season with Single-A Inland Empire of the California League, going 5-8 with a 5.19 ERA (76 ER / 131.2 IP) in 30 appearances (21 starts)... went 5-8 with a 4.70 ERA (55 ER / 105.1 IP) in 21 starts and 0-0 with a 7.18 ERA (21 ER / 26.1 IP) in nine relief appearances.
