### MEMPHIS REDBIRDS (68-61) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (65-65)

**'BIRDS BLAST ISOTOPES, 16-7:** The Albuquerque Isotopes fell victim to an early avalanche of runs as the Memphis Redbirds plated 12 runs in the first three innings and cruised to a 16-7 win Monday evening at Isotopes Park. It became clear quickly that this would not be the Isotopes' night, with the Redbirds racing out to a 9-0 lead after the first two innings on the strength of two Tyler Greene homers, a solo shot in the first and a two-run blast in the second. Albuquerque started chipping away in the bottom of the second, when Russ Mitchell led off with a walk and Jerry Sands followed with a double that sent Mitchell to third. Sands' knock was mishandled in left by Andrew Brown, however, allowing Mitchell to score the Isotopes' first run while Sands hustled into third. Jamie Hoffmann promptly picked him up, roping a single to center that easily scored Sands and trimmed the Memphis lead to 9-2. The 'Birds retaliated with three runs in the third to open up a 12-2 advantage before the Isotopes got on the board again in the fourth. After another Sands double, Hoffmann blasted a two-run shot to left to close the gap to 12-4. Tim Federowicz continued the rally with a walk in front of Damaso Espino, who laced a double to right. Nick Stavinoza picked up the ball and fired it to the cut-off man at second Pete Kozma, who couldn't hang on to it, allowing Federowicz to score and make the score 12-5 'Birds. The Redbirds opened up a 16-5 lead with two in the fifth and two more in the seventh before the Isotopes staged another rally in the eighth. Mitchell led off the frame with a single for Sands, who crushed a two-run homer right-center bringing the final margin to 16-7 Redbirds.

**ELY ELAN:** Right-hander John Ely makes the start looking to snap a two-game Isotopes losing streak while continuing his own solid pitching. Since July 1, Ely has gone 4-1 with a 4.31 ERA (23 ER / 48.0 IP) over eight starts, tied for the fourth-most victories in the PCL over that span. His only loss in that time frame came in his last home start on August 8 vs. Salt Lake, when he allowed an uncharacteristic seven runs on 11 hits in 4.1 innings of a 9-6 Isotopes loss to the Bees. Part of the reason for Ely's excellence of late has been the fact he's been keeping walks to a minimum, especially in August. Through 17.0 innings over three August starts, the right-hander has walked just five batters while fanning 15.

**TRAGIC NUMBER:** With credit to Albuquerque Journal writer Ken Sickenger, who coined the phrase, the Isotopes' number for elimination, or "Tragic Number," entering tonight is just two. If Round Rock beats New Orleans tonight at The Dell Diamond and the 'Topes fall to Memphis, the Express will clinch the PCL's American Southern Division.

**HEAD ABOVE WATER:** Albuquerque looks to break a two-game losing streak while also continuing their streak of having a .500 record or better this season. Through 130 games, the 'Topes have not had a losing record all season, with the last time the Isotopes were below .500 taking place on September 4 of last year, when the 'Topes were 70-71 before winning two straight and finishing the year with a winning record. With a mark of 65-65, this is just the third time all season Albuquerque has been at .500 (the other times were when the club was 2-2 on April 10 and 60-60 on August 12).

**THERE'S SOMETHING ABOUT JERRY:** Jerry Sands has collected hits in five of his last six home games, racking up 10 knocks in 25 at-bats (.400) over that span with seven runs, four doubles, three homers, and seven RBI.

**TICKETS FOR THIS WEEKEND GOING FAST!:** Fan Appreciation weekend is shaping up to be huge at Isotopes Park, as tickets for Saturday and Sunday are going fast. Act now and make sure you don't miss out on Isotopes grab bags and post-game fireworks!

**FINAL HOMESTAND ROLLS ON!:** The final homestand of the regular season continues tonight with one final game against the Memphis Redbirds before the Round Rock Express come to town. And as you'd expect, the home slate ends with a bang, literally, with back-to-back Fan Appreciation Weekend fireworks shows this Saturday and Sunday.

**TODAY'S START:** John Ely takes the mound coming off a no-decision on August 18 at Sacramento when he allowed the River Cats just one run on six hits in 6.2 innings while walking two and striking out seven in an eventual 2-1 'Topes win. Ely departed the game with the game tied 1-1, before Albuquerque plated a run in the eighth.

Had a short stay with the Dodgers after being recalled on August 1 and was inserted into the Los Angeles bullpen, but did not appear in any games. Optioned back to Albuquerque on August 7.

Won three straight starts from July 3 to July 17, posting a 1.89 ERA (4 ER / 19.0 IP) in that span.

Had a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. In defeat, Ely had dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

**2010:** Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game.
