DE JESUS' DINGERS DELIVER 'TOPES 13-3 WIN: Infielder Ivan De Jesus Jr., belted a pair of home runs, including a grand slam, to lead the Albuquerque Isotopes to a 13-3 win over the Round Rock Express Thursday night at Isotopes Park. Round Rock grabbed a quick lead in the first inning, scoring three runs, but the rest of the game belonged to the Isotopes. De Jesus, batting lead-off for the 'Topes, started the bottom of the first with a solo blast to left center, trimming the Express lead to 3-1 before Albuquerque erupted for five runs in the second inning. With two out and runners on first and second, Joe Becker slapped single to center, plating Ivan Ochoa and cutting the Round Rock advantage to 3-2. After Russ Mitchell tied the game with an RBI single to right, Jerry Sands hammered a three-run blast to left, giving Albuquerque a 6-3 lead. Tim Federowicz helped stretch the lead to 7-3 with a solo homer of his own in the third and Damaso Espino added an RBI single in the fifth that scored John Lindsey and augmented the home team's advantage to 8-3. Albuquerque would add another crooked number to the scoreboard in the seventh, when Lindsey singled in front of back-to-back walks by Federowicz and Ochoa, loading the bases with one out for De Jesus, who smashed a grand slam that curled around the foul pole in left and immediately gave the Isotopes a comfortable 12-3 cushion. The Isotopes then capped the scoring on an RBI single by Federowicz with two outs in the eighth to cruise to the 13-3 victory.

THE KEIS TO SUCCESS AT THE LAB: Left-hander Randy Keisler makes the start coming off a solid performance in his last outing, his first since coming off the DL with a strained hamstring, on August 21 vs. Memphis when he allowed three runs on just five hits in five innings while walking two and striking out two. Despite the fact he's still not totally healthy, Keisler not only logged five solid frames, he legged out a double and scored a run. Although the left-hander departed the game with a 4-3 lead, the Redbirds rallied late to grab a 10-5 win, leaving Keisler with a tough-luck no-decision. The win would've been the left-hander's fifth of the season at Isotopes Park, where he's been excellent. In nine games (eight starts) at The Lab, Keisler is 4-3 with a 5.21 ERA (27 ER / 46.2 IP). He's tied with reliever Travis Schlichting for the second-most wins by a 'Topes pitcher at home behind Dana Eveland's six.

LONG BALL IVAN: Infielder Ivan De Jesus Jr. continues to demonstrate his power stroke this month, belting six of his career-high eight home runs in the month of August. Last night's two homer performance was not only his second multi-homer game of his career, it was the second in six games, following closely on the heels of a two-homer game on August 20 vs. Memphis. Last night De Jesus

also smashed the third grand slam of his career, and his second salami this month. On August 9, the infielder hit a grand slam against Salt Lake, his first slam since April 20, 2008 when he hit a bases-loaded home run for Double-A Jacksonville against Montgomery. In the ultimate of strange ironies, all three of De Jesus's grand slams over his career have come in the seventh inning.

SANDS CAN HIT 'EM FAR TOO: Not to be outdone by the homer heroics of Ivan De Jesus, slugging outfielder Jerry Sands has homered in each of his last two games and in three of his last four, bringing his total in the month of August to 10, the most in the Pacific Coast League. Sands' 27 home runs on the year is tops among the Isotopes and tied for fourth in the PCL.

CHAMPION BROADCASTER: Congratulations to Voice of the Isotopes Robert Portnoy, who has been selected to call the Triple-A Baseball National Championship Game on the Versus Television Network. Joining Robert in the booth will be former Major Leaguer and Triple-A manager Bucky Dent, while Pawtucket Red Sox broadcaster Steve Hyder will serve as the broadcast's field reporter.

Memphis rallied late for the win. The pitcher also hammered a double and scored a run in
the contest.
Pleased on the DL on August 12 (retrocative to August 11) with a strained right homotring

Placed on the DL on August 12 (retroactive to August 11) with a strained right hamstring suffered in a start on August 10 vs. Salt Lake at Isotopes Park. In the fourth inning of that contest, Keisler went to field a slow roller off the bat of Bees outfielder Jeremy Moore and strained his hamstring, forcing him from the game after pitching three-plus innings in which he allowed four runs on four hits while walking two and striking out three in a 10-7 'Topes loss, Keisler's third in as many starts. Reinstated from the DL on August 21.

Won four straight outings from June 6 to June 21, a span in which he posted a stellar 0.38 ERA (1 ER / 24.0 IP). On June 21 vs. Oklahoma City, Keisler came on in the second in relief of the rehabbing Jonathan Broxton and delivered six shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10, the most punch-outs by a 'Topes pitcher this year and the most by an Isotope in a relief appearance in franchise history.

Earned his second win of the season on June 11 vs. Nashville when he allowed just one run on just four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 5-2 'Topes win. Also pitched a gem on June 6 at Round Rock when he tossed six shutout innings, allowing just six hits and a walk while striking out four in an 11-0 win, his first victory of the season.

Earned PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for his back-to-back starts on June 6 and June 11 in which he went a combined 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER / 13.0 IP) while walking two and striking out 10.

Strained his right groin and hamstring in a start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).

Roped a pinch-hit RBI double on April 18 in an 8-6 win at Oklahoma City.

Signed a minor league contract with the Dodgers out of an open tryout at Spring Training on March 3 and joined the Isotopes as camp broke.

2010: Split the season between two independent league teams and Laguna of the Mexican League... was 3-3 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER / 43.0 IP) in seven starts for Laguna... pitched for Pensacola in the independent American Association, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER / 11.0 IP) in two starts... also spent time with Long Island in the independent Atlanic League, going 5-0 with a 3.65 ERA (20 ER 49.1 IP) in eight starts... struck out 43 while walking just 18 in 49.1 innings with the Ducks.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League in 2009, going 2-2 with a 6.89 ERA (24 ER / 31.1 IP) in six starts.

Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on January 11, 2008 but was released during Spring Training... signed on the Cubs and began the season with Triple-A Iowa, going 4-6 with a 3.14 ERA (23 ER / 66.0 IP) in 12 games (11 starts)... fanned 65 while walking 26 and allowed just four home runs in 66 innings... opted out of his contract on June 10 and was signed by Baltimore.. went 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER / 48.0 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) for Triple-A Norfolk... went a combined 6-9 with a 4.03 ERA in 20 starts between both Triple-A teams.

Began the 2007 season at Triple-A Memphis and was recalled to the St. Louis Cardinals on April 9... made four appearances, three starts, for St. Louis before being optioned on April 27... was 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 ER / 39.1 IP) in six starts from June 10 to July 5... tossed six-plus innings on 16 consecutive starts from June 10 to September 2... recalled on July 27 but optioned again on July 31... outrighted to Memphis on September 6.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Randy Dean Keisler... was a 1994 graduate of Palmer (TX) High School after attending Navasota (TX) High School prior to his senior year... attended Louisiana State University and was named to the All-Southeastern Conference College World Series Team as a junior.. spent his first two collegiate seasons at Navarro (TX) Junior College... drafted by New York (AL) in the second round of the 1998 draft.
