KEISLER IN CONTROL AS 'TOPES WIN 9-0: Albuquerque Isotopes starting pitcher Randy Keisler doused the bats of one of the Pacific Coast League's hottest-hitting teams, holding the Round Rock Express to just three hits through seven innings in a 9-0 'Topes triumph Friday night at Isotopes Park. Keisler came right out of the gate dealing, retiring the first seven batters he faced before yielding a single in the third. The three hits the southpaw allowed were all singles as he cruised through his seven frames of work, walking one and striking out eight to earn his seventh victory of the year. Keisler (7-7) tossed 96 pitches, an amazing 67 of them for strikes. With Keisler in control, the Isotopes offense went to work immediately in the bottom of the first, plating three runs, two on a double by John Lindsey to grab a quick 3-0 lead. After Albuquerque added a run in the third, the 'Topes erupted for four runs in the fourth to seize control of the contest. With runners on the corners and two down, Ivan De Jesus ripped a triple over the head of centerfielder Leonys Martin, scoring both runners and increasing the home team's advantage to 6-0. Joe Becker then added his second triple in as many at-bats, plating De Jesus before trotting home on an RBI single by Mitchell to give Albuquerque an 8-0 cushion. Russ Mitchell would cap the Isotopes scoring the sixth, scoring De Jesus with an RBI single and sending the 'Topes to a 9-0 win. Reliever Ramon Troncoso came on in relief of Keisler and authored a scoreless eighth before Jon Link retired the Express 1-2-3 in the ninth to preserve the shutout.

DR. JEKYLL AND MR. BASTARDO: In just three starts since returning from over two months on the DL with a severe left ankle sprain, Alberto Bastardo has experienced opposite ends of the pitching spectrum. In his first start back with the Isotopes on August 12 at Fresno, the left-hander allowed seven runs, six earned, on eight hits in just two innings, but followed that up in Sacramento five days later with one of his most dominant outings, shutting out the River Cats on three hits in 5.1 innings. Then, Bastardo suffered one of his toughest outings of the season on August 22 vs. Memphis, when he yielded a season-high eight earned runs in just 1.1 innings, his shortest outing of the season aside from the start in Round Rock on June 5 when he injured his ankle. Before he got hurt, Bastardo was one of the 'Topes' most solid starters, authoring four quality starts in his six outings immediately prior to getting injured.

TIME TO START THINKING SERIES-LY: If the Isotopes can win one of their next two games, they'll record a series win for the first time since August 12-15, when they won three of four at Fresno and their first home series victory since taking two of three against these very Express on July 4-6.

TWO-OUT TANGO: In their last two games, the 'Topes have driven in a total of 12 runs with two out, six in each contest, meaning over half of the total 22 runs scored in those two victories came with two down. On the season, the Isotopes are batting .285 (169x594) with 217 RBI when there are runners in scoring position and two outs.

BECKS MARKS THE SPOT: After not recording a triple all season, Joe Becker hit a pair in consecutive at-bats last night, becoming just the sixth Isotope in team history to hit two triples in a game. The last one to do it was none other than John Lindsey, who hit a pair of three-bageers on July 27 of last year vs. Iowa.

RUSSELL HAS THE MUSCLE: Albuquerque yesterday welcomed Kyle Russell to the roster, and the outfielder celebrated his arrival by recording a base hit in his first Triple-A at-bat. Russell, who was a sensational college player at the University of Texas, arrives having enjoyed an excellent year at Double-A Chattanooga. In 120 games for the Lookouts (third most on the club), Russell batted .259 (102x394) with 29 doubles, four triples, and 69 RBI. He also led Chattanooga with 19 home runs while ranking fifth in the Southern League with 52 extra-base hits. Russell, who entered the season as the Dodgers' No. 15 prospect according to Baseball America, earned SL Batter of the Week from May 23-31 and was selected to the Southern League mid-season All-Star Team.

TODAY'S START: Lefty Alberto Bastardo takes the mound coming off his roughest outing of the season on August 22 vs. Memphis, when he allowed eight runs on eight hits in just 1.1 innings in a 16-7 loss to the Redbirds.

Suffered a severe left ankle sprain in a game at Round Rock on June 5. He faced just three batters, getting a groundout and surrendering two hits before he turned his ankle while going to back up third on a single by Chris Davis. Placed on the Disabled List on June 9 and reinstated on August 12.

Made three rehab starts for the Arizona League Dodgers, going 0-0 with a 3.24 ERA (3 ER / 8.1 IP).

Missed one turn in the rotation on May 20 with a sore lower back, but did not go on the DL and returned to the rotation in a start vs. Colorado Springs on May 26.

Suffered his first loss of the season on May 10 at Las Vegas, when he allowed five runs, two earned, on six hits in six innings of work in a 7-0 loss. Earned his second win of the season and second consecutive victory on April 29 in which he out-pitched 2009 Cy Young Award winner Zack Greinke, who was making a rehab assignment for the Nashville Sounds. Bastardo allowed just one run on five hits in 7.1 innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-1 'Topes win over the Sounds. Got his first win of the season on April 23 against New Orleans at Isotopes Park when he pitched six innings, allowing four runs on nine hits whie walking none and striking out seven in a 12-8 'Topes win.

2010: Split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 12-8 with a 5.68 ERA in 27 starts... tied for the Dodger organizational lead with 12 wins and 27 starts... won the May Dodger Pride Award for Chattanooga, going 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER/31.2 IP) in five starts in the month... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of May 17-23, going 2-0 and allowing only an unearned run with 14 strikeouts in 14.0 innings in his two starts... took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on May 17 at Mobile before giving up a one-out single... ended up pitching seven shutout innings, giving up the one hit while walking two and striking out seven in a 7-0 Lookouts win... transferred to Albuquerque on June 10 and won three straight decisions... transferred back to Chattanooga on August 13 and finished the year in Chattanooga... following the season, played for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Winter League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Saw action in 2009 at three levels of Dodgers system, starting in Single-A Inland Empire, stoppnig at Double-A Chattanooga and ending the season with an appearance at Triple-A Albuquerque... combined to go 12-5 with a 4.01 ERA (66 ER / 148.1 IP) in all three stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 6-2 with a 3.84 ERA (32 ER / 75.0 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... selected to the California League Mid-Season All-Star team on June 23... transferred to Chattanooga on June 25 and went 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA (34 ER / 72.1 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... tossed a complete-game on August 5 vs. West Tenn., allowing two runs on three hits in nine innings while striking out eight... transferred to Albuquerque on September 6 and made a relief appearance in the last game of the regular season at Iowa on September 7, firing a scoreless inning... was on the Isotopes' playoff roster and was slated to start game four of the first round but did not pitch as the 'Topes were swept in three games.

Spent the entire 2008 season with Single-A Inland Empire of the California League, going 5-8 with a 5.19 ERA (76 ER / 131.2 IP) in 30 appearances (21 starts)... went 5-8 with a 4.70 ERA (55 ER / 105.1 IP) in 21 starts and 0-0 with a 7.18 ERA (21 ER / 26.1 IP) in nine relief appearances.
