'TOPES BURIED BY RAINIERS, 12-4: The Albuquerque Isotopes served up a season-high five home runs, three to Alex Liddi alone, as the Tacoma Rainiers cruised to a 12-4 win Thursday night at Isotopes Park. Albuquerque jumped on the board first thanks to a solo home run from John Lindsey in the second but the game belonged to the two-man wrecking crew of Liddi and Wily Mo Pena shortly thereafter. With one on and two outs in the top of the third, Liddi hammered a two-run blast deep to center that gave the Rainiers a quick 2-1 lead. Liddi barely had time to grab a seat in the dugout before the next batter Pena crushed a solo shot to over the batter's eye in straightaway center to put Tacoma ahead 3-1. Mike Wilson then added a two-run double before scoring on a double by Johan Liminta to give Tacoma a 6-1 cushion. The 'Topes answered quickly in the bottom of the third, however, when Brad Coon lined a single to left, putting a runner on for Jay Gibbons, who smashed a homer onto the berm in right, cutting the deficit to 6-3. Russ Mitchell then singled down the third base line and scampered into second when left fielder Carlos Peguero mishandled the ball for an error, moving into scoring position for Jamie Hoffmann, who slapped a single to left, scoring Mitchell and drawing Albuquerque back within two at 6-4. That's as close as the home team would get, as Tacoma plated three in the fourth on a mammoth three-run blast from Pena before tacking on another tally in the sixth on a solo shot by Liddi to surge to 10-4 lead. Liddi added the exclamation point on a huge night in the eighth with a two-run homer, sending the Rainiers to a 12-4 win.

HOME TOWN HERO: Lefty Randy Keisler takes the mound looking to continue his mastery of Isotopes Park. Where most pitchers struggle in the hitter-friendly environs of The Lab, Keisler excels, posting a 4-1 record with a 3.48 ERA (13 ER / 33.2 IP) in six games (five starts) this year in Albuquerque. The left-hander has won each of his last four starts at Isotopes Park, with his only loss coming in his second start of the season on April 14 vs. Iowa. Keisler also comes in looking to rebound from one of his toughest outings of the year in his last start. On July 31 at New Orleans, Keisler gave up a season-high eight runs on six hits in 2.2 frames, his shortest outing since he tossed 2.2 innings at Iowa on April 21, a start he was forced to leave early after sustaining a strained right groin and strained right hamstring.

DEAR JOHN: John Lindsey has shown zero rust since returning from a month on the DL rehabbing a strained left hamstring. In two games since coming back, Lindsey has gone 4-for-7 with two doubles, a homer, and two RBI. In fact, Lindsey has picked up right where he left off when he landed on the DL on July 9 in that he continues to be red-hot. The DH has gotten a hit in each of his last eight games dating back to July 3, a span in which he's gone 13-for-29 (.448) with six runs, three homers, and nine RBI. He's also doubled in each of his last four games.

WHAT A WEEK!: In a six-day span that you couldn't make up if you tried, outfielder Trayvon Robinson has gone from Isotopes stalwart, to traded to Tacoma, to making his Major League debut. Today the Seattle Mariners, who traded for Robinson minutes before last Sunday's trade deadline in a deal that sent lefty starter Erik Bedard to the Boston Red Sox, called up the outfielder from Tacoma, with whom he appeared in just three games (one in Albuquerque). Adding to the story-book nature of the whole thing, Robinson will be making his debut in his hometown of Los Angeles, as the M's open up a series tonight with the Los Angeles Angels.

since April 21 in Iowa when he was forced to leave the game after 2.2 innings with a strained right groin and hamstring. In his last outing on July 31 at New Orleans, Keisler gave up a season-high eight runs on six hits in 2.2 innings while walking four and striking out two in a 9-3 Isotopes loss.

TODAY'S START: Randy Keisler makes the start coming off his most difficult outing

Won four straight outings from June 6 to June 21, a span in which he posted a stellar 0.38 ERA (1 ER / 24.0 IP). On June 21 vs. Oklahoma City, Keisler came on in the second in relief of the rehabbing Jonathan Broxton and delivered six shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10, the most punch-outs by a 'Topes pitcher this year and the most by an Isotope in a relief appearance in franchise history.

Earned his second win of the season on June 11 vs. Nashville when he allowed just one run on just four hits in a season-high seven innings while walking one and striking out six in a 5-2 'Topes win. Also pitched a gem on June 6 at Round Rock when he tossed six shutout innings, allowing just six hits and a walk while striking out four in an 11-0 win, his first victory of the season.

Earned PCL Pitcher of the Week honors for his back-to-back starts on June 6 and June 11 in which he went a combined 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER / 13.0 IP) while walking two and striking out 10.

Strained his right groin and hamstring in a start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).

Roped a pinch-hit RBI double on April 18 in an 8-6 win at Oklahoma City.

Signed a minor league contract with the Dodgers out of an open tryout at Spring Training on March 3 and joined the Isotopes as camp broke.

2010: Split the season between two independent league teams and Laguna of the Mexican League... was 3-3 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER / 43.0 IP) in seven starts for Laguna... pitched for Pensacola in the independent American Association, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER / 11.0 IP) in two starts... also spent time with Long Island in the independent Atlanic League, going 5-0 with a 3.65 ERA (20 ER 49.1 IP) in eight starts... struck out 43 while walking just 18 in 49.1 innings with the Ducks.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League in 2009, going 2-2 with a 6.89 ERA (24 ER / 31.1 IP) in six starts.

Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on January 11, 2008 but was released during Spring Training... signed on the Cubs and began the season with Triple-A Iowa, going 4-6 with a 3.14 ERA (23 ER / 66.0 IP) in 12 games (11 starts)... fanned 65 while walking 26 and allowed just four home runs in 66 innings... opted out of his contract on June 10 and was signed by Baltimore.. went 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER / 48.0 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) for Triple-A Norfolk... went a combined 6-9 with a 4.03 ERA in 20 starts between both Triple-A teams.

Began the 2007 season at Triple-A Memphis and was recalled to the St. Louis Cardinals on April 9... made four appearances, three starts, for St. Louis before being optioned on April 27... was 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 ER / 39.1 IP) in six starts from June 10 to July 5... tossed six-plus innings on 16 consecutive starts from June 10 to September 2... recalled on July 27 but optioned again on July 31... outrighted to Memphis on September 6.

Starte the 2006 season at Triple-A Sacramento... won three consecutive starts, going 3-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER / 18.0 IP) from April 22 to May 2... contract was selected on May 12 and made 11 relief appearances with the A's before being optioned on June 9... had a four-game winning streak from July 4 to August 11... recalled on July 26 and optioned again on July 28... outrighted to Sacramento on August 8.
