## TACOMA RAINIERS (57-57) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (58-56)

TACOMA TOPPLES 'TOPES, 13-9: Designated Hitter John Lindsey hit his second home run in as many nights, but it wasn't enough as the Albuquerque Isotopes were out-paced by the Tacoma Rainiers 13-9 in a Friday night slugfest at Isotopes Park. For the second straight game, the 'Topes jumped out an early lead when Justin Sellers led off the bottom of the first with a solo blast, giving Albuquerque an early 1-0 edge. Tacoma showed it can deliver the long ball as well, answering with two in the top of the second thanks to a mammoth two-run blast by Jose Yepez to left-center that gave the Rainiers a quick 2-1 lead. Tacoma added three more in the third in a rally ignited by a solo blow from Matt Tuiasosopo leading off the frame that increased the visitor's lead to 3-1 before an RBI fielder's choice and a run-scoring error made the score 5-1 Rainiers. Albuquerque rallied immediately in the bottom of the frame thanks to a power display of its own. After a two-run single by Russ Mitchell, Lindsey deposited a three-run blast onto the berm in right-center that instantly gave the 'Topes the lead right back at 6-5. The Isotopes tacked on another run in the fourth when Sellers led off the inning with a triple and scored on a fielder's choice by Jay Gibbons, making it 7-5 before the Rainiers surged ahead for good in the fifth. After an RBI fielder's choice, Mike Wilson crushed a two-run homer to left that gave the visitors an 8-7 lead. Tacoma added some cushion in the eighth, racking up five runs to give the Rainiers a comfortable 13-7 margin. Still, Albuquerque kept fighting as Tim Federowicz collected his first Triple-A hit in the form of a solo homer in the eighth to cut the lead to 13-8 Tacoma before adding one final tally in the ninth on a lead-off triple by Mitchell and an RBI groundout by Sands to draw within the 13-9 final score.

THE CAT IN THE ROTATION: Right-hander Francisco Felix makes the start as a newly-minted member of the Isotopes rotation and comes in riding some momentum after a brilliant performance in his last turn. In New Orleans on August 1, Felix was pressed into service in a spot-start when John Ely was recalled to Los Angeles and pitched five scoreless innings, allowing just one hit while walking two and striking out three. Felix even had a chance at the victory, leaving with a 2-0 lead, but the Zephyrs scored four in the bottom of the sixth on a home run by Chris Aguila to take a 4-2 triumph. This will be Felix's first appearance at Isotopes Park since way back on May 25 when he got a win in relief against Colorado Springs. Since then he's make five straight appearances on the road sandwiching a 10-game stint with Saltillo in the Mexican League.

**SALVAGE A SPLIT:** The Isotopes look to grab a win and avoid just their second series loss at home this year. The only series defeat the 'Topes have had at The Lab was when Oklahoma City came in and took three of four from Albuquerque on June 21-24. This year, the Isotopes have won eight series, lost one, and tied five at Isotopes Park.

PLAYING LONG BALL: The Isotopes and Rainiers have lived up to their reputation coming in as home run threats, with both teams combining for 16 home runs in just three games, with Tacoma belting 10. On the year, the Rainiers are fourth in the PCL with 143 dingers, while Albuquerque is right behind them in fifth with 142.

**SELLS ALWAYS AT THE RIGHT PRICE:** Despite enduring innumerable bumps and bruises, including getting hit in the hand by a pitch last Tuesday in New Orleans, Justin Sellers continues to not only play, but play well. Since July 4, Sellers is batting .380 (27x71) with 13 runs, eight doubles, three triples, five homers, and 18 RBI in 23 games. With a solo homer to lead off the game last night, Sellers is now just one dinger shy of tying his career-high for homers in a season of 14, set last year.

PUTTIN' ON A CLINIC!: A total of 137 kids braved the heat to attend the Isotopes' second and final Kids Clinic of the season. Isotopes players and coaches, Damaso Espino, Brad Coon, Jamie Hoffmann, Joe Becker, Justin Sellers, John Lindsey, David Pfeiffer, Joe Newby, Mike Parisi, Glenn Dishman, John Valentin, along with trainier Greg Harrel and strength coach Stephen Downey all took time out of their Saturday to take part.

**BIG HOMESTAND ROLLS ON:** The 'Topes continue their big eight-game homestand with a post-game fireworks shows after tonight's game. Tomorrow, the first 3,000 fans will get an Isotopes hat courtesy of Mattress Firm.

**TODAY'S START:** Francisco Felix makes his fifth start of the season coming off an excellent outing in his last start on August 1 at New Orleans when he allowed just one hit in five scoreless innings while walking two and striking out three. Left the game with a 2-0 lead but did not figure in the decision as the Zephyrs came back to win 4-2.

Loaned to Saltillo on June 28 and posted a 2.30 ERA ( $4\,\mathrm{ER}\,/\,15.2\,\mathrm{IP}$ ) in 10 games, all relief appearances. Returned to Albuquerque's roster on July 28.

Made three straight spot starts from April 24 to May 6, posting a 7.71 ERA (12 ER / 14.0 IP).

Earned victories in his first three decisions with the Isotopes, all relief appearances on April 13 vs. Iowa, May 17 at Tucson, and May 25 vs. Colorado Springs.

Pitched 4.0 innings in his first start of the season on April 24 vs. New Orleans, allowing three runs on five hits in a 10-9 Isotopes loss. Prior to moving to the rotation, he made three excellent appearances out of the bullpen in which he posted a 1-0 record with a 1.80 ERA (1 ER / 5.0 IP). Joined Albuquerque on April 11 from Extended Spring Training and earned a victory in his first appearance for the 'Topes in 2011, pitching 2.1 innings of relief on April 13 vs. Iowa, allowing a run on two hits while walking one and striking out two in a 10-7 Albuquerque win.

2010: Spent the majority of the season on loan to Saltillo of the Mexican League after making his first appearance at Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee... went 1-3 with a 6.28 ERA (43 ER / 61.2 IP) in 17 games (12 starts) for Saltillo... added to Albuquerque on August 28 and made two starts for the Isotopes, going 2-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP)... pitched through the sixth in both outings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Split the 2009 season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 4-2 with a 3.07 ERA (26 ER / 76.2 IP) in a total of 43 appearances... started the season at Chattanooga, going 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA and two saves in 29 games... was 2-2 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER / 18.2 IP) and a save in nine appearances in May... made a pair of starts for Lookouts, his first since 2007, and went 0-1 with a 4.05 ERA (3 ER / 6.2 IP)... went 3-1 with two saves and a 2.77 ERA (15 ER / 48.2 IP) while holding opponents to a .222 batting average in 27 relief appearances... transferred to Albuquerque on July 25... went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (8 ER / 21.1 IP) in 14 appearances... earned his only win for the Isotopes in the second game of a doubleheader after pitching a perfect seventh in a 2-1 Albuquerque win... his only save was of the two-inning variety on August 8 vs. Portland... pitched a 0.1 inning of scoreless relief in Game 3 of the Isotopes' playoff series vs. Memphis... pitched for Culiacan of the Mexican Winter League for the fourth straight season, going 2-1 with a 2.43 ERA (11 ER / 40.2 IP) in 32 appearances (one start).

Split 2008 season between Single-A Inland Empire and Triple-A Las Vegas, going a combined 5-4 with a 4.27 ERA and three saves in 40 total games... began season at Inland Empire, posting a 5-3 record with a 3.31 ERA and two saves... was 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA and two saves in 12 games at home, 1-2 with a 4.13 in 13 games on the road... ranked fifth among all California League relievers by holding batters to a .198 average... was 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA in seven games in June... yielded just two hits over 11 straight scoreless innings from June 6 to June 18... held left-handed hitters to a .145 average, while righties batted .238... transferred to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 8 and finished the season going 0-1 with a 5.81 ERA and a save in 15 appearances.
