## SALT LAKE BEES (52-63) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (59-56)

ALBUQUERQUE LEVELS RAINIERS, 20-7: The Albuquerque Isotopes put up a season-high 20 runs, including 11 in the third, tying a franchise record and helping the 'Topes obliterate the Tacoma Rainiers by the score of 20-7 on a sensational Saturday night at Isotopes Park. Tacoma got off to a quick start, scoring five runs in the top of the second, four on a grand slam by Johan Limonta, to grab a 5-0 edge, but the 'Topes began their own offensive onslaught in the bottom of the frame. With two on and nobody out, Hoffmann connected on a three-run homer to left, cutting the deficit to 5-3. Damaso Espino then followed with a walk, advanced to second on a wild pitch, and motored into third on a groundout for Justin Sellers, who hit a single to left-center, driving in Espino and trimming the lead to 5-4 after two innings. The Rainiers again added to the lead in the top of the third on a two-run homer by Carlos Peguero that made the score 7-4 before Albuquerque exploded in the bottom of the frame. With two on and nobody out, Jerry Sands roped a single to left-center plating Russ Mitchell and cutting the deficit to 7-5. Espino then cracked a single through the hole at shortstop, plating a pair to knot the game at 7-7. The Isotopes kept their foot on the accelerator, as Joe Becker added an RBI single before Brad Coon dropped down a perfect bunt single that loaded the bases with still no outs in the frame. After an RBI force-out by A.J. Ellis, Mitchell hammered a three-run shot to left-center that gave Albuquerque a 12-7 lead. Lindsey then singled in front of Sands, who hit a two-run blast to right, upping the advantage to 14-7. The very next batter Hoffmann then capped the inning with his second homer of the game, this one a solo blast, to send the 'Topes to a 15-7 lead. The offensive deluge continued one inning later, as Becker led off the fourth with a solo homer, extending the cushion to 16-7 Albuquerque. After backto-back walks, Ellis roped an RBI single, which set up Mitchell, who crushed his second three-run homer of the game, giving the Isotopes a 20-7 lead and sent the 'Topes cruising to a big win.

ATOMS AND EVELAND: Isotopes ace Dana Eveland makes the start looking to run his personal winning streak to five games while re-taking the outright lead in the PCL in victories again with a dozen. Currently, the left-hander is tied with Sacramento's Graham Godfrey and Omaha's Jeff Suppan with 11 wins, second-most in Triple-A baseball to Gwinnet's Julio Teheran's 12. Eveland has also won each of his last three starts at home, improving his record at Isotopes Park to an excellent 6-2 with a 3.65 ERA (28 ER / 69.0 IP). One of the many keys to Eveland success has been his ability to keep the ball in the yard. The left-hander has allowed just seven long balls in 133 innings-pitched and has not allowed a homer in his last 41.0 consecutive innings at Isotopes Park.

**BEES!:** Tonight, the 'Topes welcome the Salt Lake Bees, Triple-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels, to Isotopes Park for the first time since 2009. All-time, the 'Topes are 14-17 against Salt Lake, and are 6-9 against the Bees at home. The only time in team history the 'Topes have taken a series against Salt Lake was in 2004, when the Isotopes won three of four games in Salt Lake City.

**THAT LANGUAGE IS OFFENSIVE!:** Last night's offensive eruption propelled the 'Topes to a season-high 20 runs, marking just the second time in team history the Isotopes have reached the 20-run plateau. The only other time the 'Topes scored 20 times or more was back on July 30, 2009, when the team put up a club-record 23 in a 23-6 pasting of Oklahoma City. Last night Albuquerque also equaled team records for runs in an inning with 11 and hits in an inning with 10 after its big third.

**HOMER HAPPY:** Albuquerque's six home runs last night was a season-high and just one short of a team record set on May 10, 2005 vs. Portland and August 18, 2007 at Omaha. The Isotopes have now belted 148 dingers on the year, second in the PCL to Reno's 156. The 'Topes also have four players with double-digits in homers

(Sands- 20; Hoffmann- 16; Mitchell- 14; and Sellers- 13) with John Lindsey right on the cusp of joining them with nine.

**RUSS RAKES:** Russ Mitchell's two, three-run homers last night gave the infielder six RBI on the night, a career-high. In his last five games, Mitchell has been absolutely on fire, going 12-for-23 (.521) with nine runs, three doubles, a triple, three homers, and an incredible 12 RBI.

**BIG HOMESTAND ROLLS ON:** The 'Topes continue their big eight-game homestand tonight with Isotopes hats to the first 3,000 fans courtesy of Mattress Firm

**TODAY'S START:** Dana Eveland takes the mound coming off a no-decision on a sweltering day in New Orleans on August 2 when he pitched six innings, allowing three runs on eight hits while walking none and striking out two in a 6-4 'Topes win.

Tossed a three-hit shutout masterpiece at Omaha on July 23, allowing the Storm Chasers just three hits, all singles, through nine shutout innings while walking one and striking out six in a 2-0 'Topes win. The shutout was Eveland's first of his nine-year career, and his first complete game since May 21, 2008 when he was a member of the Oakland Athletics and held Tampa Bay to one run on three hits in nine innings. The left-hander becomes just the seventh pitcher in Isotopes history to toss a nine-inning shutout and just the sixth PCL hurler to do it this year. Named PCL Pitcher of the Week on August 1 as a result of his efforts.

Appeared in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 in Salt Lake City, UT where he pitched a one-two-three fourth inning in the PCL's 3-0 loss to the International League.

Selected to pitch in the Triple-A All-Star game at Salt Lake, becoming just the fourth pitcher in team history to receive the honor, the last being starter Charlie Haeger in 2009.

Posted quality starts in eight straight outings from May 13 to June 20, going 4-1 with a  $2.94~{\rm ERA}~(17~{\rm ER}~/~54.0~{\rm IP})$  in that span.

Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA ( $7 \, \text{ER} / 26.0 \, \text{IP}$ ) in that span.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
