ISOTOPES STUNG BY BEES, 11-8: The Albuquerque Isotopes gave up three runs in both the first and second innings and couldn't recover from the six-run deficit, falling 11-8 to the Salt Lake Bees Sunday evening at Isotopes Park. Salt Lake came out of the gate hot against 'Topes All-Star starter Dana Eveland, plating three tallies in the opening frame on a two-run single by Jeff Baisley and an RBI groundout by Efrén Navarro to grab a quick 3-0 edge. The Bees would then double the advantage in the second when Hank Conger crushed a three-run homer to centerfield that increased the visitor's lead to 6-0 after just two innings. The 'Topes started chipping away in the bottom of the third on an RBI single by Brad Coon, but the Bees answered with two of their own in the top of the fourth on a two-run single by Conger to take a commanding 8-1 lead. Albuquerque went to work in the bottom of the fourth, plating four runs and climbing right back into the contest. With two-out and a man on third, Jamie Hoffmann roped an RBI triple to center to make the score 8-2. After a four-pitch walk to A.J. Ellis, Tim Federowicz blasted a three-run homer to left to bring the Isotopes back within three at 8-5. Salt Lake added a pair of runs in the sixth on a bases-loaded walk to Conger and a bases-loaded hit-by-pitch to Baisley to boost the cushion to five runs at 10-5. Still, the Isotopes would not go quietly, with the bases loaded and one out in the sixth, Ivan De Jesus Jr., after an epic 11-pitch at-bat, dumped a single into shallow right-center, scoring one and cutting the lead to 10-6, Salt Lake. Jay Gibbons then belted a sacrifice fly to right that came a breath away from leaving the park for a grand slam, before the red-hot Russ Mitchell lined a single to center, scoring one more and cutting the lead to 10-8. Salt Lake would add one more insurance run in the seventh on a solo homer by Navarro that proved to be all the Bees would need as the visitors held the 'Topes scoreless over the last three innings to seal an 11-8 win.

ELY RETURNS: Right-hander John Ely makes his first start back with Albuquerque after a short stay in the Dodgers' bullpen. Ely was recalled on August 1 when young starter Rubby De La Rosa was put on the Disabled List and was placed in the bullpen, where he did not see any game action before being optioned on August 6 when rookie Nathan Eovaldi was called up to make the start against Arizona. Before his week with the Dodgers, Ely was fantastic for the 'Topes, going 4-0 with a 4.06 ERA (14 ER / 31.0 IP) in five starts in the month of July, including a stretch from July 3 to July 17 when he won three straight starts while posting a 1.89 ERA (4 ER / 19.0 IP).

LINK LOCKED IN: Isotopes closer Jon Link has been lights-out. The right-hander has not allowed a run over his last six appearances over six total innings, a span in which he's allowed just four hits and struck out six. Link has successfully converted each of his last 11 save opportunities, but the problem is, those opportunities have been few in far between. Since July 1, Link has been called on to save a win for Albuquerque just four times.

FED EX DELIVERS HOMERS: Newest catcher Tim Federowicz has racked up two hits to start his Triple-A career, and both have been home runs. Federowicz followed up a solo blast on August 5 with a three-run blast last night. The catcher has also followed up an 0-for-8 start with the 'Topes by going 2 for his last seven with three runs and four RBI in two games.

BATTER OF THE WEEK!: Congratulations to Russ Mitchell who today was named Pacific Coast League Batter of the Week after a torrid stretch that includes games beginning on August 1 through August 7. In that seven-game span, Mitchell has batted .467 (14x30) with nine runs, three doubles, a triple, three homers and an amazing 14 RBI. He's racked up multiple hits in each of his last three contests and in five of his last six, raising his batting average on the season from .264 when the month began to .288 entering play tonight. Surprisingly, as great as Albuquerque's offense has been this year, Mitchell is the first Isotope in 2011 to take the League's Batter of the Week accolade, while three 'Topes pitchers have received the PCL Pitcher of the Week award this season. Mitchell also won Batter of the Week on August 23-30 last year.

BIG HOMESTAND ROLLS ON: The 'Topes continue their big eight-game homestand tonight with the second of a four game set against the Salt Lake Bees.

TODAY'S START: John Ely makes his return to Albuquerque after a short stay with the Dodgers. The right-hander was recalled on August 1 and was inserted into the Los Angeles bullpen, but did not appear in any games. Optioned back to Albuquerque on August 7.

Won three straight starts from July 3 to July 17, posting a 1.89 ERA (4 ER / 19.0 IP) in that span.

Had a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking one and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game... selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
