BLOOD ON THE TRACKS, 'TOPES FALL TO EXPRESS 7-5: Three hits and two RBI from infielder Ivan De Jesus Jr. weren't enough as the Albuquerque Isotopes were edged 7-5 in a series-opening loss to the Round Rock Express Friday night at The Dell Diamond. Round Rock seized an early lead in the bottom of the first, scoring two on back-to-back RBI groundouts before the Isotopes answered with a pair in the top of the second. John Lindsey started the rally with a lead off solo home run to trim the deficit to 2-1 before Tim Federowicz followed with a walk and Kyle Russell singled, putting runners on corners with no outs. Damaso Espino then pounded a ground ball to short that allowed Federowicz to score and tie the game at 2-2. The Express responded with a run in the bottom of the third to take a 3-2 lead before taking control of the contest with three in the fourth inning. After an RBI groundout by Brad Nelson, Chad Tracy crushed a two-run homer to left that extended the home team's lead to 6-2. Round Rock would add one more insurance run in the fifth on an RBI single by Jose Ruiz to make the score 7-2. Albuquerque was down five, but not out, rallying for three runs in the top of the seventh. With runners on second and third and one out, De Jesus laced a single to center field, scoring both runners and bringing the Isotopes back to within 7-4. After a walk to Jerry Sands, Federowicz knocked a single to center, plating De Jesus and trimming the lead to just two runs at 7-5. Unfortunately for the Isotopes, that's as close as they'd get, as Round Rock relievers Cody Eppley and Tanner Scheppers each pitched around trouble in the eighth and ninth, respectively, to secure a 7-5 Express win.

FELIX FINISHING STRONG: Right-hander Francisco Felix makes his second straight spot-start coming off an excellent performance in his last outing at Memphis on August 29 when he held the Redbirds to one run on five hits in six innings while walking two and striking out six but ended up with a no-decision in a tough 3-1 Isotopes loss. In fact, in his last two starts on the road (August 29 and August 1 at New Orleans), Felix has yielded just one run on six hits in 11.0 innings of work. The right-hander also returns to Round Rock looking to avenge his last loss. On June 5, Felix made an emergency appearance in relief of an injured Alberto Bastardo and allowed seven runs on eight hits in three innings of an 8-2 Isotopes defeat.

THE LORE OF LINDSEY: Despite battling through a litany of injuries to his quads and hamstrings, John Lindsey continues to hit. Even though he's played in just 18 games since August 1, when he's been in there, he's been excellent, batting .310 (18x58) with 10 runs, five doubles, four homers, and 12 RBI. Of his 18 hits, half have gone for extra bases.

TWIN-KILLINGS: By hitting into a pair of double-plays last night, the Isotopes have now hit into 135 twin-killings on the season, the most in the Pacific Coast League, edging the Nashville Sounds, who have hit into 134 double-plays on the year.

HOMER HAPPY: Paced by a PCL-high 45 home runs in the month of August, the Isotopes have hit 180 long balls on the season, which now leads the league. Throughout the year, seven different 'Topes have reached double-digits in dingers and three eclipsed the 20-homer plateau (Jerry Sands-28; Trayvon Robinson-26; Jamie Hoffmann-22). Albuquerque's current home run total is its most since the Isotopes belted a team-record 197 homers in 2008.

SATURDAY NIGHT: Like the Bay City Rollers, the Isotopes are at their best on Saturday night. Albuquerque is 14-9 on Saturdays, its best record of any day of the week. Like most of those who are successful on Saturday night, however, Sundays can be a little rough. The 'Topes are 7-11 in games played on Sunday.

SEE YOU AT THE CHAMPIONSHIP: While the Isotopes home schedule is finished, it doesn't mean there won't be more baseball at Isotopes Park in 2011. On Tuesday, September 20, Isotopes Park will be the site of the Triple-A National Championship Game, pitting the playoff champion of the Pacific Coast League against the playoff champion of the International League. The game is merely the centerpiece of an entire day of fun, including a pre-game autograph session with Dodgers legends Steve Garvey, Ron Cey, and Bill Russell, a fleece blanket giveaway courtesy of Sandia Resort, and a post-game fireworks show!

In his six previous starts combined, went 0-0 with a 6.43 ERA (20 ER / 28.0 IP). In 19 total relief appearances, went 3-2 with a 5.50 ERA (23 ER / 37.2 IP).

Had an excellent outing in a spot start on August 1 at New Orleans when he allowed just one hit in five scoreless innings while walking two and striking out three. Left the game with a 2-0 lead but did not figure in the decision as the Zephyrs came back to win

Loaned to Saltillo on June 28 and posted a 2.30 ERA (4 ER / 15.2 IP) in 10 games, all relief appearances. Returned to Albuquerque's roster on July 28.

Made three straight spot starts from April 24 to May 6, posting a 7.71 ERA (12 ER /

Earned victories in his first three decisions with the Isotopes, all relief appearances on April 13 vs. Iowa, May 17 at Tucson, and May 25 vs. Colorado Springs.

Pitched 4.0 innings in his first start of the season on April 24 vs. New Orleans, allowing three runs on five hits in a 10-9 Isotopes loss. Prior to moving to the rotation, he made three excellent appearances out of the bullpen in which he posted a 1-0 record with a 1.80 ERA (1 ER / 5.0 IP). Joined Albuquerque on April 11 from Extended Spring Training and earned a victory in his first appearance for the 'Topes in 2011, pitching 2.1 innings of relief on April 13 vs. Iowa, allowing a run on two hits while walking one and striking out two in a 10-7 Albuquerque win.

2010: Spent the majority of the season on loan to Saltillo of the Mexican League after making his first appearance at Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee. went 1-3 with a 6.28 ERA (43 ER / 61.2 IP) in 17 games (12 starts) for Saltillo... added to Albuquerque on August 28 and made two starts for the Isotopes, going 2-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP)... pitched through the sixth in both outings

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Split the 2009 season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 4-2 with a 3.07 ERA (26 ER / 76.2 IP) in a total of 43 appearances... started the season at Chattanooga, going 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA and two saves in 29 games... was 2-2 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER / 18.2 IP) and a save in nine appearances in May... made a pair of starts for Lookouts, his first since 2007, and went 0-1 with a 4.05 ERA (3 ER / 6.2 IP)... went 3-1 with two saves and a 2.77 ERA (15 ER / 48.2 IP) while holding opponents to a .222 batting average in 27 relief appearances... transferred to Albuquerque on July 25... went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (8 ER / 21.1 IP) in 14 appearances... earned his only win for the Isotopes in the second game of a doubleheader after pitching a perfect seventh in a 2-1 Albuquerque win... his only save was of the two-inning variety on August 8 vs. Portland... pitched a 0.1 inning of scoreless relief in Game 3 of the Isotopes' playoff series vs. Memphis... pitched for Culiacan of the Mexican Winter League for the fourth straight season, going 2-1 with a 2.43 ERA (11 ER / 40.2 IP) in 32 appearances (one start).
