## ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (70-72) AT ROUND ROCK EXPRESS (85-57)

ROUND ROCK TOPPLES 'TOPES, 8-6: The Albuquerque Isotopes were unable to muster a comeback on Saturday night, as a four-run seventh inning lifted the Round Rock Express to an 8-6 win at The Dell Diamond. The Isotopes hit the scoreboard early in the top of the first inning. After Bryant Hernandez got plunked with a pitch by Round Rock starting pitcher Brett Tomko, Jay Gibbons walked to put runners on first and second base. Two batters later, Jamie Hoffmann laced a two-out RBI single to right, plating Hernandez to give Albuquerque a 1-0 lead. But the Express tied the game at 1-1 in the bottom of the second on a two-out solo homer from Jose Ruiz. Round Rock took a 3-1 lead in their half of the third, but the 'Topes responded in the fifth to square the contest at 3-3. Gibbons started the rally with a two-out double, which set-up Jerry Sands, who crushed a two-run homer that tied the game. However, the Express quickly re-took the advantage on an RBI groundout to surge ahead 4-3. Albuquerque wouldn't be down for long, though. John Lindsey led off the top of the sixth with a double and then moved to third on a one-out single from Damaso Espino. With runners on the corners, Ivan Ochoa then hit a sacrifice fly to left field that drove in Lindsey and tied the game at 4-4. De Jesus followed with a walk that pushed Espino to second base, which brought Hernandez to the batter's box. Hernandez then delivered the 'Topes a 6-4 lead with a two-run triple that plated Espino and De Jesus. Unfortunately for Albuquerque, the Express came up big in the bottom of the seventh. Luis Cruz and Kevin Cash each knocked in a run before Matt Kata capped the scoring with a two-run double to send Round Rock to an 8-6 win.

A PERFECT PARISI: Mike Parisi makes his last start of the 2011 season looking to end the season with a six-game winning streak. In his last outing on August 30 at Memphis, the right-hander allowed just three runs on four hits in six innings while walking three and striking out six in a 7-3 Isotopes win, Parisi's fifth in a row and sixth since joining the Isotopes on July 20 from the independent Long Island Ducks. Parisi closed out the month of August a perfect 5-0, tied for the most wins in the month in the PCL with three other pitchers, while posting a 4.23 ERA (18 ER / 38.1 IP) in six starts. While the right-hander has benefited from run support, the 'Topes have scored an average of 8.9 runs in games he's pitched, Parisi hasn't necessarily needed it. Five of his six starts over the course of his streak have been quality starts.

QUEST FOR .500: Albuquerque must win each of its last two games to avoid a finishing the season under .500 for the first time since

2008, when the Isotopes finished the season with a record of 68-75. In team history, the 'Topes have finished the season with a losing record just three times (2004, 2006, 2008).

**BOOMER SOONER:** Bryant Hernandez has made his first three games at the Triple-A level look like a breeze. In addition to picking up a base hit in his very first Triple-A at-bat, Hernandez, who was a standout at the University of Oklahoma, has racked up two hits in each of his last two games, starting his Triple-A career with five hits in his first nine at-bats (.556 average). Last night, Hernandez recorded his first Triple-A triple and drove in his first two runs.

**JERRY WORLD:** With 29 home runs on the season, Jerry Sands needs just one more dinger to become just the seventh player in team history to reach 30 dingers on the season. The last 'Tope to reach 30 home runs was Mitch Jones, who belted 35, the most in Minor League Baseball in 2009. Even more impressive is the fact that Sands spent nearly two months in the Major Leagues with the Dodgers.

SEE YOU AT THE CHAMPIONSHIP: While the Isotopes home schedule is finished, it doesn't mean there won't be more baseball at Isotopes Park in 2011. On Tuesday, September 20, Isotopes Park will be the site of the Triple-A National Championship Game, pitting the playoff champion of the Pacific Coast League against the playoff champion of the International League. The game is merely the centerpiece of an entire day of fun, including a pre-game autograph session with Dodgers legends Steve Garvey, Ron Cey, and Bill Russell, a fleece blanket giveaway courtesy of Sandia Resort, and a post-game fireworks show!

**TODAY'S START:** Mike Parisi looks to close out the 2011 season with his sixth straight win after earning his fifth victory in a row on August 30 in Memphis. In that outing, the right-hander allowed just three runs, all of them in the first inning, on four hits in six strong innings while walking three and striking out six in a 7-3 Isotopes win. His five wins in the month of August tied a PCL-high with three other pitchers.

Had his best outing of the season, a no-decision vs. Memphis, on August 20 when he pitched 6.2 innings, allowing just one run on five hits while walking three and striking out a season-high eight. Left the game with a 2-1 lead, but the Redbirds scored four in the ninth to take a 5-4 advantage before Ivan De Jesus won it with a two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth, sending Albuquerque to a 6-5 triumph.

Earned a win in his Isotopes debut on July 23 at Isotopes Park when he allowed the New Orleans Zephyrs five runs on five hits, three of them homers, in five innings while walking four and striking out one in an 11-10 Isotopes win.

Signed from the Long Island Ducks of the independent Atlantic League on July 20.

Went 6-4 with a 3.50 ERA (31 ER / 79.2 IP) in 13 games (all starts) with the Ducks, including a shutout, authored on June 15 at Lancaster when allowed just four hits over nine scoreless innings while walking two and striking out nine in a 6-0 Long Island win.

Selected to the Atlantic League All-Star team and pitched a perfect second inning in the Atlantic League All-Star Game on July 13 at York, PA.

Struck out a season-high 10 in seven innings in a 3-1 win vs. Southern Maryland on May 11, while allowing one run on four hits and two walks.

2010: Selected by the Cubs from St. Louis in the Major League portion of the Rule 5 Draft on December 10, 2009 and spent an injury-plagued season in the Cubs organization. Started the season at Triple-A Iowa, going 0-3 with a 8.50 ERA (17 ER / 18.0 IP) before being transferred to Double-A Tennessee, where he appeared in one game, allowing one run on three hits in 2.2 innings. Diagnosed with bone chips in his right shoulder and had season-ending surgery in May.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Limited to just five outings in 2009 while recovering from Tommy John surgery... went 0-2 with 4.70 ERA (8 ER / 15.1 IP) in stops between the Gulf Coast League Cardinals and the Single-A Palm Beach Cardinals... posted a 1.17 ERA (1 ER /7.2 IP) with a 0-1 record, nine strikeouts and a 0.83 average against (2x24) in three starts with the GCL Cardinals... joined Palm Beach on August 28, going 0-1 with an 8.22 ERA (7 ER / 7.2 IP) in two starts... played for the Surprise Rafters of the Arizona Fall League, going 3-2 with a 4.44 ERA (13 ER / 26.1 IP) with 15 strikeouts and a .257 average against.

Made his Major League debut in two stints with the St. Louis Cardinals in 2008... posted an 8.22~ERA~(21~ER~/23.0~IP) in 12 appearances (two starts) in two stints with the Cardinals... made his Major League debut on May 5 at Colorado, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings... went 8-2~with a 3.86~ERA~(36~ER~/84.0~IP) in 15 starts with Triple-A Memphis... had seasonending Tommy John surgery on August 20.

Spent the majority of the 2007 in Triple-A Memphis, setting career-highs in starts (28) and innings-pitched (165.0) in his first action at the Triple-A level... was 8-13 with a 4.91 ERA (90 ER / 165.0 IP) for the Redbirds... opened the season with a three-game winning streak, April 10-30, going 3-0 with a .10 ERA (9 ER / 19.1 IP) during that span (four games)... held the opposition to a .247 batting average (19x77) with runners in scoring position and two outs... had a 3.62 ERA (32 ER / 79.2 IP) in 13 starts at AutoZone Park... tossed 6.0 or more innings in 18 of his 28 starts, including eight straight from May 21 to June 27.

After being selected by the Cardinals in the ninth round of the 2004 draft, made his professional debut by going a combned 5-3 with a 3.88 ERA (31 ER / 72.0 IP) in 13 starts with Single-A New Jersey and Single-A Peoria.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Michael Richard Parisi... attended Manhattan College in New York and pitched for the Jaspers from 2002-2004... went to Sachem High School in Lake Ronkonkoma, New York... he and his fiancee Leah plan to get married this fall.
