NEW ORLEANS ZEPHYRS (38-34) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (40-32)

ISOTOPES' NINTH-INNING RALLY COMES UP SHORT IN 9-7 LOSS: The Albuquerque Isotopes mounted a two-out, five-run rally in the ninth, but it wasn't enough as the 'Topes fell 9-7 to the New Orleans Zephyrs on Tuesday night at Isotopes Park. The Z's immediately jumped on the board in the opening frame, scoring five quick runs, four of which came on a Chris Aguila grand slam to put the visitors ahead 5-0. The 'Topes showed signs of life in the third when Trent Oeltjen blasted a solo shot to right that narrowed the deficit 5-1. Albuquerque scored again in the fifth on a sac fly by Oeltjen, which brought the 'Topes within 5-2. The Z's then padded their lead through the final three frames, scoring once in the seventh off'a solo home run by Donnie Murphy and adding three more in the ninth to make it 9-2. Undaunted by the seven-run deficit, Albuquerque looked primed for a comeback in the bottom of the ninth. With two on and two out, Oeltjen slapped an RBI single to bring the 'Topes within 9-3. Alex Castellanos and Josh Fields kept the rally alive with consecutive RBI singles that cut the lead to 9-5. With runners on first and second, Jerry Sands then roped a two-run double to deep center that made the score 9-7. With the tying run at the plate, the Isotopes were unable to complete the comeback as Luis Cruz popped out to first base to give New Orleans a 9-7 victory.

A PERFECT 10: Right-hander Will Savage takes the mound looking for his 10th victory of the season after winning each of his last two starts. The season is only at the halfway point and already Savage is entering some rarified air with respect to wins. With his next victory, the right-hander will become just the seventh hurler in Isotopes history to reach double-digits in victories, and will be poised to shatter the team record for triumphs of 13 set in 2009 by Frankie De La Cruz and equaled in 2009 by Giancarlo Alvarado. Savage also continues to be superb at Isotopes Park, going 4-1 in seven games (four starts) at The Lab with a 4.50 ERA (14 ER /28.0 IP).

MIDWAY: With 72 games now in the books, the Isotopes have reached the midway point of the 2012 regular season, and for the third straight season, the 'Topes arrive at the halfway mark with a winning record, but then again, that's not unusual. In 10 seasons, the Isotopes have had a losing record halfway through the campaign just twice (2003: 34-38; 2008: 34-38) and have had a .500

record once (2009: 36-36). Strangely enough, the only two times the 'Topes have reached the post-season, they have not had a winning record through 72 games (2003, 2009).

DIALING LONG DISTANCE: Not only has Trent Oeltjen been swinging at hot bat of late, he's rediscovered his power stroke. After going 35 games to begin the season without a home run, Oeltjen has blasted five in his last 22 contests and three in his last seven games played. Oeltjen has also racked up a hit in each of his last four games, a stretch in which he's gone a blistering 8-for-17 (.471). Last night, he collected a season-high three hits in a game for the fourth time this year.

HOME STREAK: With last night's defeat, the Isotopes, who have played so well at home all season long, have lost an uncharacteristic three straight games at The Lab, tying a season high. In addition to last night's defeat, Albuquerque also dropped the last two games of its last homestand vs. Round Rock. The 'Topes also lost three in a row at home from May 23-25.

TODAY'S START: Will Savage makes the start looking to add to his team-high nine
wins after a victory on June 14 at Iowa when he allowed a season-high eight runs
on a season-high 11 hits, but ended up on the winning end of a 10-8 'Topes triumph.
Earned his seventh straight victory on May 13 at Salt Lake when he pitched 6.0 in-
nings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking two and striking
out two in a 10-7 'Topes win. The victory tied a team record for consecutive victories
equaling a markset by Sean Bergman in 2003 and tied by Daniel Barone in 2007 and
Hyang-Nam Choi in 2009. Beat Oklahoma City on May 3 after allowing four runs on
eight hits and three walks through 5.0 innings in a 15-5 'Topes win. Also helped his
cause at the plate, belting a two-run homer, his first professional home run. Before
moving to the rotation, made five appearances out of the bullpen in which he was
superb, racking up three wins while posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER / 12.2 IP). Entered the
game on April 18 vs. Iowa in the third inning after starter Fernando Nieve was ejected
and pitched a then-season-high 4.1 frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while
striking out two to earn his third victory of the season.

2011: Led the Double-A Southern League with 12 wins (12-6) and ranked among the league leaders in ERA (3.95, 8th), innings (141.1, 9th) and WHIP (1.25, 2nd) in 25 games (23 starts) with Chattanooga... tied for the most wins in the Dodger organization with Dana Eveland... selected to the Southern League All-Star game, going 7-2 with a 3.70 ERA (30 ER / 73.0 IP) in the season's first half... tossed the second complete game of his career on May 14 against Tennessee, allowing just one run on five hits over 9.0 innings, striking out five and walking only one in the Lookouts' 9-1 victory... his other complete game was a 7.0-inning shutout on May 22, 2010 at Lansing (Single-A Midwest League)... limited right-handed hitters to a .241 batting average... appeared in two games out of the bullpen in a long-relief role, allowing two runs in 9.0 innings (2.00 ERA) and limiting opposing hitters to a .229 batting average... picked up his only save of the season on Sept. 4 against Montgomery with 4.0 innings of two-run ball to close out Chattanooga's 10-5 win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for three Dodger affiliates in his first year in the organization in 2010, going a combined 10-5 with a 4.32 ERA (73 ER / 152.0 IP) in 25 starts with Single-A Great Lakes, Single-A Inland Empire, and Double-A Chattanooga... his 152.0 innings of work was the second-most of any pitcher in the Dodgers organization... went 3-0 with a 2.38 ERA (9 ER / 34.0 IP) in five May starts and was selected as Midwest League Pitcher of the Week from May 17-23 to win a Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes... tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout on May 22

Released by Philadelphia on April 4, 2009 and pitched for two independent teams Lancaster and Wichita, going a combined 6-7 with a 2.96 ERA (44 ER / 133.2 IP) in 21 games (20 starts)... posted a 2.94 ERA in 18 starts with Wichita, the fourth-best ERA in the American Association, while also ranking fifth in the league in both innings pitched (125.1) and starts... tossed a no-hitter on June 23 in a 1-0 win vs. Sioux City, in which he fanned seven, including four over the last two innings... the gem was just the second no-hitter since the history of the independent American Association... worked into the sixth inning in 17 of his 19 starts and allowed three or fewer earned runs in 15 of them.

Saw action in just six games for Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization in 2008 before going on the Disabled List with a right elbow injury... diagnosed with a slight tear in the ulnar collateral ligament but did not require surgery.

Played the entire 2007 season with Single-A Clearwater, going 4-3 with a 3.63 ERA (25 ER / 62.0) and three saves in a career-high 42 relief appearances... 14 of his appearances were 2.0 innings or longer... in nine appearances in June went 1-1 with a 0.60 ERA (1 ER / 15.0 IP) and two saves.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: William P. Savage...attended El Camino Real High School in the San Fernando Valley...played college ball at the University of Oklahoma... attended College of the Canyons JC (Valencia, CA) where he played baseball and football... in 2003, quarterbacked the COC football team to a championship and the program's first undefeated season, going 10-0.
