ISOTOPES SURRENDER FIVE SHOTS IN 8-4 LOSS: The Albuquerque Isotopes surrendered five home runs, the most the team has allowed all season, in an 8-4 loss to the Nashville Sounds Saturday night at Isotopes Park. The 'Topes initially jumped out to an early lead in the second inning when Matt Angle slapped a two-run single with the bases loaded to put Albuquerque up 2-0. The small advantage proved to be the home team's only lead of the game, as the Sounds responded in the third when starting pitcher Mark Rogers proved as capable at the plate as he was on the mound, blasting a two-run shot that knotted the score 2-2. Nashville would add another run in the fourth with an RBI single from Eric Farris, before stringing together a four-run sixth that put the game out of reach. Andy Gonzalez and Sean Halton led off the home run derby with back-to-back solo dingers that made the score 5-2. Two batters later, Farris poked a single to right that set the stage for Corey Patterson, who smashed a two-run shot to extend the lead 7-2. The Sounds padded their lead in the seventh with a final solo home run by Halton, his second of the game, that widened the gap 8-2. Albuquerque attempted a comeback in the bottom half of the frame when Trent Oeltjen smashed a two-run triple to left, cutting the lead to 8-4, but that's as close as the 'Topes would get in the series-opening loss.

NIEVE RIGHT AT HOME: Due to the always-quirky Pacific Coast League scheduling, right-hander Fernando Nieve tonight will make his fourth straight start at Isotopes Park. With all those starts at The Lab, it's a good thing Nieve has been solid at home this season. In eight previous games, seven starts, in the Duke City the right-hander is 3-3 with a 5.82 ERA (25 ER / 38.2 IP). Nieve finds himself with a .500 record thanks to back-to-back losses in each of his last two starts. After dropping a decision vs. Round Rock on June 13, the right-hander took the defeat in his last appearance on June 19 vs. New Orleans, allowing five runs on five hits and a season-high five walks in 5.0 innings of a 9-7 'Topes setback.

IT'S A WAY HOMER: Over the course of their current homestand, Isotopes pitchers have surrendered 12 home runs in five games, including a season-high five last night. On the season, the 'Topes have given up the same amount of homers as they've hit with 76. Albuquerque is tied for the fourth-most home runs allowed in the PCL and tied for fifth in most homers hit.

**THE BACKSTOP:** Of the 76 total games the Isotopes have played this year, Tim Federowicz has been behind the plate of 56 of them, the most games by a catcher this year in the PCL. That's no small feat considering the difficulty of the position, especially in the heat of the summer. Federowicz also leads the circuit with 58 assists and is third in the PCL throwing out 38% of would-be base stealers (18 CS / 47 ATT).

MATTY ICE: Matt Angle has racked up five hits in his last eight at-bats over two games, a three-hit night on Thursday night and a two-hit performance last night. Angle has eight multi-hit nights in his last 21 games.

TRIPLE TRENT: Trent Oeltjen continues to scorch the baseball, roping a two-run triple last night, his fourth three-bagger of the year and third this month. Oeltjen has collected a hit in 10 of his last 12 games, a span in which he's batted .362 (17x47) with 11 runs, a double, three triples, three homers, and 12 RBI. As if all that weren't enough, Oeltjen has also stolen five bases over that span, bringing his total on the season to a team-high 11.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: This season, the Isotopes are 6-5 in games played on Sunday and 3-2 in Sunday games at home.

**HECKUVA HOMESTAND:** Tonight the Isotopes continue their eight-game homestand with the Isotopes Park debut of that loveable rascal Rally, who will delight fans with uproarious skits. Tomorrow, all fans will be invited to run the bases after the game and on Tuesday, the homestand wraps up with a business person's special.

TODAY'S START: Fernando Nieve takes the mound looking to break a season-high two-game losing streak after suffering the loss on June 19 vs. New Orleans when he allowed five runs on five hits and five walks through 5.0 innings in a 9-7 'Topes loss. Had his best outing of the season on June 8 vs. Memphis when he authored 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out two in a 12-0 'Topes win. Had an excellent outing on May 27 vs. Oklahoma City when he was pressed into service on three days rest when Michael Antonini was scratched and pitched 5.0 solid innings, allowing a run on three hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven in an 11-9 win. Missed 15 days while on the Disabled List recovering from a hamstring strain. After 2.0 innings at New Orleans on April 26, Nieve came out to warm up for the third but could no further, leaving the game with a strained hamstring. The right-hander was placed on the DL the next day. Also had an outing on April 18 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park that was truncated by an ejection. With two outs in the top of the third, Nieve hit Anthony Rizzo with a pitch and was immediately ejected by home plate umpire Mike Jarboe, ending the right-hander's day after 2.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three. Albuquerque went on to win the game 6-4. Enjoyed a terrific outing in the 'Topes' home opener on April 13 when he held the Omaha Storm Chasers to four runs, three earned, on seven hits in six strong innings of a 7-4 'Topes win. His start Isotopes Park debut stood in stark contrast to his season debut at Omaha on April 8, when he lasted just 1.2 innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits while walking two and striking out two in a 17-11 'Topes

2011: Spent a majority of the season pitching for the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization... appeared in 25 games going 3-6 and a 6.09 ERA... finished the season tied for third on the team with six saves... also fanned 66 batters which ranked fourth amongst Bears pitchers... started the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Houston organization where he made three starts for the RedHawks, going 1-2 with a 7.63 ERA (13 ER / 15.1 IP)... granted his release on April 27.
