ALBUQUERQUE OUTLASTS MEMPHIS IN 10-8 SLUG-FEST: The Albuquerque Isotopes erupted for six runs in the seventh before fending off a late rally to seize a 10-8 win over the Memphis Redbirds Thursday night at AutoZone Park. Trailing 6-3 in the seventh, the 'Topes loaded the bases with no outs for Matt Angle, who bounced a single over the first base bag, scoring two and drawing Albuquerque within 6-5. After a Brian Cavazos-Galvez single loaded the bases for the second time with no outs, pinch-hitter Joe Becker kept the hit parade going, slapping an infield single to short that scored Tim Federowicz and tied the contest 6-6. With the bases still loaded and nobody out, Trent Oeltjen lined a single to shallow left, plating Angle and putting the visitors on top for the first time all night 7-6. Alex Castellanos then capped the six-run frame with a two-run single to left, extending the 'Topes' advantage to 9-6. Memphis would not retire quietly into the humid night, however, responding with two of its own in the bottom of the eighth to make the score 9-8, but Castellanos added some insurance with a solo home run in the ninth and closer Josh Wall pitched a perfect bottom of the frame to give Albuquerque a 10-8 win.

NIEVE NOTHING BUT SOLID: After back-to-back tough outings to begin the year sent his ERA to a stratospheric 14.09, right-hander Fernando Nieve has quietly and steadily lowered his earned run average to 6.63, a season-low, thanks to a string of solid starts. Since those two opening appearances, Nieve has posted a 4.92 ERA (31 ER / 56.2 IP) in 11 games (10 starts), and over five starts in the month of June, the righty has posted an ERA of 3.90 ERA (13 ER / 30.0 IP). In that span, he's also walked nine batters while striking out 19.

RUBBER MATCH: If the 'Topes can close out the Redbirds tonight, they will have won four straight series, their longest series winning streak of the season. With three wins in four games in Des Moines on their last road trip, the Isotopes also have an opportunity to win back-to-back road series for the first time all year. Albuquerque has won seven of its last nine games and since June 8 has gone a sterling 14-6. The 'Topes enter play today tied with Reno for the fourth-best record in the PCL behind Omaha (50-31), Sacramento (49-32), and Fresno (47-33).

CONSISTENT ROTATION: Part of the reason the Isotopes have been so successful is the fact their rotation has remained relatively stable, especially by Triple-A standards. Last night, Derrick Loop became the eighth different pitcher to start a game for the 'Topes this season, tied with Memphis for the second lowest in the PCL. Contrast that to last year, when 15 different pitchers started games for the 'Topes. Remarkably, the New Orleans Zephyrs have had just six starters all season, while Las Vegas has had the most rotation turnover with 15 different starting pitchers this year.

IRON MAN: If it seems like Josh Fields has played every day this year, it's because he pretty much has. The infielder has appeared in 78 of the Isotopes' 81 games this season, tied for second-most in the PCL behind Memphis' Pete Kozma, who's appeared in 81 contests for the 'Birds (or every game they've played). With two more hits last night, Fields also has cracked the Pacific Coast League's top 10 in batting average with a mark of .331.

WORKING FOR THE WEEKEND: Like most of us, the Isotopes are at their best on the weekends. Albuquerque has an 8-4 record on Friday nights this season and an overall mark of 22-14 in games played on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday

NEXT STOP- THE FOURTH: After a roadtrip through Memphis and Omaha, the Isotopes are back home on July 4 for a spectacular Independence Day celebration in which fans will be allowed to watch the annual fireworks show from the field. Adding to the festive atmosphere will be the classic rock cover band Stratus Phear, which will play live from 4:45-5:00 PM at Captain's Corner. On July 6, fan favorite Myron Noodleman will be on hand to make one of his never-tedious appearances!

TODAY'S START: Fernando Nieve makes the start coming off a solid no decision on June 24 when he allowed two runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings while walking none and striking out three in a 4-2 'Topes win. Had his best outing of the season on June 8 vs. Memphis when he authored 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out two in a 12-0 'Topes win. Had an excellent outing on May 27 vs. Oklahoma City when he was pressed into service on three days rest when Michael Antonini was scratched and pitched 5.0 solid innings, allowing a run on three hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven in an 11-9 win. Missed 15 days while on the Disabled List recovering from a hamstring strain. After 2.0 innings at New Orleans on April 26, Nieve came out to warm up for the third but could no further, leaving the game with a strained hamstring. The right-hander was placed on the DL the next day. Also had an outing on April 18 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park that was truncated by an ejection. With two outs in the top of the third, Nieve hit Anthony Rizzo with a pitch and was immediately ejected by home plate umpire Mike Jarboe, ending the right-hander's day after 2.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three. Albuquerque went on to win the game 6-4. Enjoyed a terrific outing in the 'Topes' home opener on April 13 when he held the Omaha Storm Chasers to four runs, three earned, on seven hits in six strong innings of a 7-4 'Topes win. His start Isotopes Park debut stood in stark contrast to his season debut at Omaha on April 8, when he lasted just 1.2 innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits while walking two and striking out two in a 17-11 'Topes loss.

2011: Spent a majority of the season pitching for the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization... appeared in 25 games going 3-6 and a 6.09 ERA... finished the season tied for third on the team with six saves... also fanned 66 batters which ranked fourth amongst Bears pitchers... started the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Houston organization where he made three starts for the RedHawks, going 1-2 with a $7.63\ ERA\ (13\ ER\ /\ 15.1\ IP)...$ granted his release on April 27.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the majority of the 2010 season with New York (NL)... was Designated for Assignment on July 23rd and optioned to Triple-A Buffalo on July 27... made 40 appearances for New York and had one start, May 29 at Milwaukee, an 8-6 loss... in 2.0 innings, he gave up three hits, five runs, all earned, with three walks and five strikeouts... became the first pitcher in Mets franchise history to appear in 19 of the team's first 30 games... picked up victories in relief vs. the Cubs on April 19 (1.1 scoreless innings with one hit) and vs. Detroit at Citi Field on June 22 (2.1 innings, no hits, no runs, with a walk and four strikeouts)... in seven June games, went 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA (3 ER / 8.2 IP and eight hits)... worked a career-best 10.2 consecutive scoreless innings in nine appearances from April 17-May 3, giving up five hits, with three walks and 10 strikeouts... struck out a season-high four in 2.1 innings vs. Detroit on June 22... went a season-best 3.0 innings vs. Cincinnati on July 5, permitting one run on three hits... made eight straight starts for Buffalo upon his return to the Bisons... scored back-to-back victories against Scranton Wilkes-Barre on August 11 and against Pawtucket on August 16... went at least 6.0 innings in four of his eight Triple-A starts.

In 2009 went to Spring Training with Houston... was claimed off waivers by New York (NL) on March 13 and assigned to Double-A Binghamton... promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on May 18 and had his contract purchased by the Mets on June 5... placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 20 with a muscle tear in his right thigh and did not pitch for the rest of the season... tore the muscle during his start on July 19 at Atlanta... finished the season with the best ERA of his career (2.95)... Major League batters went hitless against him with runners in scoring position and two out (0-for-10)... made his Mets debut on June 6 with 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen in a 7-1 loss at Washington, allowing one hit and striking out two... beat St. Louis with 6.0 shutout innings on June 24 at home to establish a career-best three game winning streak... became the first Mets pitcher to win his first three starts with the team since Jorge Sosa in 2007... also tied his career-best scoreless streak with the 6.0 shutout innings on June 24.
