'TOPES TUMBLE 8-7 TO STORM CHASERS: The Albuquerque Isotopes scored four runs in the fourth to tie the contest at 7-7, but it wasn't enough as the 'Topes ultimately fell 8-7 to the Omaha Storm Chasers on Saturday night at Werner Park. Trailing 7-3 in the fourth, Albuquerque mounted a comeback that began with three consecutive singles from Tim Federowicz, Matt Angle and Brian Cavazos-Galvez. With the bases loaded and no outs, Tyler Henson ripped an RBI single that plated Federowicz and brought the 'Topes within 7-4. Trent Oeltjen followed with a three-run double to right that completed the Isotopes rally and knotted the contest at 7-7. The game then took a turn for the worse in the fifth for the visiting 'Topes, as relief pitcher Bret Montgomery struck out Anthony Seratelli, but a passed ball by catcher Federowicz allowed the batter to reach first. Seratelli wasted no time moving into scoring position, stealing second and advancing to third on a deep fly-out to center. Cody Clark then lifted a one out sac-fly to score Seratelli and give the Storm Chasers an 8-7 edge. The one-run lead proved to be enough as Omaha's bullpen stifled all attempted comebacks from the Isotopes and closed out an 8-7 Storm Chasers win.

DAYTIME FIFE: Stephen Fife makes the start riding his second, three-game winning streak after getting the win in his last start on June 26 vs. Nashville when he allowed three runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings while walking two and striking out two in a 7-3 Isotopes win over the Sounds. That outing, like his start today, was played in the sunlight, which has become a common trend for Fife this year. The right-hander has started six day games this season, almost half of the total day games the 'Topes have played this season (15). The next closest Isotopes starter in terms of day games is Mike Parisi, who started four day games before landing on the DL on May 22. Fife is 2-1 with a 6.32 ERA (22 ER / 31.1 IP) in his six previous starts in the sunshine.

WORN OUT AT WERNER: Although it's just two years old, Werner Park is turning into a tough place for the Isotopes to play. Dating back to last year, Albuquerque is 4-9 at Werner Park and has dropped three in a row and five of its last six in Omaha. That's a far cry from how the Isotopes used to fare in Nebraska. In eight years playing at old Rosenblatt Stadium, the 'Topes were 37-27.

GET OUT YOUR BATS: When the 'Topes and Storm Chasers square off, it usually means a big day for offense. Through nine

games this year, the two teams have combined to average 15.6 runs a game (140 total tallies) and 24 hits (216). In every single contest the teams have played, at least one squad has reached double-digits in hits with both teams racking up double-digits four times.

HISTORIC JUNE: The Isotopes have closed the book on what was an historic month of June. With a record of 16-12, fourth best in the PCL, the 'Topes posted a winning record in the month for the first time ever, shattering the team's previous best June record of 14-14 set in the team's first season on 2003. That bodes well for July, which historically been a great month for the Isotopes. In nine previous seasons, Albuquerque has posted a losing record in July just three times (2006, 2008, 2011).

TERRIFIC TYLER: With a base knock last night, Tyler Henson has gotten a hit in five of his last six starts and since June 19 has raised his season average from .208 to .257. He's also displayed a knack for coming up with clutch hits. Four of his 10 RBI on the season have come with runners in scoring position and two outs

NEXT STOP- THE FOURTH: After a road trip to Omaha, the Isotopes are back home on July 4 for a spectacular Independence Day celebration in which fans will be allowed to watch the annual fireworks show from the field. Adding to the festive atmosphere will be the classic rock cover band Stratus Phear, which will play live from 4:45-5:00 PM at Captain's Corner. On July 6, fan favorite Myron Noodleman will be on hand to make one of his never-tedious appearances!

TODAY'S START: Stephen Fife makes the start coming off a third straight win on June 26 vs. Nashville when he allowed three runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings while walking two and striking out two in a 7-3 'Topes triumph. Tossed a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings on June 4 vs. Round Rock, allowing just four hits and a walk while fanning four in a 5-1 'Topes win. Also had a shutout performance on May 30 in New Orleans when he tossed 6.0 scoreless frames, allowing seven hits and a walk while striking out five in a 4-0 'Topes win. In two starts at New Orleans this year, did not allow a run in 12.0 innings. Had his best performance of the season on May 4 vs. Nashville when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings to extend his streak to 13.0 consecutive innings, fanning a season-high seven in an 8-1 'Topes win. Had a strong start on April 29 at New Orleans when he tossed 6.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out three in a 5-2 'Topes triumph. Tied a franchise record by walking eight batters in just 4.2 innings on April 22 at Oklahoma City while allowing five runs on seven hits in an eventual 11-10 'Topes win 14 innings. The eight walks ties knuckleballer Charlie Haeger, who walked eight Omaha Royals in 4.2 innings on June 15, 2010. Enjoyed his first career Triple-A win on April 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.2 innings in which he allowed six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 win. Also racked up two-hits, including a two-run double in the contest, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009.

2011: Started the season with Double-A Portland (ME) in the Boston organization before he was traded to the Dodgers at the July 31 trade deadline in a four player deal that also sent Tim Federowicz and minor leaguer Juan Rodriguez to L.A. in exchange for Trayvon Robinson... overall, went 14-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 25 combined games (24 starts) with Double-A Chattanooga and Double-A Portland... set new career-bests in wins, innings pitched (137.0) and strikeouts (95)... posted a 3-0 record with a 4.01 ERA (15 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts after joining Chattanooga... owned a 1-0 record with a 2.45 ERA in three road starts with the Lookouts... went 11-4 with a 3.66 ERA with the Sea Dogs before being traded to the Dodgers... at the time of the trade, his 11 wins were tops amongst all Red Sox farmhands... the 11 victories was tied for second-most in the Eastern League even though he played the last month in the Southern League... selected as a midseason Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Portland after tying for the league lead with 10 first half wins... named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week for the period of June 6-13... after taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his start on June 7 vs. Richmond... finished the game going 6.1 innings and allowing one hit while fanning seven... notched a career-high nine strikeouts in his July 5 start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER) at Binghamton... did not allow an earned run in five of 18 starts with Portland... earned the victory in his first start after he was traded to the Dodgers organization, allowing just one run on two hits on August 5 at Jacksonville... following the season, pitched for the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2010, his first season with Double-A Portland, he paced the club in wins (8), starts (26), and innings (136.1) while finishing third on the team with 82 strikeouts... named to the Eastern League's midseason All-Star Team after going 5-2 with a 3.83 ERA before the break... selected as the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for August 30-Sept. 6 after going 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) and seven strikeouts in two starts... limited left-handed opposition to a .248 batting average... went 3-1 with a 3.05 ERA (22 ER/65.0 IP) in 12 road starts.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Stephen J. Fife... played two seasons (2007-08) of college baseball at University of Utah and one at Everett Community College in Washington (2006)... went 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts for the University of Utah as a junior in 2008, leading the team in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts... played in the 1999 Little League World Series.
