NIEVE ALLOWS NYET IN 7-0 ISOTOPES WIN: Starting pitcher Fernando Nieve authored 6.0 scoreless frames to lead the Albuquerque Isotopes to a 7-0 win over the Nashville Sounds Friday night at Greer Stadium. Nieve was in complete control throughout the contest, allowing just four hits and two walks while fanning six to earn wins in back-to-back starts for the first time this season. Only two Sounds hitters reached second the entire night and Isotopes pitchers yielded just seven total Nashville base runners. With its starter dominating, Albuquerque wasted no time giving him some run support, scoring a pair of runs in the top of the second on a two-run homer from Brian Cavazos-Galvez that put the 'Topes on top 2-0. Matt Angle helped increase the advantage in the fifth with a solo blast to right to extend Albuquerque's lead to 3-0. The Isotopes put the game away in the fifth, erupting for four runs, every one of them coming with two outs. With a runner on second and two down, Josh Fields roped an RBI single up the middle to put Albuquerque ahead 4-0. Jerry Sands then walked and Tim Federowicz reached on an infield hit, loading the bases. A wild pitch from Sounds pitcher Seth McClung plated Fields and increased the lead to 5-0 while setting up Angle, who smashed a single to right, scoring Sands and Federowicz to give the Isotopes a 7-0 cushion. Seven runs was plenty for the 'Topes relief corps, as Michael Antonini, Cole St. Clair, and Angel Guzman each delivered a scoreless inning apiece to seal the 7-0 Isotopes win.

SAVAGE AND JOHNSON ON THE HILL: Starting for the Isotopes in tonight's twin-bill is a pair of right-handers, one looking for his 11th win and the other looking for his first. In the first game Will Savage looks to break a stretch of two no-decisions and earn his PCL-leading 11th win of the season. Savage's last victory came against these very Sounds on June 25 at Isotopes Park when the right-hander pitched 6.0 strong innings, allowing four runs on eight hits while walking one and striking out three in an 11-9 'Topes triumph. In the night-cap, right-hander Blake Johnson makes his first start of the season after 11 appearances out of the bullpen in which he posted a 0-0 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER / 12.2 IP). This will be Johnson's first start since May 10 of last season when he was a member of the Omaha Storm Chasers, working 3.0 innings in a 5-1 loss at Reno. Johnson's longest outing of the season came in a 4.0 inning appearance with Chattanooga vs. Birmingham when he earned a save, while his longest appearance as an Isotope was a 2.2 inning outing vs. Round Rock on June 12.

LET'S PLAY TWO!: Tonight will be the Isotopes' sixth doubleheader played in Nashville in team history, with the last one coming exactly one year ago on July 14, 2011 when the 'Topes came out of the All-Star Break with a twin-bill at Greer Stadium and ended up losing both games. All time, Albuquerque has swept one doubleheader in the Music City, been swept twice, and split twice. In their history, the Isotopes have played more doubleheaders in Nashville than in any other PCL city.

HIGH WATER: It's somehow fitting that in water-logged Nashville the Isotopes should reach their high-water mark. The 'Topes are 14 games over .500 for the first time this season after winning six of their last seven. Albuquerque has also beaten the Sounds four straight times, one shy of the team's longest winning streak against Nashville of five, set twice before (the last coming on June 10-July 8, 2011). The Isotopes haven't been this far clear of .500 since they were 16 games over on September 7, 2009.

HOMER HAPPY BCG: For the first time in his Triple-A career, Brian Cavazos-Galvez has homered in back-to-back games, belting a big fly in Albuquerque's last game before the All-Star Break on July 8 and its first game out of the break last night, a span of four days. In his last two contests, Cavazos-Galvez is 4-for-8 with two homers and five RBI.

HUGE HOMESTAND ON DECK!: After three games in two days this weekend in Nashville, the 'Topes are back home Monday for a mammoth eightgame homestand that includes a replica jersey night, fireworks, and Dukes Retro Nieht!

TODAY'S START: Will Savage takes the mound in the first game coming off a no-decision in his last outing on July 5 vs. Round Rock when he pitched 5.2 innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits and two walks while striking out a season-high five in an eventual 10-8 Isotopes walk-off win. Earned his seventh straight victory on May 13 at Salt Lake when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking two and striking out two in a 10-7 'Topes win. The victory tied a team record for consecutive victories equaling a markset by Sean Bergman in 2003 and tied by Daniel Barone in 2007 and Hyang-Nam Choi in 2009. Beat Oklahoma City on May 3 after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks through 5.0 innings in a 15-5 'Topes win. Also helped his cause at the plate, belting a two-run homer, his first professional home run. Before moving to the rotation, made five appearances out of the bullpen in which he was superb, racking up three wins while posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER / 12.2 IP). Entered the game on April 18 vs. Iowa in the third inning after starter Fernando Nieve was ejected and pitched a then-season-high 4.1 frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while striking out two to earn his third victory of the season.

2011: Led the Double-A Southern League with 12 wins (12-6) and ranked among the league leaders in ERA (3.95, 8th), innings (141.1, 9th) and WHIP (1.25, 2nd) in 25 games (23 starts) with Chattanooga... tied for the most wins in the Dodger organization with Dana Eveland... selected to the Southern League All-Star game, going 7-2 with a 3.70 ERA (30 ER / 73.0 IP) in the season's first half... tossed the second complete game of his career on May 14 against Tennessee, allowing just one run on five hits over 9.0 innings, striking out five and walking only one in the Lookouts' 9-1 victory... his other complete game was a 7.0-inning shutout on May 22, 2010 at Lansing (Single-A Midwest League)... limited right-handed hitters to a .241 batting average... appeared in two games out of the bullpen in a long-relief role, allowing two runs in 9.0 innings (2.00 ERA) and limiting opposing hitters to a .229 batting average... picked up his only save of the season on Sept. 4 against Montgomery with 4.0 innings of two-run ball to close out Chattanooga's 10-5 win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for three Dodger affiliates in his first year in the organization in 2010, going a combined 10-5 with a 4.32 ERA (73 ER / 152.0 IP) in 25 starts with Single-A Great Lakes, Single-A Inland Empire, and Double-A Chattanooga... his 152.0 innings of work was the second-most of any pitcher in the Dodgers organization... went 3-0 with a 2.38 ERA (9 ER / 34.0 IP) in five May starts and was selected as Midwest League Pitcher of the Week from May 17-23 to win a Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes... tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout on May 22 at Lansing.

Released by Philadelphia on April 4, 2009 and pitched for two independent teams Lancaster and Wichita, going a combined 6-7 with a 2.96 ERA (44 ER / 133.2 IP) in 21 games (20 starts)... posted a 2.94 ERA in 18 starts with Wichita, the fourth-best ERA in the American Association, while also ranking fifth in the league in both innings pitched (125.1) and starts... tossed a no-hitter on June 23 in a 1-0 win vs. Sioux City, in which he fanned seven, including four over the last two innings... the gem was just the second no-hitter since the history of the independent American Association... worked into the sixth inning in 17 of his 19 starts and allowed three or fewer earned runs in 15 of them.

Saw action in just six games for Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization in 2008 before going on the Disabled List with a right elbow injury... diagnosed with a slight tear in the ulnar collateral ligament but did not require surgery.

Played the entire 2007 season with Single-A Clearwater, going 4-3 with a 3.63 ERA (25 ER / 62.0) and three saves in a career-high 42 relief appearances... 14 of his appearances were 2.0 innings or longer... in nine appearances in June went 1-1 with a 0.60 ERA (1 ER / 15.0 IP) and two saves.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: William P. Savage...attended El Camino Real High School in the San Fernando Valley...played college ball at the University of Oklahoma... attended College of the Canyons JC (Valencia, CA) where he played baseball and football... in 2003, quarterbacked the COC football team to a championship and the program's first undefeated season, going 10-0.

TODAY'S START: Blake Johnson takes the mound for his first start since May 10, 2011 when he piched for the Omaha Storm Chasers. The right-hander is coming off back-to-back scoreless appearances, in which he tossed 2.0 frames without surrendering any hits while fanning two. Has not allowed a ball to leave the yard in his previous five games (5.1 IP) from June 26-July 8. Collected five of his last 10 outs by way of a strikeout. Limiting leadoff batters to a .125 average with only one hit and no runs in eight at-bats. Had longest outing of season on June 12 against Round Rock, tossing 2.2 frames to allow just one run on three hits. Especially effective on road, posting 2.70 ERA through three games with three hits and one run.

2011: Appeared in 43 combined games (one start), earning a 6-2 record with a 5.59 ERA in the Royals and Rockies organizations, transitioning to the bullpen full-time after making 131 starts in his previous six professional seasons... Gave up only six homers through 77.1 innings of combined work... totaled a 2-1 record with 7.62 ERA through 20 games (26.0 IP) with Colorado Springs... allowed two runs or less in 17 of 20 appearances with Sky Sox... posted a 3-1 record with one save in 30.1 frames with Omaha... made three consecutive appearances (8 IP) without allowing a run from May 24-31 for Storm Chasers... limited left-handed hitters to only five extra-base hits in 52 at-bats with Omaha... opened the season with Double-A Northwest Arkansas, picking up three saves and posting a 0.43 ERA (1 ER/21.0 IP)

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began the 2010 season with Northwest Arkansas, going 5-3 in 80.1 innings pitched over 23 games (10 starts)...also appeared in six games (one start) for Triple-A Omaha, allowing 1 ER or less in four of his six outings... tossed 51.1 innings with a 4-2 record and 2.63 ERA in second half of the season... pitched effectively against left-handed bats, limiting them to a .274 average with no triples or home runs, and 26 strikeouts to just eight walks... posted a 2-1 record with one save and 1.29 ERA (28.0 IP) in August, holding opposing sticks to .253 average.

Won eight games in 24 starts with Northwest Arkansas in 2009, ranking second on the team... his 4.57 ERA was second lowest among team pitchers with at least 81 innings of work, and his 122.0 frames ranked third among all Naturals... finished the season with 61 punch outs, third most on the team... tossed a one-hitter shutout through 6.0 innings in a win vs. Springfield on April 23... won three straight decisions from June 13-July 12... fanned a season-high seven through 6.1 innings on July 28 at Tulsa.

Spent entire 2008 season with Northwest Arkansas... tied for the team lead, and tied third in Texas League with 10 wins in 26 games (25 starts)... named to Texas League mid-season All-Star team... walked just 38 batters to 86 strikeouts in 143.0 innings of work... ranked third on the Naturals in innings pitched... hurled six innings or more in four consecutive starts from May 4-19, a span in which we went a perfect 3-0... had two spans where he won four straight decisions from May 4-25 and June 29-Aug-1.

In 2007, helped Single-A Wilimngton reach the playoffs, going 9-6 with 3.28 ERA in 26 games (22 starts) and allowing just 119 hits and 33 walks in 131.2 innings of work (1.15 WHIP)... finished ranked third on team in both wins and innings pitched... tossed 10.1 innings in relief with a .087 ERA out of the pen and one save... surrendered only seven long balls in 536 batters faced, good for just one homer every 77 batters... dominant at home with 8-3 record and 2.52 ERA... collected 64 percent of his season's punch outs (51 Ks) against righties while holding right-handers to .230 average... allowed only seven hits in 50 at-bats (.140) with runners in scoring position and two outs... undefeated in second-half games, winning final six decisions from June 21-Sept 1, a span in which he posted 1.28 ERA and allowed no earned runs in five of the six wins
