ISOTOPES AND REDBIRDS POSTPONED: Due to a storm front that brought with it heavy rains and terrifying lightening, Wednesday's game between the Albuquerque Isotopes and Memphis Redbirds was postponed and will be made up as part of a doubleheader on Thursday beginning at 4:35 PM. Right around the time the Isotopes were getting ready to take batting practice, the rains moved in and persisted well after the game's original 7:05 PM start time. After about a half hour delay, the decision was made to call the game and play two on Thursday

TWO STREAKING STARTERS: Lefty Derrick Loop makes the game one start riding a three-game winning streak, tied for his longest such streak of the season. His most recent win came in his last start on July 8 vs. Round Rock when he allowed three runs, two earned, on six hits in 5.0 innings in a 12-10 win over the Express, easily Loop's best start to date. With the All-Star Break and rain in Nashville that kept pushing his scheduled start back, Loop got some work in as a reliever in the first game of a doubleheader in the Music City on July 15, tossing a scoreless inning. Game two also features a starter on a winning streak as right-hander Fernando Nieve has won back-to-back starts for the first time all season thanks to a masterful performance in his last start on July 13 in Nashville, when he tossed 6.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out six in a 7-0 Isotopes triumph.

WATER-LOGGED: Rain is starting to be something the Isotopes are becoming all too familiar with. Last night's postponement marked the third time in seven days the Isotopes have had games washed out and today will be Albuquerque's second doubleheader in four days. The 'Topes had two games wiped out by rain in their last trip to Nashville and played a doubleheader on Sunday before returning home.

NEXT STOP, HISTORY BOOKS: With his third inning base knock last night, Elian Herrera extended his current Triple-A hitting streak to 19 straight games, tying a franchise record set in 2006 by Eric Reed and equaled in 2010 by Jamie Hoffmann. Since his streak began way back on April 23, Herrera has batted .349 (29x83) with 13 runs, six doubles, a triple, a homer, and nine RBI. A knock in his next game would not only give him sole possession of the longest hitting streak in Isotopes team history, it would move him into a tie for

the sixth longest hitting streak in Albuquerque Triple-A history with Joe Simpson (1978), Ross Jones (1983), and Tracy Woodson (1988). Only five players in the PCL this year have collected hitting streaks of 20 games or more, with Reno's Jake Elmore leading the way with a 31-game streak. The longest hitting streak in Albuquerque Dukes history is also 31, set by Pedro Guerrero in 1979.

JUST JOSH'N: Infielder Josh Fields also has a substantial hitting streak going, collecting a hit in each of his last 13 contests, a stretch in which he's been absolutely torrid. Since his streak began on July 1, Fields is batting .482 (27x56) with 11 runs, six doubles, and 15 RBI. His average in the month of July is the best in the Pacific Coast League and he has driven in a run in seven of his last eight games, racking up 11 RBI in that span. Not to be overlooked, Alex Castellanos has also collected a hit in a season-high 12 straight contests.

A THREET IN THE BULLPEN: The Isotopes relief corps has been bolstered by the arrival of a familiar face in lefty Erick Threets, who signed a contract with the Dodgers yesterday after being granted his release by the A's on July 14. Threets had been dominant for Triple-A Sacramento, going 4-2 with a 1.84 ERA (9 ER / 44.0 IP) and three saves in 34 games before his release. The left-hander has been dominant for the 'Topes as well. In 2009, he went 3-0 with a 1.52 ERA (10 ER / 41.1 IP) in 33 games before being sidelined with left elbow inflammation. Threets missed all of last year recovering from Tommy John surgery.

HUGE HOMESTAND IS HERE!!: The 'Topes continue their mammoth eightgame homestand against Memphis before welcoming the Iowa Cubs to town. Tomorrow, the Isotopes will give away replica jerseys before a sensational Saturday that includes Dukes Retro Night, the ABQ Baseball Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony, and fireworks!

TODAY'S START: Derrick Loop makes his fourth start of the season coming off his third straight win on July 8 vs. Round Rock when he worked 5.0 innings, allowing three runs, two earned, on six hits while walking two and striking out three in a 12-10 'Topes win. Also worked one scoreless inning of relief in the first game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 15. Made his first start of the season on June 28 at Memphis, his first since August 27, 2011, going 3.0 innings, giving up four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while fanning two in a 10-8 'Topes win. Before moving to the rotation, made 20 appearances out of the bullpen, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP). Transferred to Albuquerque from Extended Spring on April 8 and made his Isotopes debut that night at Omaha, pitching 3.0 innings in which he allowed one unearned run. The outing marked just his second-career Triple-A appearance (he made one appearance for Lehigh Valley in 2010). Transferred to Ogden roster on April 11 but returned to Albuquerque for good on April 23. Pitched a then-season-high 4.0 innings in a win vs. Oklahoma City on May 28, the third in a string of three straight victorious decisions, also a season-high.

2011: Spent season between Single-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization... went 2-1 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER / 32.0 IP) and three saves in 24 appearances for Clearwater. left-handed hitters batted just .100 (4x40) against him, while righties batted .261 (18x69)... started the season by not allowing a run in his first 10 consecutive outings, a span of 12.1 conecutive scoreless innings... transferred to Reading on June 16 and finished the year there, going 1-3 with a $5.29\,(20\,\mathrm{ER}\,/\,34.0\,\mathrm{IP})$ in 19 games (two starts)... held left-handed hitters to a 0.81 average (7x86)... made two starts to end the season (on August 17 and August 27), both in the second game of doubleheaders, and took the loss in both, going a combined 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER / 8.0 IP)... his start on August 17 was his first since April 16, 2009, when he made the start for Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Started the 2010 season with Camden in the Independent Atlantic League, going 0-1 with a 1.72 (6 ER / 31.1 IP) in 33 games... walked just 17 batters while striking out 40... signed with the Phillies on July 14 and began season with Single-A Clearwater... was on DL, from August 15-22... did not allow an earned run in 14 of his 15 relief appearances with Clearwater before being promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5 for his Triple-A debut... averaged 10.29 SO / 9.0 IP between both levels... held opponents to a combined .165 avg (15x91)... played for Aguilas in Dominican Winter League (16 G, 1-1, 2.79 ERA).

Spent majority of 2009 season with Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization, going 3-3 with a 1.61 ERA (12 ER / 67.0 IP) in 47 games (one start)... finished second in Boston system and third in Carolina League in saves with 18... ranked second in CL in ERA (1.61) and fouth in SO/IP (10.71)... selected as midseason Carolina League All-Star... had a 17.1-inning scoreless streak (nine games), April 12 to May 4, and a 21.2-inning scoreless streak (16 games), June 1 to July 27... did not allow an earned run in 40 of 47 appearances with Salem... promoted to Double-A Portland on August 24 and made four appearances for the Sea Dogs, going 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA (3 ER 4.1 IP).

In 2008, began season with Chico Outlaws of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER / 29.1 IP) in six games (five starts)... had contract purchased by Boston and was assigned to Single-A Lancaster on June 25... set a Lancaster franchise record with 5 wins in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (6 ER / 33.0 IP) for the month... ended up 6-0 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER / 53.1 IP) in 17 games (five starts) for Lancaster.

TODAY'S START: Fernando Nieve makes the start in the second game of the doubleheader riding his best stretch of the season. In his last outing on July 13 in Nashville, Nieve pitched 6.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out six in a 7-0 'Topes win. The victory was his second in as many starts. Had his best outing of the season on June 8 vs. Memphis when he authored 7.0 shutout innings. allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out two in a 12-0 'Topes win. Had an excellent outing on May 27 vs. Oklahoma City when he was pressed into service on three days rest when Michael Antonini was scratched and pitched 5.0 solid innings, allowing a run on three hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven in an 11-9 win. Missed 15 days while on the Disabled List recovering from a hamstring strain. After 2.0 innings at New Orleans on April 26, Nieve came out to warm up for the third but could no further, leaving the game with a strained hamstring. The righthander was placed on the DL the next day. Also had an outing on April 18 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park that was truncated by an ejection. With two outs in the top of the third, Nieve hit Anthony Rizzo with a pitch and was immediately ejected by home plate umpire Mike Jarboe, ending the right-hander's day after 2.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three. Albuquerque went on to win the game 6-4. Enjoyed a terrific outing in the 'Topes' home opener on April 13 when he held the Omaha Storm Chasers to four runs, three earned, on seven hits in six strong innings of a 7-4 'Topes win. His start Isotopes Park debut stood in stark contrast to his season debut at Omaha on April 8, when he lasted just 1.2 innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits while walking two and striking out two in a 17-11 'Topes loss.

2011: Spent a majority of the season pitching for the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization... appeared in 25 games going 3-6 and a 6.09 ERA... finished the season tied for third on the team with six saves... also fanned 66 batters which ranked fourth amongst Bears pitchers... started the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Houston organization where he made three starts for the RedHawks, going 1-2 with a 7.63 ERA (13 ER / 15.1 IP)... granted his release on April 27.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the majority of the 2010 season with New York (NL)... was Designated for Assignment on July 23rd and optioned to Triple-A Buffalo on July 27... made 40 appearances for New York and had one start, May 29 at Milwaukee, an 8-6 loss... in 2.0 innings, he gave up three hits, five runs, all earned, with three walks and five strikeouts... became the first pitcher in Mets franchise history to appear in 19 of the team's first 30 games... picked up victories in relief vs. the Cubs on April 19 (1.1 scoreless innings with one hit) and vs. Detroit at Citi Field on June 22 (2.1 innings, no hits, no runs, with a walk and four strikeouts)... in seven June games, went 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA (3 ER / 8.2 IP and eight hits)... worked a career-best 10.2 consecutive scoreless innings in nine appearances from April 17-May 3, giving up five hits, with three walks and 10 strikeouts... struck out a season-high four in 2.1 innings vs. Detroit on June 22... went a season-best 3.0 innings vs. Cincinnati on July 5, permitting one run on three hits... made eight straight starts for Buffalo upon his return to the Bisons... scored back-to-back victories against Scranton Wilkes-Barre on August 11 and against Pawtucket on August 16... went at least 6.0 innings in four of his eight

In 2009 went to Spring Training with Houston... was claimed off waivers by New York (NL) on March 13 and assigned to Double-A Binghamton... promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on May 18 and had his contract purchased by the Mets on June 5... placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 20 with a muscle tear in his right thigh and did not pitch for the rest of the season... tore the muscle during his start on July 19 at Atlanta... finished the season with the best ERA of his career (2.95)... Major League batters went hitless against him with runners in scoring position and two out (0-for-10)... made his Mets debut on June 6 with 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen in a 7-1 loss at Washington, allowing one hit and striking out two... beat St. Louis with 6.0 shutout innings on June 24 at home to establish a career-best three game winning streak... became the first Mets pitcher to win his first three starts with the team since Jorge Sosa in 2007... also tied his career-best scoreless streak with the 6.0 shutout innings on June 24.
