'TOPES SPLIT DOUBLEHEADER, SERIES WITH MEMPHIS: The Albuquerque Isotopes drew a doubleheader split against the Memphis Redbirds, taking a 4-3 win in the first game and dropping a 3-2 loss in the second contest on Thursday night at Isotopes Park. In the first game of the twin-bill, the 'Topes snagged a quick 3-0 lead in the opening frame with a leadoff, solo shot from Matt Angle that made it 1-0. With runners on first and second, Tim Federowicz and Brian Cavazos-Galvez slapped back-to-back RBI singles, putting the 'Topes on top 3-0. The 'Topes added what proved to be a vital insurance run in the sixth when Jerry Sands doubled to left, took third on a deep flyout to center and scored on an RBI single from Ozzie Martinez to give Albuquerque a 4-1 edge. The small lead was just enough for reliever Scott Rice, who yielded a bases-loaded, two-run double to Matt Chambers. As Matt Adams rumbled home with the tying run, Cavazos-Galvez delivered a perfect throw to Martinez, who in turn gunned down the runner at the plate from short to preserve the 4-3 win. In the second game of the evening, the 'Topes and 'Birds entered the seventh inning knotted at 1-1. Albuquerque reliever Michael Antonini took over in the top half of the frame and quickly coaxed back-to-back flyouts to reduce Memphis to its final out of the game. The 'Topes southpaw then gave up a walk to Eugenio Valez that set the stage for Adron Chambers, who blasted a monstrous two-out, two-run shot to left that gave Memphis a 3-1 lead. Albuquerque showed signs of a comeback in the bottom half of the inning when Matt Angle drew a one-out walk and dashed to second on a groundout from Josh Bard. Pinch hitter Alex Castellanos then drew a walk of his own to put two runners on for Trent Oeltjen, who ripped a two-out RBI single up the middle to bring the 'Topes within 3-2. That's where the rally would be extinguished, however, as Memphis held on for a 3-2 win.

A STARTER STUCK ON TEN: Will Savage makes the start looking to get over the hump and win that elusive 11th game that he's been stalking for almost a month. The right-hander has no-decisions in each of his last three starts, with his last victory coming at home against Nashville on June 25. Even with the drought, Savage is still tied atop the PCL leader-board in victories with Fresno's Eric Hacker and Reno's Joe Martinez. To get some work in, the right-hander made one relief appearance with two out in the ninth inning of the Isotopes' 11-4 loss to the Redbirds on Tuesday and coaxed an inning-ending groundout with his first pitch. The appearance out the bullpen, however brief, marked Savage's first relief outing since April 18 before he was converted to a full-time starter.

CUBBY BARE: Tonight the Isotopes start a four-game series against the Iowa Cubs, the victim of Albuquerque's only series sweep this

season. The last time the I-Cubs came to the Duke City, the 'Topes took four straight, beginning a stretch of seven consecutive victories against the Cubs. Dating back to last year, Albuquerque has won 10 of its last 12 games against Iowa at Isotopes Park. Nobody's more excited to see Iowa in town than Alex Castellanos, who is batting .439 (19x41) against Cubs pitching with 15 runs, eight doubles, two triples, and nine RBI in 11 games. He's also belted three homers against Iowa, exactly a third of his total on the year (9) and more than against any other club.

NEW STREAK BEGINS NOW: With last night's 0-for-4 in the second game of the doubleheader, Elian Herrera saw his franchise-record-tying 19 game hitting streak come to an end. Incredibly, it marked just the first time in 29 starts with the 'Topes this year that Herrera has failed to get a hit. In 31 total appearances with Albuquerque, Herrera has not gotten a hit just twice prior to last night and those were both as a pinch-hitter. In addition to Herrera's 19-game streak, Josh Fields's 14-game hitting streak and Alex Castellanos's 12-game streak ended in yesterday's doubleheader.

OZZIE, OZZIE: Despite batting just .178 (38x214) in 60 games with Triple-A Charlotte, shortstop Ozzie Martinez has gotten off to a hot start since his All-Star Break trade to the 'Topes. Martinez is 5-for-11 (.455) in his first five games with Albuquerque, getting a hit in every game in which he's gotten an at-bat.

HUGE HOMESTAND IS HERE!!: The 'Topes continue their mammoth eightgame homestand with a replica jersey giveaway tonight courtesy of Lovelace Health System. That sets up a sensational Saturday that that includes Dukes Retro Night, the ABQ Baseball Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony, and fireworks!

TODAY'S START: Will Savage makes the start riding a streak of three straight no-decisions, the last coming in his last start in the first game of a doubleheader at Nashville on July 15 when he pitched 4.0 innings, allowing one run on six hits and a walk while striking out one in a 2-1 'Topes walk-off loss. Made one relief outing on July 17 vs Memphis to get some work in and coaxed an inning-ending groundout on his first pitch. Earned his seventh straight victory on May 13 at Salt Lake when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking two and striking out two in a 10-7 'Topes win. The victory tied a team record for consecutive victories equaling a markset by Sean Bergman in 2003 and tied by Daniel Barone in 2007 and Hyang-Nam Choi in 2009. Beat Oklahoma City on May 3 after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks through 5.0 innings in a 15-5 'Topes win. Also helped his cause at the plate, belting a two-run homer, his first professional home run. Before moving to the rotation, made five appearances out of the bullpen in which he was superb, racking up three wins while posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER $\stackrel{/}{}$ 12.2 IP). Entered the game on April 18 vs. Iowa in the third inning after starter Fernando Nieve was ejected and pitched a then-season-high 4.1 frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while striking out two to earn his third victory of the season.

2011: Led the Double-A Southern League with 12 wins (12-6) and ranked among the league leaders in ERA (3.95, 8th), innings (141.1, 9th) and WHIP (1.25, 2nd) in 25 games (23 starts) with Chattanooga... tied for the most wins in the Dodger organization with Dana Eveland... selected to the Southern League All-Star game, going 7-2 with a 3.70 ERA (30 ER / 73.0 IP) in the season's first half... tossed the second complete game of his career on May 14 against Tennessee, allowing just one run on five hits over 9.0 innings, striking out five and walking only one in the Lookouts' 9-1 victory... his other complete game was a 7.0-inning shutout on May 22, 2010 at Lansing (Single-A Midwest League)... limited right-handed hitters to a .241 batting average... appeared in two games out of the bullpen in a long-relief role, allowing two runs in 9.0 innings (2.00 ERA) and limiting opposing hitters to a .229 batting average... picked up his only save of the season on Sept. 4 against Montgomery with 4.0 innings of two-run ball to close out Chattanooga's 10-5 win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for three Dodger affiliates in his first year in the organization in 2010, going a combined 10-5 with a 4.32 ERA (73 ER / 152.0 IP) in 25 starts with Single-A Great Lakes, Single-A Inland Empire, and Double-A Chattanooga... his 152.0 innings of work was the second-most of any pitcher in the Dodgers organization... went 3-0 with a 2.38 ERA (9 ER / 34.0 IP) in five May starts and was selected as Midwest League Pitcher of the Week from May 17-23 to win a Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes... tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout on May 22 at Lansing.

Released by Philadelphia on April 4, 2009 and pitched for two independent teams Lancaster and Wichita, going a combined 6-7 with a 2.96 ERA (44 ER / 133.2 IP) in 21 games (20 starts)... posted a 2.94 ERA in 18 starts with Wichita, the fourth-best ERA in the American Association, while also ranking fifth in the league in both innings pitched (125.1) and starts... tossed a no-hitter on June 23 in a 1-0 win vs. Sioux City, in which he fanned seven, including four over the last two innings... the gem was just the second no-hitter since the history of the independent American Association... worked into the sixth inning in 17 of his 19 starts and allowed three or fewer earned runs in 15 of them.

Saw action in just six games for Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization in 2008 before going on the Disabled List with a right elbow injury... diagnosed with a slight tear in the ulnar collateral ligament but did not require surgery.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: William P. Savage...attended El Camino Real High School in the San Fernando Valley...played college ball at the University of Oklahoma... attended College of the Canyons JC (Valencia, CA) where he played baseball and football... in 2003, quarterbacked the COC football team to a championship and the program's first undefeated season, going 10-0.
