IOWA CUBS (41-60) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (58-42)

ISOTOPES (HOME) RUN OVER CUBS 16-3: The Albuquerque Isotopes, dressed in Albuquerque Dukes throwback uniforms, smashed a season-high five home runs in a 16-3 blowout of the Iowa Cubs in front of the second largest crowd of the season, 13,798, on Saturday night at Isotopes Park. After Iowa scored two in the first, the 'Topes then put on a show for the gigantic crowd, sending 12 men to the plate and pounding out eight runs in the bottom half of the first. Josh Fields put the 'Topes on the board with a two-run double before coming around to score on a double by Scott Van Slyke to give Albuquerque a 3-2 lead. Jerry Sands then belted a two-run blast to center that put the Isotopes up 5-2. With the bases loaded and two out, Elian Herrera smacked a three-run double to left that capped off the inning and extended the lead 8-2. Albuquerque added a run in the second on an RBI single from Matt Angle, but the I-Cubs matched the tally in the third to cut the deficit 9-3. The 'Topes continued to pour it on in the fifth, making it 11-3 on a two-run homer by Trent Oeltjen, a solo shot from Fields, and a two-run blast by Tim Federowicz. In the seventh, the Isotopes added one more run courtesy of an RBI triple from Ivan De Jesus Jr., before tacking on its final tally in the eighth with a solo shot from Oeltjen that sent Albuquerque to a commanding 16-3 win.

FIFE RETURNS: Stephen Fife makes his first appearance in an Isotopes uniform since July 6, a span of 15 days that includes the All-Star Break and the right-hander's first Major League appearance. Originally slated to make the start on July 16 at the beginning of the homestand, Fife was held back in lieu of Bret Montgomery before joining the Dodgers the next day for his Major League debut. If he had any jitters about making his first appearance in the big leagues, Fife didn't show it, authoring a quality start on July 17 vs. Philadelphia in which he tossed 6.0 solid innings, allowing one run on four hits with three walks and a strikeout. The right-hander actually left with a 2-1 lead, but the Phillies scored two runs in the 8th to take a 3-2 lead. His last appearance for the 'Topes was even more impressive, as Fife fired 7.0 scoreless innings against Round Rock on July 6, allowing two walks and two strikeouts in a 10-1 Albuquerque win.

SWEET 16: With a record of 58-42, the Isotopes are a franchise-record 16 games above .500 for just the sixth time in team history. Albuquerque was 30-14 on May 21, 2006 before reaching the 16-game mark four times in 2009 (71-55-8/20; 72-56-8/22; 79-63-

9/5; 80-64-9/7). The Isotopes have never been 17 games above .500. The 'Topes have reached these lofty heights because they've been red-hot for the better part of July. Albuquerque has won 11 of its last 15 games and is 11-6 this month, the second-best record in the PCL, percentage points behind division-rival Oklahoma City (12-6). The Isotopes have also gone 14-4 in their last 18 games at home.

HOME RUN HAPPENINGS: The Isotopes have gone on a home run binge against Iowa pitching, blasting eight long balls over the last two games. Last night, Albuquerque set season-highs with three dingers in the fifth inning and five total. The 'Topes have now hammered 107 homers on the year, fourthmost in the PCL (Sacramento- 127; OKC- 116; Tacoma- 110).

SLAMMING SANDS: The personification of the Isotopes' sudden penchant for long balls is Jerry Sands, who crushed a solo shot to the deepest part of the ballpark in the first inning last night to give him three homers in his last two games. Sands has collected hits in 11 of his last 12 games, batting .357 (15x42) with eight runs, two doubles, three homers, and 11 RBI since July 5.

CUB CLUB: After losing three of four to the Iowa Cubs at the beginning of the season, the Isotopes have gone 9-1 against the I-Cubs since. In their last two games, the 'Topes have outscored Iowa 26-10 and with a win in their next two contests can post their best yearly record vs. the Cubs in franchise history, surpassing their 10-6 record against Iowa in 2005.

TODAY'S START: Stephen Fife takes the mound for his first start after making his Major League debut with Los Angeles on July 17, when the right-hander filled in for an injured Chad Billingsley. Facing the Philadelphia Phillies, Fife pitched 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits and three walks while striking out one. Fife left with a 2-1 lead and in line to get the win, but the Phillies rallied for two runs in the eighth to grab a 3-2 win. The right-hander held the Phillies' quartet of All-Star players Jimmy Rollins, Chase Utley, Ryan Howard, and Carlos Ruiz to a combined 1-for-11. Had his best outing of the season on July 6 vs. Round Rock, when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in which he allowed just two hits and two walks while striking out two in a 10-1 'Topes win. Won three straight decisions for the second time this season from May 30 to June 26, posting a 1.50 ERA (3 ER / 18.0 IP) in those starts. Had a shutout performance on May 30 in New Orleans when he tossed 6.0 scoreless frames, allowing seven hits and a walk while striking out five in a 4-0 'Topes win. In two starts at New Orleans this year, did not allow a run in 12.0 innings. Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings on May 4 vs. Nashville to extend his streak to 13.0 consecutive innings, fanning a season-high seven in an 8-1 'Topes win. Tied a franchise record by walking eight batters in just 4.2 innings on April 22 at Oklahoma City while allowing five runs on seven hits in an eventual 11-10 'Topes win 14 innings. The eight walks ties knuckleballer Charlie Haeger, who walked eight Omaha Royals in 4.2 innings on June 15, 2010. Enjoyed his first career Triple-A win on April 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 5.2 innings in which he allowed six runs on 10 hits while walking one and striking out one in a 13-6 win. Also racked up two-hits, including a two-run double in the contest, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher to collect multiple hits in a game since Tim Redding went 2-for-3 on May 9 of last year vs. Memphis and the first to have more than one RBI since J.D. Durbin drove in three in a game vs. Round Rock on Sept. 1, 2009.

2011: Started the season with Double-A Portland (ME) in the Boston organization before he was traded to the Dodgers at the July 31 trade deadline in a four player deal that also sent Tim Federowicz and minor leaguer Juan Rodriguez to L.A. in exchange for Trayvon Robinson... overall, went 14-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 25 combined games (24 starts) with Double-A Chattanooga and Double-A Portland... set new career-bests in wins, innings pitched (137.0) and strikeouts (95)... posted a 3-0 record with a 4.01 ERA (15 ER / 33.2 IP) in six starts after joining Chattanooga... owned a 1-0 record with a 2.45 ERA in three road starts with the Lookouts... went 11-4 with a 3.66 ERA with the Sea Dogs before being traded to the Dodgers... at the time of the trade, his 11 wins were tops amongst all Red Sox farmhands... the 11 victories was tied for secondmost in the Eastern League even though he played the last month in the Southern League... selected as a midseason Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Portland after tying for the league lead with 10 first half wins... named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week for the period of June 6-13... after taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning in his start on June 7 vs. Richmond... finished the game going 6.1 innings and allowing one hit while fanning seven... notched a career-high nine strikeouts in his July 5 start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER) at Binghamton... did not allow an earned run in five of 18 starts with Portland... earned the victory in his first start after he was traded to the Dodgers organization, allowing just one run on two hits on August 5 at Jacksonville... following the season, pitched for the Salt River Rafters in the Arizona Fall League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2010, his first season with Double-A Portland, he paced the club in wins (8), starts (26), and innings (136.1) while finishing third on the team with 82 strikeouts... named to the Eastern League's midseason All-Star Team after going 5-2 with a 3.83 ERA before the break... selected as the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for August 30-Sept. 6 after going 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER 11.0 IP) and seven strikeouts in two starts... limited left-handed opposition to a .248 batting average... went 3-1 with a 3.05 ERA (22 ER/65.0 IP) in 12 road starts.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Stephen J. Fife... played two seasons (2007-08) of college baseball at University of Utah and one at Everett Community College in Washington (2006)... went 7-5 with a 3.72 ERA in 15 starts for the University of Utah as a junior in 2008, leading the team in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts... played in the 1999 Little League World Series.
