ISOTOPES FALL TO ROUND ROCK 5-4 IN 11 INNINGS: The Albuquerque Isotopes allowed three runs in the 11th, the last courtesy of a walk-off, RBI single by Elio Sarmiento, in a 5-4 loss to the Round Rock Express on Tuesday night at the Dell Diamond. With the game knotted at 2-2, the Isotopes initially claimed a two-run lead in the 11th, beginning with a leadoff walk to Alex Castellanos. Josh Fields then rolled a grounder to short and Castellanos was able to beat the throw to second, avoiding both the force out and double play. In an attempt to salvage an out on the fielder's choice, second baseman Yangervis Solarte unleashed an errant throw that allowed Castellanos to scamper into third. Facing no outs and a runner in scoring position, Albuquerque padded its lead on an RBI single from Scott Van Slyke, and following a walk to Jerry Sands that loaded the bases, added another tally when Matt Angle collected an RBI knock of his own that made it 4-2 'Topes. The Express refused to call it quits, storming back in the bottom half of the frame with a one-out single from Brad Nelson. Joey Butler then coaxed a walk from 'Topes reliever Angle Guzman, and Solarte grounded out to first to advance both runners. With Round Rock down to its final out, Matt Kata singled to third, but a throwing error from Castellanos allowed the batter to take second while also sending Nelson and Butler home to tie the game 4-4. Sarmiento then completed the comeback with a two-out RBI single that scored the runner from second and gave the Express a 5-4 walk-off victory.

FERNANDO-MANIA: Right-hander Fernando Nieve has emerged from the All-Star Break pitching beautifully. In his last two starts, Nieve is 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER / 11.0 IP), allowing a total of eight hits in that span while walking four and striking out 11. Of those eight knocks he's allowed since returning from the break, only two have gone for extra bases. Nieve also has a season-high two-game winning streak that began with a win against these Round Rock Express on July 4 at Isotopes Park and continued with a masterful shutout performance at Nashville on July 13. In three starts in the month of July, Nieve is 2-0 with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER / 17.0 IP).

HOT BATS: Over the month of July, the Isotopes are batting .325 as a team, second in the PCL by a mere two percentage points to Oklahoma City, who is batting .327 as a team this month. Albuquerque has also belted 26 home runs in 20 games this month

and now has five different players with double-digit home runs; (Jerry Sands-15; Trent Oeltjen-12; Alex Castellanos, Scott Van Slyke-11; Josh Fields-10). Tim Federowicz, who hit his ninth homer of the season last night, is one dinger shy of becoming the sixth Isotope to reach double-digits in homers this year.

DIVISION DOMINANCE: Even with last night's extra-inning heart-breaker, the Isotopes still have a 22-15 record against teams in the PCL's American Southern Division. Not only is Albuquerque's division record tops among American Southern Division teams, amazingly the 'Topes are the only team in the division with a winning record in those important games.

GREAT STARTS: Over the last three games, Isotopes starters have gone 2-0 with a miniscule 0.83 ERA (2 ER / 21.1 IP). In each of the last three contests, 'Topes starters have pitched through the seventh inning and have not given up more than one earned run in a given outing. The combination of Stephen Fife, John Ely, and Derrick Loop have also walked just two while striking out 24 in that span.

THE LAB HEATS UP IN AUGUST: After an eight-game road trip, the Isotopes are back home on August 1 to start the final month of the regular season in style. On tap for the eight-game homestand is cowbell night, a performance by the Zooperstars!, fireworks, and a Dodger Stadium Replica giveaway!

TODAY'S START: Fernando Nieve takes the mound coming off a solid no-decision in his last start, the second game of a doubleheader vs. Memphis on July 19 when he pitched 5.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits while walking two and striking out five in an eventual 3-2 'Topes loss. Pitched 6.0 shutout innings on July 13 at Nashville, his second shutout performance of the season, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out six in a 7-0 'Topes win. The victory was his second in as many starts. Had his best outing of the season on June 8 vs. Memphis when he authored 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out two in a 12-0 'Topes win. Had an excellent outing on May 27 vs. Oklahoma City when he was pressed into service on three days rest when Michael Antonini was scratched and pitched 5.0 solid innings, allowing a run on three hits while walking one and striking out a season-high seven in an 11-9 win. Missed 15 days while on the Disabled List recovering from a hamstring strain. After 2.0 innings at New Orleans on April 26, Nieve came out to warm up for the third but could no further, leaving the game with a strained hamstring. The right-hander was placed on the DL the next day. Also had an outing on April 18 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park that was truncated by an ejection. With two outs in the top of the third, Nieve hit Anthony Rizzo with a pitch and was immediately ejected by home plate umpire Mike Jarboe, ending the right-hander's day after 2.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three. Albuquerque went on to win the game 6-4. Enjoyed a terrific outing in the 'Topes' home opener on April 13 when he held the Omaha Storm Chasers to four runs, three earned, on seven hits in six strong innings of a 7-4 'Topes win. His start Isotopes Park debut stood in stark contrast to his season debut at Omaha on April 8, when he lasted just 1.2 innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits while walking two and striking out two in a 17-11 'Topes loss.

2011: Spent a majority of the season pitching for the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization... appeared in 25 games going 3-6 and a 6.09 ERA... finished the season tied for third on the team with six saves... also fanned 66 batters which ranked fourth amongst Bears pitchers... started the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Houston organization where he made three starts for the RedHawks, going 1-2 with a 7.63 ERA (13 ER / 15.1 IP)... granted his release on April 27.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the majority of the 2010 season with New York (NL)... was Designated for Assignment on July 23rd and optioned to Triple-A Buffalo on July 27... made 40 appearances for New York and had one start, May 29 at Milwaukee, an 8-6 loss... in 2.0 innings, he gave up three hits, five runs, all earned, with three walks and five strikeouts... became the first pitcher in Mets franchise history to appear in 19 of the team's first 30 games... picked up victories in relief vs. the Cubs on April 19 (1.1 scoreless innings with one hit) and vs. Detroit at Citi Field on June 22 (2.1 innings, no hits, no runs, with a walk and four strikeouts)... in seven June games, went 1-0 with a $3.12\ ERA$ (3 ER / $8.2\ IP$ and eight hits)... worked a career-best 10.2 consecutive scoreless innings in nine appearances from April 17-May 3, giving up five hits, with three walks and 10 strikeouts... struck out a season-high four in 2.1 innings vs. Detroit on June 22... went a season-best 3.0 innings vs. Cincinnati on July 5, permitting one run on three hits... made eight straight starts for Buffalo upon his return to the Bisons... scored backto-back victories against Scranton Wilkes-Barre on August 11 and against Pawtucket on August 16... went at least 6.0 innings in four of his eight Triple-A starts.

In 2009 went to Spring Training with Houston... was claimed off waivers by New York (NL) on March 13 and assigned to Double-A Binghamton... promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on May 18 and had his contract purchased by the Mets on June 5... placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 20 with a muscle tear in his right thigh and did not pitch for the rest of the season... tore the muscle during his start on July 19 at Atlanta... finished the season with the best ERA of his career (2.95)... Major League batters went hitless against him with runners in scoring position and two out (0-for-10)... made his Mets debut on June 6 with 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen in a 7-1 loss at Washington, allowing one hit and striking out two... beat St. Louis with 6.0 shutout innings on June 24 at home to establish a career-best three game winning streak... became the first Mets pitcher to win his first three starts with the team since Jorge Sosa in 2007... also tied his career-best scoreless streak with the 6.0 shutout innings on June 24.
