'TOPES OUTLAST EXPRESS 6-5 IN 13-INNING THRILLER: For the second straight night nine innings weren't enough to decide the contest, but this time it was the Albuquerque Isotopes who prevailed, hanging on for a wild 6-5 win in 13-innings over the Round Rock Express Wednesday night at Dell Diamond. Knotted at 5-5 in the 13th and with the sting of Tuesday's 11-inning defeat still fresh, Matt Angle ignited the Isotopes rally with a lead-off single and scampered into scoring position when a pick-off attempt by pitcher Derek Hankins sailed past first baseman Brad Nelson. Tyler Henson then advanced Angle to third on a sacrifice bunt, moving the go-ahead run 90-feet from pay-dirt with just one out. Ozzie Martinez then reached on an infield single to the pitcher, putting runners on the corners, but after Hankins coaxed a strikeout, it appeared the runners may be left stranded. Alex Castellanos had other plans, however, slapping a two-out single to second that plated Angle and gave Albuquerque a 6-5 lead. Right-handed reliever Blake Johnson made sure the one run advantage held, retiring Round Rock in order in the bottom of the 13th to seal the 6-5 Isotopes victory and earn his second win in four days.

SAVAGE SPELL: After racing out to 10 victories on the year, right-hander Will Savage has been stuck at 10 for almost exactly a month. His last victory came on June 25, when he beat the Nashville Sounds at Isotopes Park. Since then, Savage has had five straight no-decisions, posting a 7.41 ERA (14 ER / 17.0 IP) in that span. His last start ended up being his shortest, as the right-hander lasted just 3.0 innings on July 20 vs. Iowa, allowing six runs on eight hits in a game eventually won by the Isotopes 10-7 thanks to a three-run walk-off homer by Jerry Sands. Even with a month of no-decisions, however, Savage still ranks among PCL leaders in wins, tied for second with New Orleans' Tom Koehler and Reno's Joe Martinez behind Fresno's Eric Hacker (11).

EXTRA, EXTRA: For just the fourth time in franchise history (and for the first time on the road), the Isotopes have played back-to-back extra-inning contests, with last night's 13-inning win coming on the heels of an 11-inning loss on Tuesday. The last time the 'Topes had two consecutive extra-inning contests was on May 23 and May 24, 2010, when Albuquerque dropped a game against Las Vegas 9-8 in 10 innings and beat Reno 9-8 in 11 frames the next night. Last night, three teams in the Dodgers organization went extras, as LA fell in St. Louis 3-2 in 12 innings and Rancho Cucamonga lost at Inland Empire 10-6 in 11 frames. This season Albuquerque is 4-3 in extra-inning games.

FABULOUS FED: Catcher Tim Federowicz has found his power stroke, hitting homers in back-to-back games for the first time this season while going yard in three of his last four contests. With 10 homers now on the year, Federowicz is already within striking distance of his career-high set last year when he hit eight for Double-A Portland and six more with the 'Topes after being traded from the Red Sox for a total of 14. In 16 games in July, Federowicz is batting .318 (21x66) with seven runs, two doubles, three homers, and 13 RBI.

STREAKING SLYKE: Scott Van Slyke has a tied a season-high by racking up hits in his last seven straight games, a span in which he's batted .344 (11x32) with six runs, three doubles, and three RBI. Since returning to Albuquerque from Los Angeles on July 16, Van Slyke is batting an even .300 (12x40)

TEXAS TWO-STEP: A win in their next two games would give the Isotopes a season-series win against the Round Rock Express for the first time since 2010, when the 'Topes went 9-7 against their Texas rivals. In the seven years the 'Topes and Express have been playing against each other since Round Rock joined the PCL in 2005, Albuquerque has prevailed in the season series three times, dropped the season series twice and split twice.

THE LAB HEATS UP IN AUGUST: After an eight-game road trip, the Isotopes are back home on August 1 to start the final month of the regular season in style. On tap for the eight-game homestand is cowbell night, a performance by the Zooperstars!, fireworks, and a Dodger Stadium Replica giveaway!

TODAY'S START: Will Savage makes the start riding a streak of four straight no-decisions, the last coming in his last start on July 20 vs. Iowa when he pitched 3.0 innings, his shortest start of the season, allowing six runs on eight hits and a walk while striking out none in an eventual 10-7 'Topes win. Made one relief outing on July 17 vs Memphis to get some work in and coaxed an inning-ending groundout on his first pitch. Earned his seventh straight victory on May 13 at Salt Lake when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking two and striking out two in a 10-7 'Topes win. The victory tied a team record for consecutive victories equaling a markset by Sean Bergman in 2003 and tied by Daniel Barone in 2007 and Hyang-Nam Choi in 2009. Beat Oklahoma City on May 3 after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks through 5.0 innings in a 15-5 'Topes win. Also helped his cause at the plate, belting a two-run homer, his first professional home run. Before moving to the rotation, made five appearances out of the bullpen in which he was superb, racking up three wins while posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER / 12.2 IP). Entered the game on April 18 vs. Iowa in the third inning after starter Fernando Nieve was ejected and pitched a then-season-high 4.1 frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while striking out two to earn his third victory of the season.

2011: Led the Double-A Southern League with 12 wins (12-6) and ranked among the league leaders in ERA (3.95, 8th), innings (141.1, 9th) and WHIP (1.25, 2nd) in 25 games (23 starts) with Chattanooga... tied for the most wins in the Dodger organization with Dana Eveland... selected to the Southern League All-Star game, going 7-2 with a 3.70 ERA (30 ER / 73.0 IP) in the season's first half... tossed the second complete game of his career on May 14 against Tennessee, allowing just one run on five hits over 9.0 innings, striking out five and walking only one in the Lookouts' 9-1 victory... his other complete game was a 7.0-inning shutout on May 22, 2010 at Lansing (Single-A Midwest League)... limited right-handed hitters to a .241 batting average... appeared in two games out of the bullpen in a long-relief role, allowing two runs in 9.0 innings (2.00 ERA) and limiting opposing hitters to a .229 batting average... picked up his only save of the season on Sept. 4 against Montgomery with 4.0 innings of two-run ball to close out Chattanooga's 10-5 win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for three Dodger affiliates in his first year in the organization in 2010, going a combined 10-5 with a 4.32 ERA (73 ER / 152.0 IP) in 25 starts with Single-A Great Lakes, Single-A Inland Empire, and Double-A Chattanooga... his 152.0 innings of work was the second-most of any pitcher in the Dodgers organization... went 3-0 with a 2.38 ERA (9 ER / 34.0 IP) in five May starts and was selected as Midwest League Pitcher of the Week from May 17-23 to win a Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes... tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout on May 22 at Lansing

Released by Philadelphia on April 4, 2009 and pitched for two independent teams Lancaster and Wichita, going a combined 6-7 with a 2.96 ERA (44 ER / 133.2 IP) in 21 games (20 starts)... posted a 2.94 ERA in 18 starts with Wichita, the fourth-best ERA in the American Association, while also ranking fifth in the league in both innings pitched (125.1) and starts... tossed a no-hitter on June 23 in a 1-0 win vs. Sioux City, in which he fanned seven, including four over the last two innings... the gem was just the second no-hitter since the history of the independent American Association... worked into the sixth inning in 17 of his 19 starts and allowed three or fewer earned runs in 15 of them.

Saw action in just six games for Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization in 2008 before going on the Disabled List with a right elbow injury... diagnosed with a slight tear in the ulnar collateral ligament but did not require surgery.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: William P. Savage...attended El Camino Real High School in the San Fernando Valley...played college ball at the University of Oklahoma... attended College of the Canyons JC (Valencia, CA) where he played baseball and football... in 2003, quarterbacked the COC football team to a championship and the program's first undefeated season, going 10-0.
