### ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (61-44) AT ROUND ROCK EXPRESS (44-61)

**ISOTOPES EDGED BY EXPRESS, 3-2:** The Albuquerque Isotopes one-run rally in the eighth came up just short in a 3-2 loss to the Round Rock Express on Thursday night at the Dell Diamond. Albuquerque snagged an early lead in the second on a solo shot from Ivan De Jesus Jr. that put the 'Topes up 1-0. Round Rock answered in the fourth as Brad Nelson blasted a two-out triple to center and scored on an RBI double from Matt Kata to tie the contest 1-1. Albuquerque starter Will Savage kept the Express off balance until the seventh, when Kata ripped a leadoff triple to right and scored two batters later on an RBI single from Luis Hernandez that give the home team a 2-1 lead. Hernandez then took second on a wild pitch from Savage, advanced to third on a single, and finally scored on a sac-fly from Tommy Mendonca to widen the advantage 3-1. Following the two-run seventh, Savage retired from the contest having tossed 7.0 innings in which he allowed three runs on eight hits, while walking none and fanning five. The Isotopes showed signs of a comeback in the eighth, narrowing the deficit to 3-2 when Trent Oeltjen smacked a leadoff triple and immediately scored on a sac-fly from Elian Herrera. However, the rally was short lived as a 'Topes groundout and flyout ended the inning, sending the 'Topes to a 3-2 defeat.

THE PATRON SAINT OF SPOT STARTS: Lefty Cole St. Clair makes the spot-start tonight for Albuquerque, the first of his five-year professional career. The last time St. Clair toed the slab in a starting role was on March 11, 2008 when the lefty was a senior at Rice University pitching against the University of Houston at Recklin Park on the Rice campus, roughly 170 miles from Dell Diamond. This season, St. Clair has been a stalwart out of the Isotopes bullpen, leading all 'Topes relievers (excluding Michael Antonini, who started the season in the rotation) with 51.2 innings in 32 appearances, fourth most on the club. As a middle-inning specialist, the lefty is no stranger to working multiple innings, logging 4.0 frames in an appearance twice this season, including just a week ago on July 20 vs. Iowa at Isotopes Park. St. Clair has also been playing his best lately, racking up a 2.61 ERA (3 ER / 10.1 IP) in five appearances in the month of July, his lowest ERA in any single month this season. The southpaw has also been superb on the road, posting a 1.35 ERA (3 ER / 20.0 IP) in 15 appearances away from Isotopes Park.

SERIES THINKING: The Isotopes tonight look to avoid their first series loss in nearly a month, when they dropped three of four games against the tough Omaha Storm Chasers at Werner Park on June

30-July 3. Since then, Albuquerque has won three series and split one, going 13-6 in that span.

**TOO CLOSE TO CALL:** Each of the last three games between the Isotopes and Express have been decided by one run, with Round Rock winning the first and third games 5-4, 3-2 and Albuquerque winning the second game 6-5. In seven total games played between the 'Topes and Express at Dell Diamond this year, the average winning margin is just two runs.

**TORRID TRENT:** Trent Oeltjen continues to swing a hot bat, racking up hits in each of his last eight games, a season high for the Australian. Since the streak began on July 18, Oeltjen is batting .419 (13x31) with six of those 13 knocks going for extra bases. Oeltjen has picked up a hit in 18 of 21 games played in the month of July, batting a scorching .381 (32x84) this month.

**DEARLY DEPARTED DH:** This will be the last time the Isotopes will be able to use the Designated Hitter until the final series of the season when Omaha comes to Isotopes Park from August 31-September 3. Tomorrow in Nashville begins a stretch of 33 straight games against National League affiliated teams, meaning pitchers will get their hacks for the next month.

**THE LAB HEATS UP IN AUGUST:** After an eight-game road trip, the Isotopes are back home on August 1 to start the final month of the regular season in style. On tap for the eight-game homestand is cowbell night, a performance by the Zooperstars!, fireworks, and a Dodger Stadium Replica giveaway!

**TODAY'S START:** Lefty Cole St. Clair makes the first start of his professional career and his first since he was a senior at Rice University in 2008. Appeared in 32 games out of the bullpen for Albuquerque, racking up 51.2 innings, the most by an exclusive 'Topes reliever so far this season. Is a perfect 3-0 in his three decisions this year, all of which have come at home. Won his first career Triple-A game on May 7 vs. Nashville when he pitched a season-high 4.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits while walking none and striking out two in an 8-3 Isotopes win. Went six straight appearances from April 16 to May 5 without giving up a run, a span of 7.1 innings. Did not give up his first home run until his 16th appearance of the season, a span of 23.1 consecutive innings. His three total home runs allowed is tied with Scott Rice for the fewest on the team (min. 20.0 IP).

2011: Went 1-5 with a 3.04 ERA (17 ER / 50.1 IP) and two saves with Double-A Chattanooga... was second on the Lookouts with 42 appearances... fanned 46 batters while walking 13... limited opposing hitters to a .242 (43x178) batting average, including a .212 (21x99) mark against right-handers... selected as a Southern League All-Star after posting 0.83 ERA (2 ER / 21.2 IP) in 19 first-half appearances... did not allow a run in seven June appearances (7.0 IP)... allowed just four runs in an 18-game (22.0 IP) span from May through July (1.63 ERA).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Split the 2010 season between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 1-3 with a 4.21 ERA (34 ER / 72.2 IP) and three saves in 44 appearances... struck out 74 batters between both stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER / 12.0 IP) and two saves in eight games... limited opposing hitters to a .167 average (7x42) with 15 strikeouts to earn an April 30 promotion to Chattanooga... saw action in 36 games with the Lookouts, going 1-2 with a 4.60 ERA (31 ER / 60.2 IP) and one save... held opposing hitters to a .211 average (8x38) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

Appeared in 30 games for Single-A Great Lakes in 2009, going 4-1 with a 2.48 ERA (10 ER / 36.1 IP) and 15 saves... did not allow a run over his final 13 appearances (14.0 IP) for the Loons... overall, limited opposing hitters to a .226 average (30x133) with 45 strikeouts in 36.1 innings... successfully converted each of his nine save opportunities... won the August/September Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes, going 1-0 with seven saves, not allowing a run in 10.0 innings and limiting opponents to a .194 average (7x36) with 11 strikeouts in nine August games.

Selected by the Dodgers in the seventh round of the 2008 draft and began his professional career at Rookie-Level Ogden, posting no record and an 3.18 ERA (6 ER / 17.0 IP) and five saves in 12 games... fanned 22 while walking just five.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Allen Cole St. Clair... went 10-3 with five saves and a 3.03 ERA in 24 games (three starts) as a senior with Rice in 2008... had been selected by Cleveland in the seventh round of the 2007 draft, but chose to return to Rice for his senior season... graduated from Rice with a Bachelor's degree in Economics... was named the winner of the 2008 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, an honor that identifies personal qualities that define a complete studentathlete... was named a *Baseball America* First-Team College All-American after his sophomore season in 2006... pitched for Team USA in 2006, winning the Gold Medal at the FISU World Championships in Havana, Cuba... pitched in three College World Series from 2006-08... was a teammate of Phillip Hughes at Foothill High School in Santa Ana... his father Jay played basketball at the University of Southern California.
