ALBUQUERQUE DROPS 5-2 HEARTBREAKER IN 12 INNINGS: The Albuquerque Isotopes allowed two runs in the ninth before finally succumbing to a walk-off, three-run homer in the 12th for a gut-wrenching 5-2 loss to the Omaha Storm Chasers Monday night at Werner Park. Knotted at 2-2 in the bottom of the 12th inning, the Chasers started a rally by leading off the frame with back-to-back singles by David Lough and Derrick Robinson off Albuquerque reliever Scott Rice. After Rice struck out Anthony Seratelli on a foul bunt, Max Ramirez blasted a 3-2 pitch over the wall in left-center to give Omaha a dramatic 5-2 walk-off victory. The fact the contest went to extra innings at all was due to some terrible luck for the 'Topes. Clinging to a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the ninth, Albuquerque closer Josh Wall got two quick outs before Wil Myers hit a grounder that bounced off the third base bag for a two-out infield hit. Clint Robinson then roped a single to left and Tony Abreu walked, loading the bases for Lough, who hit a ball right back up the middle that deflected off Wall's glove and rolled in the direction of shortstop Joe Becker. Becker picked up the ball and immediately threw to first, but his toss sailed high, allowing two runs to score and the Storm Chasers to improbably tie the score at 2-2.

SHOWING SOME LOVE FOR LOOP: Looking to snap a four-game losing streak, Albuquerque turns to its newest starter Derrick Loop, who happened to be the starting pitcher the last time the 'Topes won a game on June 28. In that start, the left-hander's first of the season, Loop gutted through 3.0 innings, allowing four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while striking out two in an eventual 10-8 Isotopes win over the Memphis Redbirds. The four walks was particularly uncharacteristic for Loop, who usually showcases pin-point control. Prior to his start, the southpaw had surrendered four total walks over 14.0 innings spread out among eight appearances.

TOUGH STRETCH: For just the second time this year, the Isotopes have dropped four in a row, equaling a streak set from May 31 to June 3. Albuquerque has also dropped four in a row, and seven of nine, to the Omaha Storm Chasers and is in danger of being swept for the first time all year. The Isotopes have only been swept by Omaha once in team history, on June 30 to July 3, 2003 when the Omaha Royals took four in a row from the 'Topes in Albuquerque.

CRUZ'N TO L.A: After the getting word on Sunday night that he was joining the Dodgers, Luis Cruz flew from Omaha to Los Angeles yesterday and got the start at shortstop in his Dodgers debut. In his first at-bat in the second inning, Cruz lifted a sacrifice fly that plated James Loney and gave LA a 2-0 lead in an eventual 8-2 loss to the Cincinnati Reds. On the night, Cruz went 0-for-2 with an RBI. Last night, the Dodgers' starting lineup featured three players who began the year in Albuquerque in Elian Herrera, Scott Van Slyke, and Cruz. While things have been tough for the 'Topes, who have lost five of six, the Dodgers have dropped eight of their last nine.

RIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF: More than a month in the Major Leagues has done little to cool off Ivan De Jesus Jr., who racked up three hits last night in his first game back with Albuquerque after getting recalled to LA on May 19. De Jesus has gotten a hit in each of his last nine games played at the Triple-A level, going 15-for-41 (.366) with three doubles, a triple, and eight RBI in that span.

TODAY'S START: Derrick Loop makes his second start of the season after going 3.0 innings in a start at Memphis on June 28, his first since August 27, 2011, giving up four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while fanning two in a 10-8 'Topes win. Before moving to the rotation, made 20 appearances out of the bullpen, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP). Transferred to Albuquerque from Extended Spring on April 8 and made his Isotopes debut that night at Omaha, pitching 3.0 innings in which he allowed one unearned run. The outing marked just his second-career Triple-A appearance (he made one appearance for Lehigh Valley in 2010). Transferred to Ogden roster on April 11 but returned to Albuquerque for good on April 23. Pitched a then-season-high 4.0 innings in a win vs. Oklahoma City on May 28, the third in a string of three straight victorious decisions, also a

2011: Spent season between Single-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization... went 2-1 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER / 32.0 IP) and three saves in 24 appearances for Clearwater.. left-handed hitters batted just .100 (4x40) against him, while righties batted .261 (18x69)... started the season by not allowing a run in his first 10 consecutive outings, a span of 12.1 conecutive scoreless innings... transferred to Reading on June 16 and finished the year there, going 1-3 with a 5.29 (20 ER / 34.0 IP) in 19 games (two starts)... held lefthanded hitters to a 0.81 average (7x86)... made two starts to end the season (on August 17 and August 27), both in the second game of doubleheaders, and took the loss in both, going a combined 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER / 8.0 IP)... his start on August 17 was his first since April 16, 2009, when he made the start for Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Started the 2010 season with Camden in the Independent Atlantic League, going 0-1 with a 1.72 (6 ER / 31.1 IP) in 33 games... walked just 17 batters while striking out 40... signed with the Phillies on July 14 and began season with Single-A Clearwater... was on DL, from August 15-22... did not allow an earned run in 14 of his 15 relief appearances with Clearwater before being promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5 for his Triple-A debut... averaged 10.29 SO / 9.0 IP between both levels... held opponents to a combined .165 avg (15x91)... played for Aguilas in Dominican Winter League (16 G, 1-1, 2.79 ERA).

Spent majority of 2009 season with Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization, going 3-3 with a 1.61 ERA (12 ER / 67.0 IP) in 47 games (one start)... finished second in Boston system and third in Carolina League in saves with 18... ranked second in CL in ERA (1.61) and fouth in SO/IP (10.71)... selected as midseason Carolina League All-Star... had a 17.1-inning scoreless streak (nine games), April 12 to May 4, and a 21.2-inning scoreless streak (16 games), June 1 to July 27... did not allow an earned run in 40 of 47 appearances with Salem... promoted to Double-A Portland on August 24 and made four appearances for the Sea Dogs, going 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA (3 ER 4.1 IP).

In 2008, began season with Chico Outlaws of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER / 29.1 IP) in six games (five starts)... had contract purchased by Boston and was assigned to Single-A Lancaster on June $25\dots$ set a Lancaster franchise record with 5 wins in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (6 ER / 33.0 IP) for the month... ended up 6-0 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER / 53.1 IP) in 17 games (five starts) for Lancaster.
