'TOPES EDGED BY SOUNDS IN WALK-OFF FASHION, 4-3: After dominating the first three games, the Albuquerque Isotopes were dealt a measure of revenge as the Nashville Sounds scored a run in the bottom of the ninth to earn a 4-3 walk-off win Monday night at Greer Stadium. With the game knotted at 3-3 in the bottom of the ninth, Albuquerque reliever Luis Vasquez immediately found himself in a spot of trouble when he issued a lead-off walk to Khris Davis. After a sacrifice and groundout moved the runner to third, Edwin Maysonet roped a two-out single to left, easily plating Davis and giving the Sounds a dramatic 4-3 win. The stage for the last-inning dramatics was set, however, by a seventh inning in which the Isotopes grabbed a lead and immediately relinquished it. With Tyler Henson on third and two down, Elian Herrera dunked a single into center, plating the runner and giving Albuquerque a 3-2 lead. The advantage proved short-lived, as Nashville immediately manufactured an answer in the bottom of the frame. Jordan Brown drew a lead-off walk and quickly advanced into scoring position on a sacrifice bunt. Maysonet then dropped down another bunt that was fielded by pitcher Fernando Nieve, who tossed it to first, but Josh Fields couldn't find the handle for an error, allowing the batter to reach first while Brown coasted into third. Pinch-hitter Sean Halton completed the rally with a sacrifice fly center, scoring Brown, knotting the game at 3-3 and setting up the ninth-inning drama.

WILL ON THE HILL: Right-hander Will Savage takes the mound coming off a tough-luck loss in his last outing at Round Rock on July 26. Savage pitched a season-high 7.0 innings and allowed only three runs on eight hits while walking one and striking out five, but suffered his fourth loss of the season in a 3-2 defeat. The setback has prolonged the right-hander's winless streak to six straight starts since his last victory on June 25. In that span, Savage has been respectable, posting a 4.88 ERA (13 ER / 24.0 IP) since his last win.

SANDS STILL SWINGING: Although virtually everything pales in comparison to a two-grand slam performance, Sands remains hot, collecting two hits last night to extend his current hitting streak to five straight games. In those five games, Sands has racked up multiple hits in his last four contests, going 10-for-17 since July 28. With another RBI last night, Sands has knocked in 23 runs in 26 games played in the month of July, tied for fourth-most in the PCL. The slugging Sands is fourth in the League with 73 RBI on the

JUMPING JULY: After tonight the Isotopes will turn the page on July, a month that has been successful for the 'Topes. Heading into tonight, Albuquerque is 17-10, the second most wins they've ever racked up in the month of July. The Isotopes won 19 games in 2003 (19-10) and 2009 (19-8). All-time, the 'Topes are 147-131 in July for a .529 winning percentage. When it's all said in done, Albuquerque can look to its pitching as the force that carried the team through the month. Isotopes pitchers posted a 3.93 ERA in the month of July, the second best ERA in the PCL behind New Orleans' July mark of 3.26.

FIRST BLOOD: Albuquerque has scored first in each of the last the three games, going 2-1 in that span. On the season, the 'Topes are 37-14 (.725 winning percentage) when getting on the scoreboard first, the third best winning percentage in the league behind Las Vegas (42-14, .750) and New Orleans (45-17, .726).

NORTHERN EXPOSURE: Through 54 games, the Isotopes have dominated their counterparts in the PCL's American Northern Division, racking up a record of 33-21 against Iowa, Memphis, Nashville, and Omaha. The 'Topes will end the season posting their best record in a season series in franchise history against Iowa (12-4) and Nashville (11-4 plus tonight) and have a winning record against Memphis (6-5) with five games to play. Although the Isotopes are 4-8 against the Storm Chasers, they get four games against Omaha at home to close out the regular season on August 31-September 3.

THE LAB HEATS UP IN AUGUST: After an eight-game road trip, the Isotopes are back home tomorrow to start the final month of the regular season in style. On tap for the eight-game homestand is cowbell night, a performance by the Zooperstars!, fireworks, and a Dodger Stadium Replica giveaway!

TODAY'S START: Will Savage makes the start coming off a tough-luck nodecision on July 26 at Round Rock when he pitched a season-high 7.0 innings, allowing three runs on eight hits while walking one and striking out five in a 3-2 'Topes loss. Made one relief outing on July 17 vs Memphis to get some work in and coaxed an inning-ending groundout on his first pitch. Earned his seventh straight victory on May 13 at Salt Lake when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four runs, three earned, on five hits while walking two and striking out two in a 10-7 'Topes win. The victory tied a team record for consecutive victories equaling a markset by Sean Bergman in 2003 and tied by Daniel Barone in 2007 and Hyang-Nam Choi in 2009. Beat Oklahoma City on May 3 after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks through 5.0 innings in a 15-5 'Topes win. Also helped his cause at the plate, belting a two-run homer, his first professional home run. Before moving to the rotation, made five appearances out of the bullpen in which he was superb, racking up three wins while posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER / 12.2 IP). Entered the game on April 18 vs. Iowa in

the third inning after starter Fernando Nieve was ejected and pitched a then-seasonhigh 4.1 frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while striking out two to earn his

2011: Led the Double-A Southern League with 12 wins (12-6) and ranked among the league leaders in ERA (3.95, 8th), innings (141.1, 9th) and WHIP (1.25, 2nd) in 25 games (23 starts) with Chattanooga... tied for the most wins in the Dodger organization with Dana Eveland... selected to the Southern League All-Star game, going 7-2 with a 3.70 ERA (30 ER / 73.0 IP) in the season's first half... tossed the second complete game of his career on May 14 against Tennessee, allowing just one run on five hits over 9.0 innings, striking out five and walking only one in the Lookouts' 9-1 victory... his other complete game was a 7.0-inning shutout on May 22, 2010 at Lansing (Single-A Midwest League)... limited right-handed hitters to a .241 batting average... appeared in two games out of the bullpen in a long-relief role, allowing two runs in 9.0 innings (2.00 ERA) and limiting opposing hitters to a .229 batting average... picked up his only save of the season on Sept. 4 against Montgomery with 4.0 innings of two-run ball to close out Chattanooga's 10-5 win.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for three Dodger affiliates in his first year in the organization in 2010, going a combined 10-5 with a 4.32 ERA (73 ER / 152.0 IP) in 25 starts with Single-A Great Lakes, Single-A Inland Empire, and Double-A Chattanooga... his 152.0 innings of work was the second-most of any pitcher in the Dodgers organization... went 3-0 with a 2.38 ERA (9 ER / 34.0 IP) in five May starts and was selected as Midwest League Pitcher of the Week from May 17-23 to win a Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes... tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout on May 22 at Lansing

Released by Philadelphia on April 4, 2009 and pitched for two independent teams Lancaster and Wichita, going a combined 6-7 with a 2.96 ERA (44 ER / 133.2 IP) in 21 games (20 starts)... posted a 2.94 ERA in 18 starts with Wichita, the fourth-best ERA in the American Association, while also ranking fifth in the league in both innings pitched (125.1) and starts... tossed a no-hitter on June 23 in a 1-0 win vs. Sioux City, in which he fanned seven, including four over the last two innings... the gem was just the second no-hitter since the history of the independent American Association... worked into the sixth inning in 17 of his 19 starts and allowed three or fewer earned runs in 15 of them.
