### ROUND ROCK EXPRESS (38-51) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (51-38)

FIFE FIRES SEVEN SCORELESS IN 10-1 'TOPES BLOWOUT: Starter Stephen Fife tossed a gem as the Albuquerque Isotopes blew out the Round Rock Express 10-1 on Friday night at Isotopes Park. Fife was nearly unhittable, giving up a mere two knocks through 7.0 shutout innings of work. The right-hander faced a total of 24 batters on the night, three above the minimum through seven innings, en route to collecting his fourth win in his last five decisions. It was all Albuquerque all night as the home team jumped to a quick lead in the third when Josh Fields smashed a bases-loaded double down the left-field line that scored three and put the 'Topes up 3-0. The Isotopes added another in the fifth, going up 4-0 on an RBI single from Tim Federowicz. The 'Topes began the sixth with a walk to Tyler Henson, who advanced to third on a groundball from Oeltjen that was misplayed by Guilder Rodriguez. Round Rock then called upon reliever Ross Wolf, who Albuquerque battered around for four quick runs beginning with consecutive RBI singles from Alex Castellanos and Fields to make it 6-0. Two batters later, Federowicz slapped a two-run single to cap off the inning and give the Isotopes a commanding 8-0 lead. In the seventh, Albuquerque continued to light up the scoreboard with a Henson single followed by a two-run homer from Trent Oeltjen, his second in as many games, to widen the lead 10-0. The Express broke up the shutout with a two-out RBI single in the ninth from Brad Nelson, before Angel Guzman closed the door for a 10-1 victory.

ACE ON THE MOUND: 'Topes ace John Ely takes the mound coming off a tough no-decision in his last start on July 2 at Omaha when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out nine. Despite leaving the game with a 2-0 lead, Ely watched from the dugout as the Storm Chasers plated two with two down in the bottom of the ninth en route to a 5-2 Omaha win in 12 innings. The right-hander will now make his last start before shuffling off to the Triple-A All-Star Game in Buffalo looking to close out the pre-break portion of the 2012 season perfect at home. In eight starts at The Lab so far this season, Ely is a perfect 5-0 with a 2.47 ERA (14 ER / 51.0 IP), while walking 10 and striking out 45. He has won each of his last three starts at Isotopes Park dating back to May 26. The Triple-A All-Star looks to also increase his PCL lead in strikeouts. Ely has fanned 112 batters this year, 17 more than the next closest pitcher, Fresno's Yusmeiro Petit, a former 'Tope who has 95.

BEASTMODE'S BACK!: It's not every season the best player in baseball comes to your city, but it's even more rare when he comes twice, as is the case for lucky 'Topes fans. Dodgers superstar outfielder Matt Kemp returns to Isotopes Park today and tomorrow while

continuing his Major League rehabilitation from a strained left hamstring. In his last appearance at The Lab on May 27 and May 28, Kemp put on a hitting display, going 5-for-7 (.714) with a double, two homers, and five RBI in two games. He was then activated by the Dodgers but reinjured the hamstring running the bases against Milwaukee on May 30 and returned to the DL on May 31. He's already appeared in four rehab games for Single-A Rancho Cucamonga from July 3 to July 6, going 6-for-14 (.429) with a double and four RBI.

SWEET SIX: With last night's drubbing of the Express, the Isotopes have now won six straight games at The Lab dating back to June 24, tying a season-high. The longest home winning streak in team history is 10 games, set from June 25-July 24, 2009

**LOVING LEFTIES:** The Isotopes are 23-9 against left-handed pitchers this season with Josh Fields and Tim Federowicz being particularly abusive to lefties. Fields is batting .375 (39x104) with 11 doubles, a triple, four homers, and 17 RBI while Federowicz is hitting at a .405 (34x84) clip vs. southpaws with 11 doubles, a triple, three homers, and 16 RBI.

SERIES BUSINESS: By taking the first three games in a five-game set against the Express, the 'Topes have won three straight series at Isotopes Park. The last time Albuquerque didn't win a series at home was June 11-13, when these very Express took two of three games.

HOMESTAND ROLLS ON!!: The Isotopes' five-game homestand continues tonight with the second Isotopes Park fireworks show in four days! Tomorrow, the 'Topes head into the Triple-A All-Star Break in style with the Isotopes Park debut of the Sweetright Brothers!

TODAY'S START: John Ely makes his last start before he heads off to the Triple-A All-Star Game coming off a sensational no-decision at Omaha on July 2 when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out nine. Left the game with a 2-0 lead but the Storm Chasers scored two in the ninth en route to a 5-2 win in 12 innings. Selected to his first Triple-A All-Star Game and his first since he appeared as a Southern League All-Star in 2009. Won a season-high fourth straight game after a victory on June 22 vs. New Orleans when he allowed four runs on five hits in 6.1 innings while walking one and striking out six in an 8-4 Isotopes win in seven-innings. Came two outs away from becoming the first Isotope this season to toss a complete game but surrendered back-to-back home runs that ended his night. Had a streak of six straight quality starts from April 30-May 26. Had a dominant 3-2 win at Tacoma on May 10 when he allowed just two runs on four hits while walking three and striking out a career-high 11, shattering his old career-high of nine set in 2008 when he was at Single-A Winston-Salem in the South Atlantic League. Authored 15.0 scoreless innings in three straight home starts from April 19-May 5. Earned his first victory of 2012, a stellar start on April 19 vs. Iowa when he allowed three runs on six hits in seven innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-3 'Topes win.

2011: Played most of the season in Albuquerque, going 7-8 with a 5.99 ERA (96 ER / 144.1 IP) in 25 starts.. recalled on April 10 and made a spot start for the Dodgers that day at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres... optioned back to Albuquerque on April 11... nearly threw his first career no-hitter and the first no-hitter in Isotopes history in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20... after holding the I-Cubs hitless going into the seventh and final inning, he struck out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith... then retired the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career... named PCL Pitcher of the Week for April 18-25 thanks to his performance... had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career.. allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in the 3-1 'Topes victory... recalled on June 4 and had a brief stay with the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing of his career - 2007 at Rookie-Level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati... entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win... if he had worked the ninth, he would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA... optioned back to Albuquerque on June 6... had a short stay with the Dodgers after being recalled on August 1 and was inserted into the Los Angeles bullpen, but did not appear in any games before being optioned back to Albuquerque on August 7... recalled one last time on Sept. 6 and made three more relief appearances for Dodgers, not allowing a run in 4.0 innings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut in 2010, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6-June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17-July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from Sept. 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodgers rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins.
