## ROUND ROCK EXPRESS (39-51) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (51-39)

'TOPES WIN STREAK SNAPPED WITH 6-3 LOSS TO EXPRESS: Even with Dodgers rehabbing All-Star Outfielder Matt Kemp scoring a run, the Albuquerque Isotopes' ninth-inning rally came up just short in a 6-3 loss to the Round Rock Express on Saturday night at Isotopes Park. The Express drew first blood in the opening frame when Brad Nelson slapped an RBI single to center, giving Round Rock its first lead 1-0. The visitors struck again in the fourth, extending their advantage 2-0 on a two-out RBI double by Greg Miclat. Both teams traded a run in the sixth beginning with a solo shot from Luis Martinez to make it 3-0, before the 'Topes were finally able to get on the board in the bottom half of the frame. Kemp, who finished the night 1-for-5, collected his only hit of the game with a leadoff single to right, but was immediately forced out at second on a grounder from Josh Fields. Jerry Sands and Tim Federowicz then drew back-to-back walks to load the bases for Tyler Henson, who lifted a deep sac-fly to center that plated Fields and brought the Isotopes within 3-1. Round Rock extended the advantage to 6-1 with three in the eighth before Albuquerque teased a comeback in the final inning. Kemp reached on a fielder's choice, took second via defensive indifference and crossed home on an RBI single from Fields that narrowed the deficit 6-2. With two outs Sands ripped a single to right-center that advanced Fields to third. The 'Topes then brought the score within 6-3 after Express reliever Aaron Heilman slung a wild pitch to the backstop that allowed Fields to scamper home for the final run of the inning. One batter later, Federowicz drove a ball all the way to the warning track in right, but it was run down by Butler for the final out, sealing a 6-3 Round Rock win.

THERE CAN BE ONLY ONE DERRICK: Isotopes lefty Derrick Loop takes the mound against the Express' Derek Hankins looking to continue a two-game winning streak. After earning the win in his last appearance as a reliever on June 21, Loop earned a victory in his second start after allowing six runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings of an 11-7 win at Omaha on July 3, a victory that turned out to be Albuquerque's only win in the four-game set against the Storm Chasers. Despite spending most of this season as a reliever, Loop has now been stretched out in just two appearances as a starter. In his last outing, Loop tossed a season-high 78 pitches.

TIME FOR A BREAK: After tonight's game the Isotopes will take three days off for the Triple-A All-Star Break before reconvening on Thursday, July 12 for a four-game series in Nashville. In addition to watching John Ely, Tim Federowicz, and Josh Wall in the Triple-A All-Star Game, expect the 'Topes to get a lot of rest, because they're going to need it. Once play resumes Thursday, the 'Topes will get just one day off' (August 9) before the end of the regular season, a span of 53

WINNING TIME: Regardless of the outcome of tonight's game, the 'Topes are poised to head into the All-Star Break with their best record in franchise history. Prior to this season, the most wins the 'Topes ever entered the break with was 49 (2005). If Albuquerque can leap-frog Oklahoma City, it would mark the third time the Isotopes headed to the break in first place (2005, 2009).

WANTED: EXTRAS: In the last two games, the Isotopes have racked up a total of 24 hits, but only three of those have gone for extra bases. Last night, Albuquerque amassed 11 hits, with the only extra-base knock coming in the form of a Joe Becker double, while on July 6, the 'Topes had 13 hits and only a double by Josh Fields and a homer by Trent Oeltjen were more than a single. Either way, the hits are coming. Albuquerque has racked up double-digit hits in each of its last six games, accumulating 78 total knocks in that span (an average of 13 per game).

**IN A FIELDS BY HIMSELF:** Josh Fields continues to swing a scorching bat, collecting multiple hits in each of his last seven games, a span in which he's batting .548 (17x31). The infielder has also scored two runs in each of the last three games and driven in eight over his last five.

HOMESTAND WRAPS UP WITH THE BROS: The Isotopes' five-game homestand comes to a spectacular and violent conclusion with the Isotopes Park debut of the Sweetright Brothers! In addition to hilarious antics, the "Brothers" bring with them elaborate props designed to amuse as well as puzzle the audience!

TODAY'S START: Derrick Loop takes the mound for his third start of the season coming off a win on July 3 at Omaha when he allowed six runs on eight htis in 5.0 innings while walking two and striking out one in an 11-7 'Topes win. Made his first start of the season on June 28 at Memphis, his first since August 27, 2011, going 3.0 innings, giving up four runs on two hits and a season-high four walks while fanning two in a 10-8 'Topes win. Before moving to the rotation, made 20 appearances out of the bullpen, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP). Transferred to Albuquerque from Extended Spring on April 8 and made his Isotopes debut that night at Omaha, pitching 3.0 innings in which he allowed one unearned run. The outing marked just his second-career Triple-A appearance (he made one appearance for Lehigh Valley in 2010). Transferred to Ogden roster on April 11 but returned to Albuquerque for good on April 23. Pitched a then-season-high 4.0 innings in a win vs. Oklahoma City on May 28, the third in a string of three straight victorious decisions, also a season-high.

2011: Spent season between Single-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization... went 2-1 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER / 32.0 IP) and three saves in 24 appearances for Clearwater.. left-handed hitters batted just .100 (4x40) against him, while righties batted .261 (18x69)... started the season by not allowing a run in his first 10 consecutive outings, a span of 12.1 conecutive scoreless innings... transferred to Reading on June 16 and finished the year there, going 1-3 with a 5.29 (20 ER / 34.0 IP) in 19 games (two starts)... held left-handed hitters to a 0.81 average (7x86)... made two starts to end the season (on August 17 and August 27), both in the second game of doubleheaders, and took the loss in both, going a combined 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER / 8.0 IP)... his start on August 17 was his first since April 16, 2009, when he made the start for Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Started the 2010 season with Camden in the Independent Atlantic League, going 0-1 with a 1.72 (6 ER / 31.1 IP) in 33 games... walked just 17 batters while striking out 40... signed with the Phillies on July 14 and began season with Single-A Clearwater... was on DL, from August 15-22... did not allow an earned run in 14 of his 15 relief appearances with Clearwater before being promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5 for his Triple-A debut... averaged 10.29 SO / 9.0 IP between both levels... held opponents to a combined .165 avg (15x91)... played for Aguilas in Dominican Winter League (16 G, 1-1, 2.79 ERA).

Spent majority of 2009 season with Single-A Salem in the Red Sox organization, going 3-3 with a 1.61 ERA (12 ER / 67.0 IP) in 47 games (one start)... finished second in Boston system and third in Carolina League in saves with 18... ranked second in CL in ERA (1.61) and fouth in SO/IP (10.71)... selected as midseason Carolina League All-Star... had a 17.1-inning scoreless streak (nine games), April 12 to May 4, and a 21.2-inning scoreless streak (16 games), June 1 to July 27... did not allow an earned run in 40 of 47 appearances with Salem... promoted to Double-A Portland on August 24 and made four appearances for the Sea Dogs, going 1-0 with a 6.23 ERA (3 ER 4.1 IP).

In 2008, began season with Chico Outlaws of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER / 29.1 IP) in six games (five starts)... had contract purchased by Boston and was assigned to Single-A Lancaster on June 25... set a Lancaster franchise record with 5 wins in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (6 ER / 33.0 IP) for the month... ended up 6-0 with a 3.04 ERA (18 ER / 53.1 IP) in 17 games (five starts) for Lancaster.

Spent entire 2007 season with Chico of the independent Golden Baseball League, going 8-5 with a 3.82 ERA (39 ER / 92.0 IP) in 17 games (15 starts)... led Golden Baseball League in wins... led team in starts and innings... named to the GBL postseason All-Star team... earned the win in Game 2 of the GBL Championship Series in helping Chico to the league title.

Selected by Cleveland in the 23rd round of the June 2006 draft and made his professional debut with Mahoning Valley in the short-season New York-Penn League, going 1-2 with a 2.95 ERA (12 ER / 36.2 IP) in 22 games.
