**ISOTOPES SUNK BY SOUNDS, 9-5:** The Albuquerque Isotopes saw a one-run lead evaporate thanks to a five-run eighth as the Nashville Sounds rallied to take a 9-5 series-ending win Tuesday night at Greer Stadium. With the contest tied at 4-4 in the top of the eighth, Albuquerque seized a quick lead when Alex Castellanos hammered a two-out, solo home run to left that gave the 'Topes a 5-4 edge. Nashville answered immediately and emphatically in the bottom of the frame on normally reliable Isotopes reliever Scott Rice. Khris Davis led off the frame with a single and immediately scampered into second on a wild pitch to put the tying run in scoring position. Taylor Green singled to shallow center, putting runners on the corners for Sean Halton, who laced a double to right, plating Davis and knotting the game at 5-5. After a walk to Jordan Brown loaded the bases, still with no out, Humberto Quintero roped a single to left, plating a pair and giving Nashville its first lead of the game 7-5. That's when things really unraveled for the 'Topes, as Edwin Maysonet dropped a bunt down that was picked up by Rice and thrown away, allowing two runs to score and give the Sounds a 9-5 lead. That was enough for the Nashville bullpen, which shut down the 'Topes in the eighth to cruise to a 9-5 win.

**SOLID START FOR ST. CLAIR:** Lefty Cole St. Clair makes his second career professional start coming off a solid performance in his first on July 27 at Round Rock. Making his first start since he was at Rice in 2008, St. Clair allowed just two runs on five hits in 5.0 solid innings of work while walking one and striking out two. For his performance, however, St. Clair was rewarded with his first loss of the season, a tough-luck defeat after the 'Topes were held to just one run in an eventual 5-1 defeat. Even with the loss, July ended up being the southpaw's best month of the season, posting a 2.93 ERA (5 ER / 15.1 IP) in six appearances (one start), his lowest ERA in any month this year.

**VIVA LAS VEGAS:** For the first time since 2010, the Isotopes welcome the Las Vegas 51s, Triple-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays, to Isotopes Park for a four game set. Since 2009, when Albuquerque became a Dodgers affiliate and the 51s switched to Toronto, the series has been an even 6-6, with the teams splitting their only previous series in the Duke City 2-2 from May 20-23, 2010. Prior to that, when Albuquerque was an affiliate of the then Florida Marlins and the Dodgers were in Las Vegas, it was much more one-sided, with the 'Topes posting a 19-5 record. Because of that early domination, the Isotopes are 25-11 all-time against the 51s and have a 12-4 record against Las Vegas all-time at Isotopes Park.

**HOME STRETCH:** Today the Isotopes begin their last month of the regular season with a 1.5 game lead on Oklahoma City looking to close down the team's third division title in franchise history. If Albuquerque's going to make the playoffs, it's going to have to travel a tougher road than the RedHawks. The combined records for the Isotopes' eight remaining opponents (including what is looking more like a winner-take-all series in OKC from August 27-30) is 459-428, a .517 winning percentage. Meanwhile, the combined record of the RedHawks' seven remaining opponents (they play Round Rock twice in the last two weeks of the season) is 428-459, a .483 winning percentage. Five of Albuquerque's eight remaining series are against teams with a winning record, including two current division-leaders (Omaha and Reno), while just three of OKC's remaining eight series are against teams with a record above .500, including two current division-leaders (Sacramento and Albuquerque).

**HOME RUN JERRY:** With a three-run homer last night, the red-hot Jerry Sands has belted four home runs in his last five games, while driving in an incredible 15 runs in that span. After hitting eight homers in the months of May and June combined (41 total games), Sands has blasted eight long balls in 27 games in July, including seven in his last 13 contests. His recent tear has propelled him towards the top in the PCL in both homers (19- fourth-most in the league) and RBI (76- tied for third) this season.

**AWESOME AUSSIE:** Even the recent record-setting home run binge of Sands can't obscure the torrid stretch Trent Oeltjen is enjoying of late. Oeltjen has gotten a hit in 13 of his last 14 games (an 0-for-1 in a pinch-hit appearance July 30 broke a 12-game hitting streak), batting a scorching .462 (24x52) since July 19. In the 13 games he's collected a hit, seven of them have been multi-hit performances.

**THE LAB HEATS UP IN AUGUST:** After an eight-game road trip, the Isotopes are back home tonight to start the final month of the regular season in style. On tap for the eight-game homestand is cowbell night, a performance by the Zooperstars!, fireworks, and a Dodger Stadium Replica giveaway!

**HAIL TO THE CHIEF!** Happy Birthday to Isotopes General Manager John Traub, who turns 25 today!

**TODAY'S START:** Lefty Cole St. Clair makes his second career start after a fin showing in his first on July 27 at Round Rock when he suffered a hard-luck defeat after allowing just two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings while walking one and striking out two in a 5-1 'Topes loss. The outing marked the first start of his professional career and his first since he was a senior at Rice University in 2008. Appeared in 32 games out of the bullpen for Albuquerque, racking up 51.2 innings, the most by an exclusive 'Topes reliever so far this season. Is a perfect 3-0 in his three decisions this year, all of which have come at home. Won his first career Triple-A game on May 7 vs. Nashville when he pitched a season-high 4.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits while walking none and striking out two in an 8-3 Isotopes win. Went six straight appearances from April 16 to May 5 without giving up a run, a span of 7.1 innings. Did not give up his first home run until his 16th appearance of the season, a span of 23.1 consecutive innings. His three total home runs allowed is tied with Scott Rice for the fewest on the team (min. 20.0 IP).

**2011:** Went 1-5 with a 3.04 ERA (17 ER / 50.1 IP) and two saves with Double-A Chattanooga... was second on the Lookouts with 42 appearances... fanned 46 batters while walking 13... limited opposing hitters to a .242 (43x178) batting average, including a .212 (21x99) mark against right-handers... selected as a Southern League All-Star after posting 0.83 ERA (2 ER / 21.2 IP) in 19 first-half appearances... did not allow a run in seven June appearances (7.0 IP)... allowed just four runs in an 18-game (22.0 IP) span from May through July (1.63 ERA).

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Split the 2010 season between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 1-3 with a 4.21 ERA (34 ER / 72.2 IP) and three saves in 44 appearances... struck out 74 batters between both stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER / 12.0 IP) and two saves in eight games... limited opposing hitters to a .167 average (7x42) with 15 strikeouts to earn an April 30 promotion to Chattanooga... saw action in 36 games with the Lookouts, going 1-2 with a 4.60 ERA (31 ER / 60.2 IP) and one save... held opposing hitters to a .211 average (8x38) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

Appeared in 30 games for Single-A Great Lakes in 2009, going 4-1 with a 2.48 ERA (10 ER / 36.1 IP) and 15 saves... did not allow a run over his final 13 appearances (14.0 IP) for the Loons... overall, limited opposing hitters to a .226 average (30x133) with 45 strikeouts in 36.1 innings... successfully converted each of his nine save opportunities... won the August/September Dodger Pride Award for Great Lakes, going 1-0 with seven saves, not allowing a run in 10.0 innings and limiting opponents to a .194 average (7x36) with 11 strikeouts in nine August games.

Selected by the Dodgers in the seventh round of the 2008 draft and began his professional career at Rookie-Level Ogden, posting no record and an 3.18 ERA (6 ER / 17.0 IP) and five saves in 12 games... fanned 22 while walking just five.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Allen Cole St. Clair... went 10-3 with five saves and a 3.03 ERA in 24 games (three starts) as a senior with Rice in 2008... had been selected by Cleveland in the seventh round of the 2007 draft, but chose to return to Rice for his senior season... graduated from Rice with a Bachelor's degree in Economics... was named the winner of the 2008 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, an honor that identifies personal qualities that define a complete student-athlete... was named a *Baseball America* First-Team College All-American after his sophomore season in 2006... pitched for Team USA in 2006, winning the Gold Medal at the FISU World Championships in Havana, Cuba... pitched in three College World Series from 2006-08... was a teammate of Phillip Hughes at Foothill High School in Santa Ana... his father Jay played basketball at the University of Southern California.
